Dear Alex Calzareth:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request received in this office February 2, 2007, regarding the subject: Bella Baer.

We have completed the review of all documents responsive to your request and have identified 73 pages which are responsive to your request. Enclosed are 67 pages released in their entirety, and 6 pages released in part. We have reviewed and have determined to release all information except those portions that are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(7)(C) of the FOIA.

The following exemptions are applicable:

Freedom of Information Act U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(C)

Exemption (b)(7)(C) provides protection for personal information in law enforcement records, which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. We have withheld various information relating to third-party individuals. The types of documents and/or information that we have withheld could consist of names, addresses, identification numbers, telephone numbers, fax numbers, or various other documents that are considered personal.

The enclosed record consists of the best reproducible copies available.

Old documents/records such as these are maintained on microfilm and the quality of the image is dependent on the condition of the original document when it was filmed.

Reference is made to your application to amend your alien registration and alien enemy identification records to show you as a citizen of France.

After careful consideration of the evidence submitted, it is believed that you have not satisfactorily established that at the time your records were created you were of a nationality other than stateless, last of Germany. Under the circumstances, your application is denied.

It may be added, further, that this Service has, since July 10, 1944, discontinued its former practice of amending alien registration and alien enemy identification records. Consequently, your case is being closed in this office.

Reference is made to your order of May 3, 1944, denying the applications of Sigmund Baer, AR-7690800, and his wife, Bella Bessie Baer, AR-7690802, to amend their Alien Registration and Alien Enemy Identification records to show their nationality as French rather than as German. Their files, together with that of their daughter, Madeline Baer, AR-7690801, are attached.

The letter of November 25, 1942 from Mr. Mannis to Mr. Sigmund Baer in file AR-7690800, informing him that he is classifiable as a subject of France and, therefore, not liable to the regulations of the Attorney General governing aliens of enemy nationality indicates that Mr. Mannis has also communicated with the office of the United States Attorney, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania concerning the nationality of the applicants. This Office has no information of the action, if any, taken by the United States Attorney in Pittsburgh with reference to their alien enemy status.

As you are aware, this Office has, upon the granting of an amendment to show an applicant as a non-enemy, instructed him to surrender his Certificate of Identification. Such action was originally taken on the basis of paragraph 4 of Instruction No. 91 and has been continued under Instruction No. 161.

In your memorandum of September 22, 1943 in re Betty Weitzmann, AR-2545932, you stated that under the Presidential Proclamation the United States Attorneys have been charged with the enforcement of its provisions and that it is for them to determine who is an alien enemy for the purpose of the proclamation.

In view of the possibility that the United States Attorney may have informed Mr. and Mrs. Baer they are not alien enemies, will you please advise whether this Office should communicate your decision to the United States Attorney and ask whether he has taken any action in the case with respect to the alien enemy identification record, or whether the applicants should be informed of the decision without our communicating with the United States Attorney. We should also like to know whether, if the United States Attorney has informed them that they are not classified as aliens of enemy nationality for the purpose of the Presidential Proclamation of January 14, 1942, this Office should amend the alien enemy identification record to show non-enemy nationality on the basis of his decision.

These aliens have applied to have the records of the Office for Alien Registration amended to show their nationality as French.

The records disclose that the husband was born in Untergrombach, Germany on February 27, 1901, the wife in Michelbach, Germany on January 27, 1907. They were married on February 9, 1933. They were admitted to the United States on November 10, 1941, at which time they were in possession of French travel documents in lieu of passports, and immigration visas showing their nationality as "without ex German". The birth certificates of both subjects show them to be Jewish. Certificates of good conduct, issued to both subjects on May 20, 1941 by the French officials in Bourboule, France, reflect their nationality as German.

The subjects have testified that they were citizens of Germany at birth and that they left Germany in July 1933, proceeding to France where they resided until October 21, 1941. They state that they applied for French citizenship in 1936 and had taken all the steps necessary with the Department of Justice, the Department of Commerce and the Surete Nationale and that they had been promised citizenship in 1941 before all others, but that as soon as the war broke out every naturalization case was interrupted by a special order of the French Government. The husband has presented letters and certificates showing his service in the French Army in 1940 and approval of his application for naturalization by the Minister of Commerce, the Prefect of Haut-Rhin and the Minister of Justice. The letter dated March 21, 1939 from the Minister of Justice indicates that the husband may proceed toward citizenship after two years. The Alien Enemy Control Unit, Department of Justice, has stated that they consider the subject classifiable as a citizen of France based on the foregoing evidence.

