

**2 Sep 1626: The will of John Smythes.** In it the testator wills "to be buried in the church of Wrington neere unto the place where my sonne John Smithes was lately buried" and makes bequests "to the poor of Wrington; Johane my wife; my cosen William Strode; my son-in-law John Cope; Elizabeth Godwyn, my daughter, wife of Robert Godwyn; my daughter Sara Harvie, wife of Nicholas Harvie; my daughters Jane Bernard wife of Edward Bernard, gent.; Mary Bisse wife of James Bisse, gent.; Johane Chichester wife of Richard Chichester, gent.; and Judith Taverner wife of John Taverner, gent. Proved by Joane Smythes the widow at London 2 September 1626.
