Dear Alex Calzareth:

This is in response to your Genealogy request received in this office April 18, 2006, for access to copies of documents regarding Ludwig Klein.

We have completed our search for records that are responsive to your request and have identified 18 pages, which are responsive to your request. Enclosed are 17 pages released in their entirety. We are withholding one page in part pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(7)(C) of the FOIA. All documents provided are the best reproducible copies available. **Old documents/records such as these are maintained on microfilm and the quality of the image is dependent on the condition of the original document when it was filmed.**

Exemption (b)(7)(C) provides protection for personal information in law enforcement records, which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. We have withheld various information relating to third-party individuals. The types of documents and/or information that we have withheld could consist of names, addresses, identification numbers, telephone numbers, fax numbers, or various other documents that are considered personal.
