Cairo Grand Jury Cathes Twelve In Its Net.

Cairo, Ill, March 24 - Twelve indicatments for rioting were returned this afternoon by a special grand jury that has been investigating the attack on the Alexander county jail, February 17, during which one man in the mob was killed, and several injured by the sheriff's special deputies. Those indicted are: George F. Walker, newspaper man; Frantz Gorman, an alderman; James Davidge, a constable; C. O. Foster, former deputy circuit clerk; Lee Watson, stock dealer; Samuel Wessinger (sic Wissinger), special agent of the Big Four Railroad and deputy sheriff; W.H. Simpson, manager of a lumber company; James Casey, former policeman; J.B. Scott, blacksmith; W.C. Charles, liveryman; O.P. Hurd, Jr., president of a lumber company; Jon Maloney, wagon manufacturer. The twelve were immediately arrested and released on bonds. Their trail has been set for May 9, and funds for their defense will be raised by popular subscription. The indictments caused a sensation as no such drastic action was anticipated. A fine of \$500 and six months imprisionment is possible in cases of conviction. The mob was repuised while trying to take Jon Pratt, a negro purse-snatcher, from jail to lynch him. The grand jury is not through with its investigation, and further indictments may be returned.

Wissinger Killed to Protect Own Wife, Delcares Slayer Shot Sent Through Heart Following Abuse of the Sick Woman. Attacked Fires While Warding Off Stab by Pair of Scissors.

Death, with grim fingers already around the home of Mrs. Fannie Wissinger, 1605 East Monroe, who was fighting dread pneumonia, found plenty to do, when her father, George Small, and her husband, Emmett Wissinger, quarreled yesterday morning. In self defense, the father claims he

shot and killed Wissinger. The tragic affair was the culmination of a family quarrel, in which a divorce suit instituted by the wife played a part. The husband had been enjoined by the court from visiting the home of his estranged wife, which he violated. Going there at frequent intervals, he is said to have abused and harassed her. The wife had been sick for sometime with influenza that developed into pneumonia. Friday night, the husband occupied an adjoining room to where the sick wife fought the dread disease. According to her story, he entered the room Saturday morning and renewed his abuse.

Claims Self-Defense

She sent her son by a former husband to get her father to protect her. When he arrived, he found Wissinger in an angry mood, and words brought on an attack, which Small avers he tried to avoid. The husband defended himself against an assault with what he thought was a knife in the hands of Wissinger, and grabbing a revolver from the bed of his daughter, he fired the fatal shot which penetrated the heart. The shooting occurred at 11 o'clock. The officers were advised of the shooting, and when they arrived, they found the body of Wissinger in a pool of blood at the foot of the bed of his wife, who had been left there for nearly 30 minutes alone with the corpse. Speaking mildly, Small says, he attempted to avoid trouble and check the abuse of Wissinger. He will claim self-defense, and has a cut on one hand, which he says was inflicted by Wissinger, who was armed with a pair of old scissors.

First Husband Also Slain

Trouble has visited Mrs. Wissinger before. She is the widow of George Eddleman, who was killed about two years ago by a neighbor when they became involved over a blackberry patch. She had a suit for divorce from Wissinger filed on November 20 and a restraining order had been obtained by Mrs. Wissinger. It tool another tragedy in her life to bring her troubles with her second husband to an end. In her petition for divorce the wife alleges that since January 1, 1918, Wissinger had been guilty of extreme cruelty; had continually abused her, calling her vile and opprobrious names and compared her with a common street walker; that he had struck her and beat her, and continually threatened her life. She avers that on more than one occasion he choked her, and jumped on her stomach with his knees and injured her so severely that she has not yet recovered from the effects of this attack. When interviewed by a World reported yesterday afternoon at the county jail, where he was placed after giving up to the officers, Small said, "I am 62 years old and today noon was the first meal I ever ate off the county in my life. I have always been a law abiding man. This is the first time I was ever arrested in my life." His voice quivered as he told the story, of the tragedy in his daughter's home.

The record discloses that on August 22, 1925, a filling station on the outskirts of Tulsa, in charge of one Johnny Crowell, was held up and about \$25 taken from the cash register. A few days later defendant was arrested, charged with the offense. He is identified by Crowell as the person who committed the robbery. Defendant denied his guilt and offered evidence tending to prove an alibi.

Released from the Navy on June 1, 1946 he returned to Cairo. He got his GED and started college and studied for the ministry at Taylor University, Upland, Indiana. On Aug 16, 1948 he married Mary Elizabeth Wissinger and moved to Carbondale, Illinois to study at Southern Illinois University and be a student pastor to three small churches, Walgonville, Woodland, and New Shiloh, until he graduated on June 11, 1950. Kam Chumbler - A Leader On and Off the Court, Thursday May. 14, 2014 By Eric Chumbler

PADUCAH, KY - It has been a sad week for many in McCracken County and the surrounding area, as Kam Chumbler lost his life Tuesday to an accidental gunshot wound. He was just 20-years-old.

