Dear Alex Calzareth:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request received in this office July 26, 2006, regarding the subject: Otto Oppenheimer.

We have completed the review of all documents responsive to your request and have identified 13 pages which are responsive to your request. Enclosed are 12 pages released in their entirety, and 1 pages released in part. We have reviewed and have determined to release all information except those portions that are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 [(b)(7)(C)] of the FOIA.

The following exemptions are applicable:

Exemption (b)(7)(C) provides protection for personal information in law enforcement records, which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The types of documents and/or information withheld could consist of names, addresses, identification numbers, telephone numbers, fax numbers, or various other documents that are considered personal.

The enclosed record consists of the best reproducible copies available.

In the event you wish to appeal this determination, you may write to the USCIS FOIA/PA Appeals Office, 111 Massachusetts Ave., NW, 4th Floor, Washington, DC 20529, within 60 days of receipt of this letter. Both the letter and the envelope should be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."

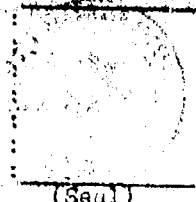

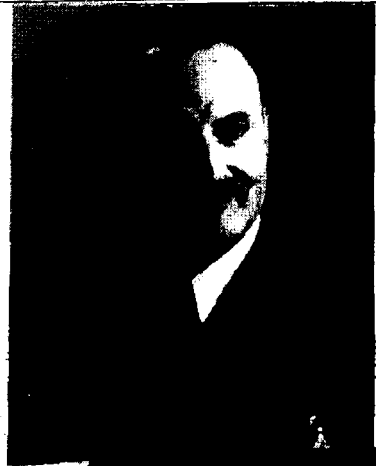
