Whereas, by Virtue and in Pursuance of an Order on Application, do. 24/15
entered the *eleventh* day of *January*
1767 by *Henry Michael* of the Township of *the*
in the County of *York* hath been surveyed a certain Tract of Land, containing *Sixty two acres one*
hundred and seventeen perches in *Windsor Township*

in the County of *York* - And Whereas, the ~~said~~ right of the said *Henry Michael* to the above mentioned tract of Land by virtue of *undry good Conveyances* in law became void in *Anthony Keller*

And the said *Anthony Keller* hath paid the purchase-money, at the rate of five pounds sterling per hundred acres, with the interest thereon due, agreeably to an act of Assembly, passed the ninth day of April, 1781, entitled "an Act for establishing a Land Office," &c. and a supplement thereto, passed the twenty-fifth of June, then next following.

These are, therefore, to authorise and require you to accept the said Survey into your Office, and to make return thereof, into the Office of the Secretary of the Land Office, for confirmation, by patent, to the said *Anthony Keller* And, for so doing, this shall be your warrant.

In Witness whereof *John Cochran* Secretary of the Land Office, hath hereunto set his hand and affixed the seal of the said office, the *thirty first* day of *August* A. D. 1809
