Dear Alex Calzareth:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request received in this office July 26, 2006, regarding Nelly Heinsheimer.

We have completed the review of all documents responsive to your request and have identified 11 pages which are responsive to your request. Enclosed are eight pages released in their entirety, and three pages released in part. We have reviewed and have determined to release all information except those portions that are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 (b)(7)(C) of the FOIA.

The following exemptions are applicable:

Exemption (b)(7)(C) provides protection for personal information in law enforcement records, which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. We have withheld information relating to third-party individuals. The types of documents and/or information that we have withheld could consist of names, addresses, identification numbers, telephone numbers, fax numbers, or various other documents that are considered personal.

The enclosed record consists of the best reproducible copies available.

In the event you wish to appeal this determination, you may write to the USCIS FOIA/PA Appeals Office, 111 Massachusetts Ave., NW, 4th Floor, Washington, DC 20529, within 60 days of receipt of this letter. Both the letter and the envelope should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."

I, the undersigned APPLICANT FOR AN IMMIGRATION VISA, being duly sworn, state that my full and true name is **Helly Heinsheimer**, that I am **43** years of age, of the **female** sex and **caucasian** race; that I was born on the **23** day of **Febr. 1886**, A. D. at **Offenbach a. Main, Germany**; that for five years immediately preceding this application I have resided at the following places, to wit:

That my port of embarkation is **unknown**; that I shall enter the United States at the port of **New York**; that my final destination beyond such port is **New York N.Y.**; and that I do not have a ticket through to such destination; that my passage was paid for by **husband**; that I intend to join **relative** **dto. Heinrich Heinsheimer** whose address is **324 West 101st Street, New York N.Y.** (City, State, street, and number)
lasted with \$ 100.00

That my purpose in going to the United States is **to join husband**, and I intend to remain **permanently** (Permanently or length of time)

of the insane; that my mother has never been in an institution or hospital for the care and treatment of the insane; that I have never been refused an immigration or passport visa at any American Consulate.

That, except as hereafter noted, I am not a member of any one of the following classes of individuals excluded from admission to the United States under the immigration laws: (1) Idiots ; (2) Imbeciles ; (3) Feeble-minded ; (4) Epileptics ; (5) Insane persons ; (6) Persons having had previous attacks of insanity ; (7) Persons with constitutional psychopathic inferiority ; (8) Persons with chronic alcoholism ; (9) Paupers ; (10) Professional beggars ; (11) Vagrants ; (12) Persons afflicted with tuberculosis ; (13) Persons afflicted with a loathsome or dangerous contagious disease ; (14) Criminals ; (15) Polygamists ; (16) Anarchists ; (17) Members of unlawful organizations ; (18) Prostitutes ; (19) Procurers ; (20) Contract laborers ; (21) Persons likely to become public charges ; (22) Persons previously deported or ordered deported and permitted to leave the United States voluntarily in lieu of deportation ; (23) Persons previously excluded from admission to the United States at a port of entry ; (24) Persons whose passage paid by another ; (25) Unaccompanied children ; (26) Natives of Asiatic barred zone ; (27) Illiterates ; or (28) Aliens ineligible to citizenship.

That I claim to be exempt from exclusion on account of the class numbered (), noted above, for the reasons following, to wit:

That I am the ~~husband~~ ^{wife} of Heinrich Heinsheimer, who is an alien resident, lawfully admitted for permanent residence, of the United States, 50 years of age, and resides at 324 West 101st Street, New York N.Y. verified by form 573 (City, State, street, and number)

That because of the relationship aforesaid I am entitled to and claim the preference provided for in paragraph (1) of Subdivision (a) of Section 6 of the Immigration Act of 1924, as amended May 29, 1928.

That I am the dependent child under 18 years of a skilled agriculturist and entitled to and claim preference provided for in paragraph (1) of Subdivision (a) of Section 6 of the Immigration Act of 1924, as amended May 29, 1928.

That I am aware that Section 1 (a) of the Deportation Act of March 4, 1929, provides in part that the entry or attempted entry to the United States of an alien who has been arrested and deported from the United States in pursuance of law shall be a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than two years or by fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

That I am also aware that Section 2 of the Act just cited provides that any alien who enters the United States at any time or place other than as designated by immigration officials or eludes examination or inspection by immigration officials, or obtains entry to the United States by a willfully false or misleading representation or the willful concealment of a material fact, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
