#### Introduction

The purpose of this book is to make available to those searching the descendants of William Bailey of Douglas Parish, York Co., NB, what is known at the present time

The text shown below is a request for assistance by Elizabeth Bailey after the death of her husband in 1852. The text was written by Mike Bailey. The original documents are also shown in the section called "Supporting Documentation & images: Part 1 & 2"

In 1853 Elizabeth Bailie (sic) petitioned the House of assembly of the Province of New Brunswick for a sum of money to purchase land for a home.

To the Honorable (?) House of Assembly of the Province of New Brunswick in General (?) (?)

The Petition of Elizabeth Bailie of Douglas in the County of York

### Humbly (?)

That your petitioner is the widow of the late William Bailie who died on the eighteeth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two, having your petitioner with nine children (the youngest of whom was born seven months after her husband's death) in very indigent circumstances. That your petitioner came to this province with her late husband as settlers about twenty years (?). That the said William Bailie was a pensioner of Her Magestys 98th Regiment of Foot. That he commuted his pension for an allowance of Land promised to be provided him in the Province. That a tract of land Lot number in the first (?) of Little Magaguadavic Lake Settlement Parish of Kingsclear was (?) to him but in consequence of his not having his certificate of Discharge (which your petitioner supposes he did not do from it being in such a (?) state that he feared it would not satisfy the demands of the Crown lands Office) this (?) was never granted to him.

Your petitioner desires to present for your investigation a Memorandum from a Clerk in the Crown land Office to the above effect - A letter from the war office station that a Drummer William Bailie was discharged from the th Regiment in September - And the (?) Certificate of Discharge which has been promised by Military (?) to be a Discharge Certificate and no doubt authentic and which my late husband always had in his possession and preserved with much care.

Under the circumstances your petitioner Honorably (?) that your Honorable Honor will be pleased to grant to her and her children a (?) tract of land to the (?) formally located to her husband as such a sum of money as may enable her to purchase a small farm for the maintenance and support of her large family.

And your Petitioner as is duly bound will ever Pray.

The following was received frm Mike Bailey, 13 Dec 2014:

William Bailey was born in 1796 in Tarrington Parish, Birkshire, England.

When he 16 years old in 1812 he joined the British Army as a drummer. The British Army was spread pretty thin at that point with campaigns against Napoleon in Europe and a new conflict with the United States in north America. William was assigned to the 98th Regiment of Foot Soldiers as a drummer and spent most of his time in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Logged in as Drummer Bailey he stayed with the regiment until it was disbanded in 1818, when he was discharged at Fort Pitt in Chatham, Kent County, England. He returned to his home in Tarrington Parish, Birkshire, England and about 1822 married Elizabeth Waherty.

"He commuted his pension for an allowance of Land promised to be provided him in the Province [of New Brunswick, Canada]. That a tract of land Lot number 7 in the first (?) of Little Magaguadavic Lake Settlement Parish of Kingsclear was (?) to him but in consequence of his not having his certificate of Discharge (which your petitioner supposes he did not do from it being in such a (?) state that he feared it would not satisfy the demands of the Crown lands Office) this (?) was never granted to him."

He and his wife Elizabeth immigrated to New Brunswick, Canada in 1833.

In 1851 he was listed as a 60-year old Tenant farmer in Douglas Parish, York County, New Brunswick. Tenant farmers did not own the land they worked, but paid a rent or a portion of their crop to the landlord in hopes of someday building up enough credit or capital to buy their own land. In 1851 he was living with his wife Elizabeth and their seven children, next door to his son Richard (a land owner) and wife Leticia and their baby daughter Mary Jane.

William died in July of 1852, at about 58 years old, seven months before the birth of his ninth child. As a tenant farmer in New Brunswick William had no land to pass on to his wife and children and in 1853 Elizabeth Bailie (sic) found herself "in very indigent circumstances" and officially "petitioned the House of Assembly of the Province of New Brunswick for a sum of money to purchase land for a home" in recognition of William's years of service to the Crown and his commutation of his pension for an allowance of land in the Province of New Brunswick.

The date of death of Elizabeth is unknown. She only appears in the 1851 census and her children are in the 1861 census, the youngest beng only 7 years old. It would appear that Elizabeth has either died or remarried but she has abandoned her youngest children which seems strange. It is being assumed that she has died unless other evidence is found to prove otherwise.
