

**Mrs. Rhoda Montgomery Dead.**

Mrs. Rhoda S. Montgomery died at the home of her son, Charles, in North Dillon township, Sunday evening, Sept. 18, 1910. Mrs. Montgomery was born May 18, 1830 at Paris, Illinois. She came to Missouri in childhood. In 1868 she was united in marriage with Thomas Knight of Maries Co., and of this union one son, Chas. was born. About four years after the marriage Mr. Knight died. In 1885 Mrs. Knight was united in marriage with N. H. Montgomery of Phelps County who died about seven years ago. Mrs. Montgomery in her early life was a school teacher and at one time taught school in Rolla. In 1860 she joined the Christian church and has been a faithful follower of that faith.

Funeral services were conducted from the Macedonia Christian church Monday afternoon, Rev. Geshert of Salem officiating and interment took place at Macedonia cemetery. As an evidence of the high esteem in which she was held and out of deep sympathy for the bereaved family, a large crowd of neighbors and friends were present at the funeral.—Rolla New Era.
