"I Jedidiah Davis Clerk of the first Company of Infantry in the second battalion and second Regiment in the Cumberland Brigade Comanded by Capn John Hann Jr Do Swere that this enrollment Contains a Return of the names of the said Company between the ages of Eighteen and forty five years made to the best of my information knowl- edge and beleife and those persons whose names are noted absent Did not parade with and answer at the roll Calls of the Company on the twelfth day of June and that the deficiencies in arms and equipmentt are marked opposit the names of the Delinquents so help me God.

"At a Battalion Court of Appeals held at the Court house on the 30th Day of June 1806 thirty fined on this list.
