LETTING OF THE CONTRACT

CANADOCHLY CHURCH—We learn that the contract for building the new Canadochly Church, near the site of the one now standing, in Lower Windsor Township, five miles from this borough, has been awarded to Mr. Peter Keller, Jr., carpenter, of that township, at and for the sum of \$7500 and the old building; and that the new edifice will be erected the following spring. The contractor is making preparations for a vigorous prosecution of the work as soon as spring opens, and for that purpose has procured from the brickyard of Messrs. Ellwood & Son, in this place, 100,000 bricks, which are now on the ground, which together with 80,000 to 90,000 of good brick from the old building will go far towards completing the new edifice. The church property, including eighteen acres of land, is held jointly by the German Reformed and Lutheran Congregations worshipping there, and by whom the new building is to be put up. There were also two additional acres of land purchased a few years since, which has been appropriated and handsomely fitted up for a cemetery near the church, and of which many of the lots have been taken." —*Wrightsville Star*, quoted by *York Gazette*, January 15, 1867.
