A listing in a death notice that appeared in a March 4, 2010 Escape and Evasion Society newsletter for John W. "Bill" Petty indicates he was a nose gunner on Dinah Might with an aircraft number of 42-52164 and shot down January 20, 1945. There was an AC with that number with the 450th BG/723rd BS. The MACR (No. 11804) for 460th BG, 761st BS B-24 shot down January 20, 1945 on which Petty is listed as a crew member indicates the AC No. as 42-50746. Note that that AC is shown below named "Slick Chick with a Hot Lick". Dinah Might as 42-51408 is confirmed via several sources. Picture on file. Dinah Might was Petty crew's normal aircraft, but it did not pass pre-flight inspection on
