The first Carleton who came to this Country was Edward who was made a freeholder in 1642 at Rowley, Mass. and appointed Judge in 1647 - His son Edward removed to ^[son] ~~John~~ ^{not Edw} to Haverhill Mass. & bought a farm & planted an Orchard The last tree of which disappeared in 1864 - He was County Clerk, died in 1668, leaving four children, John, Edward, Joseph & Thomas. Edward settled in the West Parish, on ^[son of John] what is now known as the Carleton place. Thomas settled in Bradford (Mass) John in Andover, & Joseph in New Hampshire - Edward had six sons, Edward, Benjⁿ, Nehemiah, Aaron, Abner, & Ebenezer & two daughters, ^[11 or 12 ch] Edward Jr. lived at the old place & rec^d a Commission from King George 2^d - Edward Jr had 4 sons, Richard, Edward, John & Peter - Peter is the great grand father ^[grfath] of Orrville Carleton & John Carleton & others now living in Bath NH - Peter married Hannah Gage & lived on the old place - his children were Edmund, Edward, Israel, & Ebenezer the last married died in Bath Oct 21st aged 76 years & was the father of a numerous family, ^[died in 1849] see Page 1st -
