

Will of Benjamin Hamm.

Know all men by these presents: That I, Benjamin Hamm of Miami County and State of Indiana, being of sound disposing mind and memory do make and publish this my last Will and Testament.

Item 1st I will and direct that all of my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of the first money coming to the hands of my executor, out of my estate.

Item 2nd. I will and bequeath to my children in equal shares all my personal and Real Estate or the proceeds of the same, viz. Emily, wife of John Fowinkle, Phoebe Ellen, wife of John Haggerty, John R. Hamm James D. Hamm, Alonzo C. Hamm and Eliza J., wife of Lafayette H. Lagg.

In ascertaining and determining the equal share to each of my said children, whatever notes or receipts I may have against each, the principal thereof shall be and is hereby charged as an advancement to such child, and my executor shall only collect if necessary and also charge each with any amount of unpaid interest that may be specified in said notes or receipts which is not endorsed thereon specifically.

Item 3rd. I hereby will and direct that my executor within a reasonable time after my death shall sell all Real Estate of which I may die seized, upon such notice as he may deem best, and upon such time terms credit, cash or interest upon deferred payments securing any unpaid sums by mortgage and other security by way of Insurance or personal security as may fully protect any deferred payments and I hereby authorize and empower my said executor to make, execute and deliver deeds in fee simple as such executor to said Real Estate.

Item 4th I hereby nominate and

appoint my son James D. Hamm, Executor of this my last Will and Testament, hereby authorizing and empowering him to do all and every act and thing necessary or required of him, to perform all the provisions of this Will. He shall not be required to give bond as such executor, and shall not be required to resort to court in the discharge of any duties as such executor. He shall probate this will, and may if he deems it expedient file a final report of his settlement, but shall not be required so to do.

Item 5th. I hereby revoke all former Wills and codicils thereto by me made
