Special Note (DNA Study)

The following is a note that is in the notes section for Juliane, wife of Gottlied Sparman. It is being shown here as well as it pertains to all children of August Zielke and his wife Amelia Sparman. The real question could also be stated as "Is August Zielke the biological father of the children that his is shown to be the father????"

This DNA study is trying to answer this question as well as the maiden name of the wife of Gottlieb Sparman.

To partake in this DNA study, you must have have a DNA result from Ancestry.com as that is the platform that contains the tools to do this study provided you have entered your Pedigree as to how you connect to the Zielke line. If you don't have your Pedigree at Ancestry.com then you can send an email to the address shown at the end of this document with your lineage.

The parentage of Juliiane is unknown as no information has ever been found for her birth, marriage, death, or other info that indicated who her parents were. The only evidence that is available now is from Autosomal DNA testing. I show shared DNA with people who are descendants of Herman Plath and the only way this can be is that the Plath line is part of my Pedigree. There are two possibilities that I will call situation A and situation B. Situation A is that Juliana wife of Gottlieb Sparman was Juliane Plath, sister to Herman Plath. Situation B is that one of Herman Plath's sons was the father of my grandmother, Alvina Zielke. There is a third possibility and that is that both situation A AND B are True. This is entirely a possibility as first cousins marrying in this family line appears to be very prevalent.

August Zielke and Amelia/Emelie Sparman were married in 1880 and their first three sons were born in the period from 1882-1889 all in Princeton, Green Lake Co., WI, then August and his family moved to Sleepy Eye, Brown Co., MN which was the same area where the two Plath brothers and their families were located. They have been in this area since before 1860. This gives a reason that August Zielke moved to this area. More research is needed and this will only be found by sharing DNA information that proves this situation either TRUE or FALSE, so far, everything points in the direction of TRUE. What is needed is that all the children of August Zielke need to be included in this study to prove situation B as False and Situation A as True. You hold the answers in your DNA results, I have presented mine. This note is aimed at the other descendants of August Zielke that have have their DNA tested at Ancestry.com.

One major item that all of us has to remember is that our matches may hold the answer and these matches must be known to the others in the group as they may recognize lines that we don't. Introduction

This book is an attempt to bring together information on the descendants of John Zuehlke and his wife Wilhelmine.

A major problem in trying to track this family has been the spelling of the last name which varies according to how people thought it should be spelled. My great-grand-father, August Zielke/Zilke used a spelling that was Zilke according to the tombstone at the Bethany Lutheran Church Cemetery (SE 18, Twp. 19, Rnge 2, W-3). However, just recently after much searching, the tombstone of his parents has been found on "Find a Grave" that shows a photograph of the Tombstone which is located at "Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church Cemetery, Neshkoro, Marquette Co., Wisconsin" A photograph of this tombstone is included in this document to show that the surname is spelled as Zuehlke which appears to be the German spelling used by a number of the descendant lines. The notes that show the tracking of the different families shows the spelling as found in the different census and other documents.

Since this is a work in progress, there is missing data in the form of missing dates for births/marriages/deaths and if the age was known then a one year span is used to show the approximate year that the event took place. Missing data for a location is shown as a "?" mark. If anyone knows of information that is more exact then they are asked to please contact the person shown below so that the correct information may be shown in updated versions of this book. If more information is known on descendants of any family then an update it required to keep this tree growing.

An additional chapter has been added on a Zilke line that was in Michigan. This family starts with a Karl Fredrich 'Herman' Zilke and many researchers refer to the John Zuehlke who was in the 1900 census in Wisconsin. Maybe this is an older brother to August. The only way we will be able to prove this is by using autosomal DNA analysis. We already have three persons who have had their Family Finder autosomal DNA tested and now we need at least one person who is a descendant of Herman to be tested to prove this is either TRUE or FALSE.

When sending update information or corrections, do not use the numbering system shown in the book to refer to a family rather than the full names of the parents as shown in this document. The numbering system is only generated when the book is created and means nothing to me when doing updates. Thanks very much.

The Marriage certificate for August and Emilie Sparman also indicate that the name is Zielke as the fathers name is John Zielke and mother Wilhelmine Zolke.

The Delemma!!!! Was August Zielke the biological father of the children that had his surname? My father, Edwin Krause, told me that August had told him that Elsie, the youngest child, was not his daughter but was fathered by a different person. This is a fact that needs to be verified by DNA testing to prove that the biological father of Elsie was not August Zielke.

In the case of my grand-mother, Amelia Zielke, the second oldest daughter, DNA matches indicate that her father was either Herman Plath or one of his sons.

All of the DNA matches on this line, are via the Sparman connection or via the Plath/Sparman connection. No matches have been found for any of August Zielke's siblings(More research required)

The answers to this might be found from the descendants of the son's of August if they will share their DNA matches with the rest of us to try and break down this brick wall.

The only document that I had that showed where my grandfather, Carl Gustav William Krause, was born was a Nonresident Alien's Border crossing Identification Card.

