BARRON PROJECT Y-DNA CLANS

August 2023

Within the Barron Y-DNA Project, there are currently 159 individuals who have done Y-DNA testing. Of these, 133 have been grouped into 14 distinct, unrelated Clans, and 26 Individuals are so far "Unassigned". Below you can see details for each clan and its members, and for unassigned members. Interestingly, a majority of the unassigned participants and all but one of the Clans descend from [Haplogroup R-M269](#).

CLAN 1 (Haplogroup R-M269)

Other Known Surnames related to Clan 1 OR due to Non-Paternal Events (NPEs): Anderson, Sykes, Taylor, Gordon

Currently, Clan 1 has two known branches – an English and American. Both branches descend from an Unknown Most Recent Common Ancestor b. about 1520, most likely in England. The English Y-DNA testers have their heritage in Cumberland and Durham Counties, England, as early as 1700. And Clan 1's American descendants most likely descend from a single immigrant, b. about 1620, either in England or the US (VA or MD) and who immigrated to St. Mary's County, Maryland before 1656. While his name is not known, he had at least 3 sons who lived to adulthood, George, John, and Thomas and possibly of 4th son, Rev. Robert Barron. Of these, Thomas, b. 1656 St. Mary's County, MD, had 5 known children that lived to adulthood, it is his son Thomas Jr, b. ca 1704, St. Mary's County, MD, from which the current American Y-DNA testers all appear to descend. Descendants of the American branch spread throughout the US South and Mid-Atlantic, with some lines moving to the Midwest.

Jon Andersen's work with refined Y testing of over 12 Clan 1 members (Family Tree DNA Y700 and Dante 30x tests), support the above deductions (see [analysis](#)).

<p>While the Most Recent Common Ancestor of Barron Clan 2 is not known, he likely was an Ulster-Scot who lived in Northern Ireland in the 1600s. There are clan members living in Northern Ireland, Australia and the U.S. who trace their ancestral line to one Archibald Barron who signed a land lease in Lisnaward, County Down, Northern Ireland, in 1713. CLAN 3 (Haplogroup R-M269)

Clan 3's Most Recent Common Ancestor may have been Joseph Barron, b. 1655 in Barbados, d. 1725 in Talbot County, MD. This line has been taken back several additional generations to Cambridge, England, with the earliest known ancestor identified as Richard Baron, b ca 1591. Currently, all members of Clan 3 who belong to the Barron DNA Project descend from an American branch of this family, which settled throughout the South.

Participant William Paul Barron, Jr. has the longest proven Barron lineage of any of the following participants. One of the objectives of this DNA project was to prove the connection between William Paul Barron's ancestral line and those of the other participants, in order to validate the proposed relationship between an early American Barron, James Barron (b. 1752) and his "lost" son, Caleb Barron (b. 1797).

Clan 9 and 10 have a documented Clan 3 ancestry thru the Caleb Barron (b. 1797) > Ezekiel b. 1838 > line - yet none of the individuals in Clan 9 and 10 match Clan 3 on Y-DNA. At several points, Non-Paternity Events (NPEs) occurred, so neither the Clan 9 or Clan 10 Barron lines carry the Barron Clan 3 Y-chromosome, nor does either carry the Y-chromosome of the other (Clan 9 does not carry the Y-chromosome of Clan 10 and vice-versa). An NPE could be an adopted/orphaned son who took the Barron surname from a guardian or stepfather, or an illegitimate son.

CLAN 5 (Haplogroup R-M269)

Clan 5 was initially formed from descendants of Samuel Barron (1780-1861), but Y-DNA matches show that an earlier ancestor of this clan was a Braswell male. Clan 5 Barrons also match a few Parkers, Carvers, Clarks and Sumners, indicating Non-Paternity Events on all these lines that connect their Y chromosomes to a common Braswell ancestor, possibly sometime in the 1700s or a bit earlier.

