Dear Alex Calzareth:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request received in this office August 4, 2006, regarding the subject: Hilde Wimpfheimer.

We have completed the review of all documents responsive to your request and have identified 9 pages which are responsive to your request. Enclosed are 8 pages released in their entirety, and 1 page released in part. We have reviewed and have determined to release all information except those portions that are exempt pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552 [(b)(7)(C)] of the FOIA.

The following exemptions are applicable:

Exemption (b)(7)(C) provides protection for personal information in law enforcement records, which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy. The types of documents and/or information withheld could consist of names, addresses, identification numbers, telephone numbers, fax numbers, or various other documents that are considered personal.

The enclosed record consists of the best reproducible copies available.

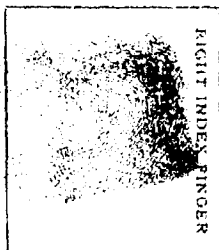

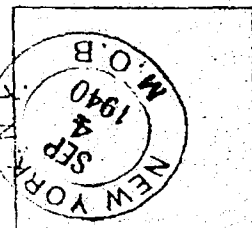

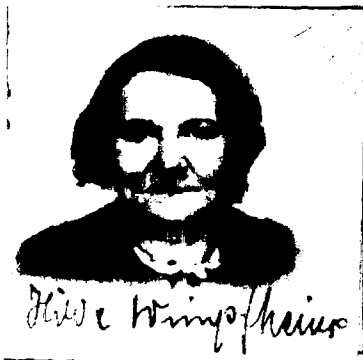
