Buried in Kraft Cemetery about a mile East of New Middletown, Ind., where DAR of Harrison Co. placed a marker. He enlisted 24 May 1778 for 9 mo. as a Private in Capt. John Novle Cumming's Co., 2nd Btn. Pension Claim 35552. A marker was placed at his grave by the White River Chapter of the DAR of Daviess Co., Ind.