On the basis of the testimony and evidence in the record, it appears that the husband, and through him the wife, would have been eligible for naturalization in France in 1941 but that the outbreak of the war and the discontinuance of naturalization by the French Government interrupted the proceedings prior to his acquisition of French citizenship. The conclusion that the subjects did not acquire French citizenship is supported by the fact that they were listed as citizens of Germany in their certificates of good conduct issued on May 20, 1941, by the manner of their entry into the United States with French travel documents rather than ordinary French passports and by their own testimony that they were not actually admitted to French citizenship.

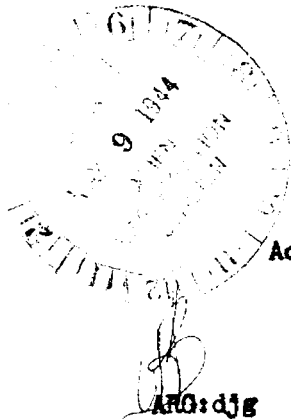
Since the subjects are Jewish and were residing outside Germany since prior to November 25, 1941, they were expatriated by the German Decree of November 25, 1941, which expatriated all Jews residing outside Germany on that date and are now stateless, last citizens of Germany.

IT IS ORDERED that the applications of the above-named individuals to have the records of the Office for Alien Registration amended to show their nationality as French be denied.

I refer to your memorandum of April 20 discussing the citizenship status of Sigmund Baer, 6560 Darlington Road, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

Our records disclose that Mr. Baer produced a Certificate of Service in the Army of the Republic of France; a letter dated March 21, 1939 from the Ministry of Justice, indicating that he would be entitled to French citizenship at the expiration of two years thereof; a Certificate of the Mayor of St. Louis, France, dated May 17, 1940, evidencing his loyalty to the Republic of France; a recommendation from the Minister of Commerce of the Republic of France dated March 3, 1939, proposing him for French citizenship; and a statement of the Minister of Interior of the Republic of France, dated December 22, 1939, indicating his status as a loyal resident of France.

Unfortunately, due to the circumstances of this war, Mr. Baer could not obtain a Certificate of Citizenship, to which he was entitled two years after March 21, 1939, or March 21, 1941. However, the letter of the Ministry of Justice states further that he became entitled to French citizenship on March 21, 1941.

In view of these letters, which were authentic, it is the view of this Unit that Mr. Baer became a citizen of France as of March 21, 1941, and therefore, can be classified by this Unit, for the purpose of the Attorney General's regulations, as a citizen of France. As there is no doubt that by virtue of his birth in Germany he is a native of Germany, even though he would not have to comply with the regulations of the Attorney General, he would, nevertheless, be liable to apprehension as a potentially dangerous alien enemy should this be necessary. His file, however, discloses no loyalty to Germany, but, in fact, a loyalty to the cause of the United Nations.

In accordance with request of the District Office by letter dated June 14, 1943, and June 15, 1943, investigations have been conducted regarding the above-named petitioners for amendment of alien registration as to nationality, in accordance with provisions set forth in Instruction No. 67. Sworn question and answer statements of the subjects were taken on August 24, 1943, and attached hereto. Additional documents furnished by both subjects also are attached. The statements and documents are self-explanatory.

MRS. M. D. BACHMANN, 6556 Darlington Road, Pittsburgh, Pa., was interviewed on November 12, 1943. She stated that the subjects have been neighbors of hers for about two years. They are persons of good moral character and apparently loyal to the United States, she said. The witness said she did not know what was their nationality, although they appeared to be Germans. She did not know whether they belonged to any organizations and did not believe that they have ever been arrested. The witness said she did not think the subjects have a short-wave radio, firearms, etc. in their home.

MR. and MRS. PHILIP BRENTON, 6560 Darlington Road (first floor) who were interviewed on November 12, 1943, stated that they have had an apartment in the same house with the subjects for about two years. During that time the subjects have impressed them as being loyal to the United States and persons of good moral character. The witnesses stated they did not know of what country the subjects are citizens, but knew that they originally lived in Germany and resided in France two or more years prior to coming to the United States. The witnesses did not know whether the subjects have belonged to any organization and did not believe the subjects have ever been arrested. The subjects do not appear to have a short-wave radio, fire arms, etc. in their home, said the witnesses. A search of the criminal records of the Bureau of Police, Pittsburgh, Pa. was made on August 17, 1943. Nothing was found relating to the subjects. A search of the records of the F. B. I. was made on the same day. Nothing unfavorable was found relating to the subjects.