Many people are having great difficulty finding the place where Carl Gustav William Krause was from, according to the Hamburg Ship List. The following link shows a section of a map (GrosBblatt 40 Neustettin - Flatow) and GrosBlatt 41 where the two maps join.

 Map section showing where Branch-One-A was from in West Prussia. The small circular dots with 518 is for the descendants of Johann Krause and 517 for Herman Krause. The other dots are for different Krause families who have proven to be DNA-cousins after 37-Marker Y-Chromosome tests were done on living male descendants of their lines.

Another link with several other maps that show where the Branch-One Krause Roots came from in West Prussia may further aid those who are having difficulty in finding this area. Just click on the icon on the right side to view the map or document. The maps included in this summary include the one in the link shown above.

One item that helped me in my search for my Krause ancestry is a bit convoluted but gave an essential piece of information. My grandfather, when asked the name of his father, did not know his name but remembered an Uncle John who had moved away to another state and was never heard from again. When my grandfathers older sister was married, her marriage documents shows that Johann/John Krause was her father. The person who moved to a different state was Herman Krause and his family. Both Herman and my grandfather with his mother and her second husband, Hans Heinrich Wilhelm Knickrehm moved in 1887 to different states, Herman to Wisconsin and Henry Knichrehm to Minnesota and that is how they lost touch with each other. The essential piece of information here was that Herman and John were brothers. Autosomal DNA testing has shown that according to the amount of shared DNA for the descendants of Herman and John, they may have been half-brothers. It is being assumed that they were full brothers.

When my grandfather was asked if there were any Krause relatives that stayed in Germany, he stated that they were coming to America but the ship sunk at sea and all were lost. Hearing this, you didn't ask any more questions.

This entry of John Krause as the father of Albert is based on the following:

One day in 2001, my father, Edwin, told me that Albert was not his brother but was his half-brother. I didn't say anything, just listened. A week later he said the same thing and this time, I asked him how did he know that. His reply was that his sister, Annie, had told him. As she had seen the hired man creep into the bed-room when my grand-father was away in hospital. I didn't ask anything more and Dad didn't offer anymore explanation.

This seems hardly plausible as Annie would have been only 18 months old and would have been to young to remember this event.

This entry of John Krause as the father of Albert is based on the following:

One day in 2001, my father, Edwin, told me that Albert was not his brother but was his half-brother. I didn't say anything, just listened. A week later he said the same thing and this time, I asked him how did he know that. His reply was that his sister, Annie, had told him. As she had seen the hired man creep into the bed-room when my grand-father was away in hospital. I didn't ask anything more and Dad didn't offer anymore explanation.

This seems hardly plausible as Annie would have been only 18 months old and would have been to young to remember this event.

Many people are having great difficulty finding the place where Carl Gustav William Krause was from, according to the Hamburg Ship List. The following link shows a section of a map (GrosBblatt 40 Neustettin - Flatow) and GrosBlatt 41 where the two maps join.

 Map section showing where Branch-One-A was from in West Prussia. The small circular dots with 518 is for the descendants of Johann Krause and 517 for Herman Krause. The other dots are for different Krause families who have proven to be DNA-cousins after 37-Marker Y-Chromosome tests were done on living male descendants of their lines.

Another link with several other maps that show where the Branch-One Krause Roots came from in West Prussia may further aid those who are having difficulty in finding this area. One item that helped me in my search for my Krause ancestry is a bit convoluted but gave an essential piece of information. My grandfather, when asked the name of his father, did not know his name but remembered an Uncle John who had moved away to another state and was never heard from again. When my grandfathers older sister was married, her marriage documents shows that Johann/John Krause was her father. The person who moved to a different state was Herman Krause and his family. Both Herman and my grandfather with his mother and her second husband,

Hans Heinrich Wilhelm Knickrehm moved in 1887 to different states, Herman to Wisconsin and Henry Knichrehm to Minnesota and that is how they lost touch with each other. The essential piece of information here was that Herman and John were brothers. Autosomal DNA testing has shown that according to the amount of shared DNA for the descendants of Herman and John, they may have been half-brothers. It is being assumed that they were full brothers.

When my grandfather was asked if there were any Krause relatives that stayed in Germany, he stated that they were coming to America but the ship sunk at sea and all were lost. Hearing this, you didn't ask any more questions.

The following is information that I was told by my father, Edwin Krause:

This entry of John Krause as the father of Albert is based on the following:

One day in 2001, my father, Edwin, told me that Albert was not his brother but was his half-brother. I didn't say anything, just listened. A week later he said the same thing and this time, I asked him how did he know that. His reply was that his sister, Annie, had told him. As she had seen the hired man creep into the bed-room when my grand-father was away in hospital. I didn't ask anything more and Dad didn't offer anymore explanation.

This seems hardly plausible as Annie would have been only 18 months old and would have been to young to remember this event.

When it came time for Y-Chromosome DNA testing, I didn't include the descendants of Albert at first as I was unsure about the tale that I had been told. Finally, I had Steven Krause tested and his Y-Chromosome results showed that he was a closer match to my Krause line than even what I was as I had a mutation that was unique to myself.
