REV. NATHAN W. ALGER.

REV. NATHAN W. ALGER [son bc] conducted several weeks of evangelistic services in Pas—sumpsic, and then became pastor of the Baptist Church at Passumpsic in the spring of 1875, pastor 8 years, superintendent of schools. He held other charges in Canada and in Vermont—later went to Santa Cruz, Calif. Pastor there some years. Res. Albuquerque, N. M. after 1892; revisiting Vermont in 1898.

He m. Nov. 1860 Mary K. French [dau. mc] (b. Compton, Que. July 1840; d. Denver, Colo. Nov. 1, 1926) they celebrated their golden wedding at Albuquerque, N. M. in Nov. 1910, a brother of each, who attended the wedding in 1860, being present. He d. Albuquerque Apr. 5, 1914, aged 80 years, 3 months.

ALBERT DANA "DANEY" ALGER farmed in Passumpsic on the Milo Lawrence place at the top of Mill St. on the Waterford line; working into his late 80's as a handiman and yard trimmer. He was born in Irasburg, Vt. [son bc] March 21, 1878 [dc] the son of Albert D. (Oct. 1, 1840 - Apr. 30, 1897[gs]) and Sarah M. (Nov. 8, 1853 - Dec. 13, 1927[gs]) (Huntington) Alger [Dana.dc]; m. 1st Effie S.(L.) Drake (b. Glens Falls, N. Y.) [dau. mc] 1883; d. 1907 [gs]; m. 2nd Gertrude Hattie Andrews (b. Craftsbury 1888; d. 1981 [gs]). He d. Darling Inn Oct. 28, 1970; all three bur. Irasburg, Vt. Cem. [dc/gs].
