Thomas and Rebecca (Bitters) Morris

Rebecca Bitters

The oldest daughter of Arnold and Mary Bitters was born January 23, 1792 in Northampton County, Pennsylvania.

Rebecca was eleven years old at the time of her father's death.

Little is known about her life.

We don't know when Rebecca married Thomas Middaugh of Lower Mt. Bethel Twp, Northampton County, Pennsylvania. As was common at the time, Thomas is approximately ten years older than Rebecca. He was born April 25, 1783.

In 1809, Thomas and his father participated in the incorporation of the Hunter Settlement Presbyterian Church.

They were the parents of 10 children:

- George B. Middagh, born 1828 in Northampton County, Pennsylvania and died March 9, 1860 at Lower Mt Bethel Twp, Northampton County, Pennsylvania
- Amanda Middagh, born October 08, 1833 and died December 2, 1849 at Northampton County, Pennsylvania
- Mary Ann Middagh, born Abt. 1839and her death date is unknown

Chapter VI Ancestry of my Grandmother Mary Middagh Mershon

Thomas Middagh and Wife Rebecca

"Unfortunately, I can record but little about the anœstry of my Grandmother Mershon, Mary Middagh, or "Middaugh," as it is also spelled. She was of Dutch descent, as were many others of our Antecedents. Her father's name was Thomas and he was born April 25, 1783. Like so many of our ancestors, he died before he reached the mark of three score and ten years (70) - on May 27, 1841. Since we have only the good old Bible name, Rebecca, by which to designate his wife, my great-grandmother, I can tell you only of her span of life, from January 23, 1792, to August 31, 1852."

Mary Middagh

The firstborn of Thomas and Rebecca (Bitters) Middagh, was born November 23 1809 at Northampton County, Pennsylvania

Mary was married to Jacob Bergen Mershon, who ws born October 13, 1808 in Middlesex County, New Jersey. The date of their marriage is unknown.

Jacob and Mary were the parents of

- George Middagh Mershon born July 22, 1847 in Richmond, Northampton County, Pennsylvania. George died February 28, 1929

Jacob died June 14, 1848 and Mary on June 23, 1874.

George Middagh Mershon married Henrietta McFall on December 30, 1869 in Easton, Northampton County, Pennsylvania. Henrietta was born November 23, 1843 in Warren County, New Jersey.

George Passed away Feb 28, 1929 and Harrietta followed on September 8, 1931 at Northampton County, Pennsylvania

Peter Middagh

The second child and oldest son of Thomas and Rebecca (Bitters) Middagh, was born August 25 1811, at Northampton County, Pennsylvania.

All that is known about his wife is her name was Eve

Peter and Eve were the parents of three children:

- Thomas Middagh born about 1842
- Emma Middagh born about 1845
- Andrew Middagh borrn about 1848

Census records as notorious as they are for being wrong indicate there was one male child under the age of 5 in 1840. This could have been Thomas or possibly another child born between 1835 & 1840 who died before September 27, 1850.
