Dear Alex Calzareth:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act, (FOIA) request, received in this office August 15, 2005, regarding the subject, Stefani Fried.

We have completed the review of all documents responsive to your request and have identified 55 pages, which are responsive to your request. Enclosed are 40 pages released in their entirety, and fourteen pages released in part. We are withholding one page in full. In our review of this page, we have determined that it contains no reasonable, segregable portion(s) of non-exempt information. We have reviewed and have determined to release all information except those portions, which are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C) of the Freedom of Information Act, (FOIA). The enclosed record consists of the best reproducible copies available.

Freedom of Information Act 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(6)

Exemption (b)(6) permits the government to withhold all information about individuals in personnel, medical and similar files where the disclosure of such information would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The types of documents and/or information withheld may consist of birth certificates, naturalization certificates, drivers license, social security numbers, home addresses, dates of birth, or various other documents and/or information belonging to a third party that are considered personal.

Freedom of Information Act 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(C)

Exemption (b)(7)(C) provides protection for personal information in law enforcement records, which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. We have withheld various information relating to third-party individuals. The types of documents and/or information withheld could consist of names, addresses, identification numbers, telephone numbers, fax numbers, or various other documents that are considered personal.

**"Old documents/records such as these are maintained on microfilm and the quality of the image is dependent on the condition of the original document when it was filmed."**

In the event you wish to appeal this determination, you may write to the USCIS FOIA/PA Appeals Office, 111 Massachusetts Ave., NW, Washington, DC 20529, within 60 days of receipt of this letter. Both the letter and the envelope should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."

4. Said certificate is defective because my age as of the date of naturalization is stated thereon as 49, whereas my age at the time of such naturalization was 52. In answer to question 5 on my application for naturalization [Form N-400 (old A-2214) U.S. Dept. of Justice, Immigration & Naturalization Service (Edition of 1-13-41)] I correctly stated my birthday to have been Sept. 2, 1894. In computing my age for the purpose of inserting the same on my Certificate of Naturalization the Clerk apparently made a mathematical mistake and inserted the age of 49 instead of the age of 52. I did not notice such mistake on account of my emotional state at the time of my naturalization, and only discovered the mistake recently.

I request that the clerk of court be authorized to correct my said certificate to conform to the facts shown on my petition for naturalization, or to issue a new certificate to me in the event that correction cannot be made without mutilating the certificate.