For Clan 5's Barron members— their Most Recent Common Ancestor (MRCA) as well as their Earliest Known Ancestor – was Samuel Barron, b. abt 1780 in Maryland, lived in Wilkes/Hancock/Warren/Upson Counties, Georgia, d. abt 1861 in Barbour County, Alabama. All members of this clan show close Y-DNA matches to a Braswell family, with earliest known ancestor Robert Bracewell (Braswell), b. 1611, England, d. 1668, Virginia. It appears that the Clan 5 Barrons carry this Braswell Y chromosome, shared by the Parker member, and Braswell/Brazell members. There may have been a Non-Paternity Event (NPE) with Samuel Barron, or a generation or two prior, where a Braswell male fathered this line (with a similar event occurring in the Parker line of this clan). An NPE could be an adopted son who took the Barron surname or illegitimate son

Clan 12 is a closely related group of cousins – with their Most Recent Common Ancestor (MRCA) being Joseph Barron b ca 1813 making James Frederick Barron a 2nd Cousin 1x Removed (2C1X) from Lance Barron and 2C2X from Max Mawby. Lance and Max's MRCA was Herbert Lawrence Barron b. 1892 making Lance and Max 1st cousins 1x removed (1C1X). What is interesting about their YDNA results is that while Lance and Max are 1C1X – it is James and Lance that match exactly on 37 of 37 markers, and yet due to a mutation Max has on the fast mutating DYS464 they match him on 36 of 37 markers for a Genetic Distance (GD) of 1. Which just underscores the fact that mutations can and do occur in any generation. Also interesting, is that the three of them only match each other and one other individual, even at Y12 and Y25 markers. The cause of that could be that YDNA testing hasn't been as common in Australia, and/or they have unique YDNA.

Clan 12's earliest known common ancestor was Thomas Baron b ca 1773 in Wigan, Lancashire, England who m. Frances "Fannie" Parkinson. Current Clan 12 members descend from Thomas and Fannie's son, Joseph Baron b ca 1813 in Wigan (m. 1835) Ann McCann, b. ca 1819, Roscommon, Ireland. Joseph, Ann and their children left England and arrived in New South Wales, Australia in 1842. Other children of Thomas and Ann emigrated to Fall River, Massachusetts where many of their descendants still reside.

Note that in general, while the spelling of their surname was Baron in England, it appears most of the Australian lines changed to Barron soon after arrival.

Clan 14's Earliest Known Common Ancestors was **Nicolas Baron (1645- after 11 May 1698)**, son of **Lupien Baron** (ca 1623-ca 1649) and **Jeanne Thiesson/Tierson**. Nicolas was born 17 Jun 1645 in Villenauxe-au-Grande, Troyes, Champagne, France. Nicolas, like his father, became a merchant butcher and between 1672 and 1676 he emigrated to what was then the French colony of New France (Nouvelle-France) settling on the island of Montreal (in what is now Quebec) where on 11 Nov 1676 Nicolas married Marie Marthe Chauvin, daughter of Pierre Chauvin and Marie Marthe Hautreux/Autreuil. In the early to mid-1700's, after France extended its claims to the South and West of the British Colonies (on down to the Gulf of Mexico, including the large French colony of Louisiana), some of **Nicolas and Marthe's** children and descendants migrated throughout New France. Some went south into New England while others went west into what is now the Canadian Province of Ontario and eventually were among the earliest arrivals into what are now the US States of Michigan, Ohio, and Indiana.

Of the latter, was **Joseph Barron** (1773-1843), grandson of **Pierre Lupien** (dit Baron/Barron or Sieur Barron)(1683-1744) (s/o Nicolas and Marthe) and his wife, Angelique Courant. Joseph had an aptitude for languages and having learned many dialects of various Native American tribes, at times, worked as an interpreter, messenger and envoy for then General William Henry Harrison (later President of the US), the Territorial Governor of the area NW of Ohio (territories of Michigan and Indiana and the District of Louisiana).

Clan 14 members also match another descendant of Nicolas Baron (s/o Lupien Baron). That individual has done his BigY-700 and is Haplogroup R-FTA59634. He and Charlie Barron have a GD of 2 at Y-37. Derek Lupien and the other tester's MRCA is **Michel Baron** b 1812 QC – d MA (m. Zepherine Boucher).