Kam was a distant cousin of mine, but I did not know him anywhere near as well as many you're about to hear from. Kam's legacy is deep. Deeper than his career at Lone Oak High School and McCracken County High School. Much deeper than that. Evidence of that was no clearer than at Baptist Health of Paducah's ICU waiting room earlier this week where hundreds of family, classmates, friends and even some strangers gathered to pray for Kam to pull through. Tears were shed along with occasional moments of laughter as hundreds of memories of Kam were shared

Kam's accomplishments were many. He was a member of the inaugural graduating class of McCracken County High School. He was captain of the first ever McCracken County Mustangs basketball team when they won the Second District Championship, First Region Championship and made an Elite 8 appearance in the KHSAA Sweet 16 Basketball Tournament. Kam was selected Varsity Most Valuable Player three years in a row, twice at Lone Oak High School, once at McCracken County High School. Kam was selected for the All District Team for three years, won All Purchase Player his senior season, he was an All Region Tournament Player for two years, First Region Tournament MVP, and a member of the KHSAA Sweet 16 All Tournament Team in 2014. Kam was the recipient of the Joey Fosko Scholarship Award, received Honorable Mention for All State Basketball and Academic All State for four seasons. He received a scholarship to play basketball for Shawnee Community College Basketball and was also a student and basketball player for West Kentucky Community and Technical College.

Kam was known on the basketball floor for being clutch. His nickname among many of his friends and teammates was "Kam2Clutch". It was a nickname much deserved. On February 21, 2013, Lone Oak was trailing Paducah Tilghman by one point, 49-48, with 31 seconds left in the 2nd District Championship game. Kam Chumbler received a back screen to fade to the left wing where he was passed the basketball and drained a three point shot with 20 seconds left to help Lone Oak win the 2nd District Championship over Paducah Tilghman, 55-54. Fast forward a year later as McCracken County took on Marshall County for the First Region championship. With the score tied at 41 in overtime with just seconds left, Kam Chumbler penetrated to the foul line where he lofted a shot up with one second left that took a trip around the rim and fell through the net, giving the Mustangs the regional championship in their first season, 43-41 over Marshall County.

I had a chance to talk to several people who Kam influenced heavily. I spoke with his high school principal, some of his high school and college basketball coaches, and one of his closest friends. Every single one of them, without solicitation from me, echoed the same word: Leader.

"Kam played a huge role in uniting the communities in our school last year. His passing has played just as big a role in keeping people united. He has always played a role in keeping us together. Kam has always been a unifier and a leader. People will always remember his clutch shots on the basketball floor, but his beautiful smile that was always contagious is what I'll never forget about Kam Chumbler". -Michael Ceglinski, Principal, McCracken County High School "Kam is what all coaches want out of their best player; a great student, a great player, and a great leader for all of their kids. What I liked about Kam is his actions would always reach the younger kids and guide them in a way to be

successful, not only on the basketball floor but also in life. He would always do what you wanted done on the first time you asked him. He went out and did the job you ask without complaint, and would always go further than you ever thought possible. We(McCracken) would've never won the First Region Championship without him. His attitude of unselfishness created an attitude of unselfishness among the entire team. I'm going to miss him seeing him. Athletics and sports has nothing to do with it, I'm just going to miss him stopping by for a visit." -Burlin Brower, Head Coach of the McCracken County Mustangs boys basketball team. "Kam was more than an excellent basketball player, he was an excellent person. Even as a freshman, teammates gravitated to him. That never stopped. He was impossible to dislike. He was fun to watch on the court but just as much fun to be around off the court. He was like gravity, the way people were drawn to him. Kam led by example. He made his teammates work harder just to keep up with him. He made everyone around him better." -Andy Poore, Kam's Head Coach at Lone Oak from 2010-2013 and Associate Head Coach at McCracken in 2014.

"Kam did anything that we asked him to do and excelled at it. He was a great teammate, he was a better person off the floor than he was on the floor and that says a lot. He was a leader and that was none more evident than when 12-15 of our basketball players were at the hospital multiple hours earlier this week. He took responsibility for everything that happened on the floor. He was a no-excuse kind of guy. Burlin Brower said it best in an interview on the Jeff Bidwell Show yesterday that when some people die, you have to exaggerate to come up with good things about that person. You don't have to do that with Kam. He was a great person and will be sorely missed." -Carl Johnson, Assistant Coach of Shawnee Community College.

"On the basketball floor, Kam was the leader. He was the core of everything we ran. He was the center of us getting fired up, he was in control of us getting into our sets, and he always set the tone for us. Outside of basketball, he was not only my best friend, but he was a brother to me. We always picked on each other and gave each other a hard time, but he would've done anything for me just like I would for him. He would do the small things like wake up earlier to pick me up for school so my parents wouldn't have to. He was kind, caring, and the best leader you could ever ask for. He was family." -Aaron Hayden, basketball teammate and close friend of Kam Chumbler.

I don't think I have to say much more than what those five gentlemen said. Kam Chumbler touched many lives. Quite possibly more than he ever realized. But he will never be forgotten.

On behalf of so many, thank you, Kam. Thank you for everything you did to bless so many in your 20 years with us.
