Dear Alex Calzareth:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request received in this office August 4, 2006, regarding Henry Otten Fuchs.

We have completed the review of all documents and have identified 36 pages which are responsive to your request. Enclosed are 26 pages released in their entirety, and 10 pages released in part. We have reviewed and have determined to release all information except those portions that are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(2) and (b)(7)(C) of the FOIA.

The following exemptions are applicable:

Exemption (b)(2) provides protection for records that are related solely to the internal personnel rules and practices of an agency. The types of documents and/or information we have withheld under this exemption may relate to internal matters of a relatively trivial nature, such as internal personnel rules and practices which could consist of employee identification codes, computer login codes, policies regarding the use of parking facilities and breakrooms, employee leave policies and dress codes or internal matters of a more substantial nature, the disclosure of which would risk circumvention of a legal requirement, such as operating rules, guidelines and manuals of procedures for examiners or adjudicators.

Exemption (b)(7)(C) provides protection for personal information in law enforcement records, which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The types of documents and/or information withheld could consist of names, addresses, identification numbers, telephone numbers, fax numbers, or various other documents that are considered personal.

The enclosed record consists of the best reproducible copies available.

Old documents/records such as these are maintained on microfilm and the quality of the image is dependent on the condition of the original document when it was filmed.

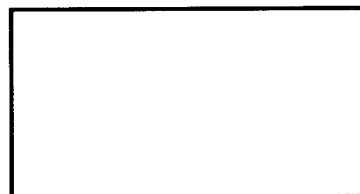



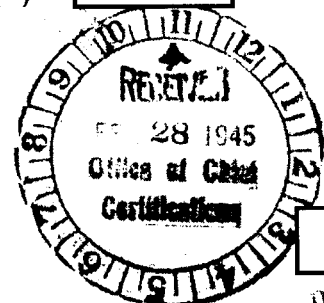

THROUGH OFFICIAL CHANNELS

The subject has satisfactorily established by documentary evidence and by the testimony of his father that he did acquire United States citizenship at birth. The point at issue in this case is whether or not applicant has ever expatriated himself.

The first time that the applicant ever came to the United States was June 23, 1933 at which time he was 26 years of age and in possession of a United States passport. This entry into the United States has been verified by the office of this Service at Boston, Massachusetts. Note that the applicant in addition to being manifested as a passenger coming for permanent residence, citizen of U.S.A., was also manifested as a seaman, citizen of France, admitted under Section 3(5) of the Act of 1924 for a period of sixty days.

The latest evidence submitted by the applicant is a certificate of identification issued by the French Police Department of Strasbourg, France August 4, 1922 (see Exhibit 3). At that time the subject was 15 years old; he was recorded as of American nationality.

There is attached hereto and made a part hereof a copy of a letter addressed to the Commissioner by the Chief of the Passport Division of the State Department under date of January 27, 1945 relative to the applicant's possible expatriation. This letter states that there is nothing in the State Department's files indicating that the subject expatriated himself while abroad.

The applicant has stated that during the time that he resided in Europe he did not by any voluntary act renounce his allegiance to the United States of America or in any other way make an election of other than American nationality. In the absence of any contravening evidence it is recommended that subject's application be granted.

The Department has received Mr. Savoretti's letter of December 29, 1944 concerning the application of Henry Otten Fuchs for a certificate of derivative citizenship under Section 339 of the Nationality Act of 1940 (Visa-2026557).

The citizenship of Henry Otten Fuchs is of record in the Department in the form of the applications upon which several American passports have been issued to him, the last of which was No. 141 issued on April 7, 1933 by the American Consulate at Stuttgart, Germany. In the application upon which this passport was issued to Mr. Fuchs he stated that he was born at Strasbourg, Alsace, France on May 27, 1907 and that his father, Herman Fuchs, who was born in Germany, was naturalized as a citizen of the United States by the County Court of Oregon at Baker, Oregon on March 4, 1889.

There is no information in the Department's files indicating that Mr. Fuchs expatriated himself while abroad.

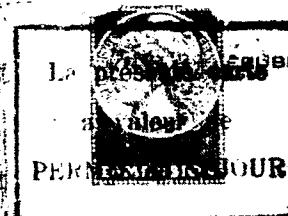

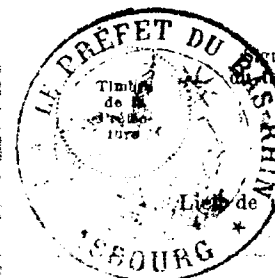
