Funeral services for Stanley Christian Nelson, 79, of 289 N. 250 E., Orem, who died Friday, Aug. 15, 1975 at Utah Valley Hospital, were held Tuesday, Aug. 17. He died of causes incident to age.

He was born to Andrew and Anna Lorentzen Nelson Jr. on Nov. 25, 1895, in Ferron, Emery County. On March 13, 1919, he married Florence Cary in Manhattan, Kansas. The marriage was later solemnized in the Manti LDS Temple.
