### POURED OIL DOWN HER THROAT

Jacob Wissinger Arrested for Abusing His Wife Last night.

Alderman Theodore Crawford was awakened from his slumbers last night by Mrs. Fannie Wissinger, who desired a warrant for her husband, Jacob Wissinger, on a charge of assault and battery. The alderman went to his office and after hearing the woman's statement issued the warrant. Officer Hoover arrested Wissinger later at his home, Third avenue and Seventeenth street and locked him up to await a hearing. In her information Mrs. Wissinger alleges that last night her husband struck and choked her and then attempted to pour kerosene oil down her throat. Afterwards he put her out of the house and locked the door. He claimed that no one could arrest him, but Officer Hoover promptly placed him under arrest.

Maybe that's where he got his start as a conductor? Anyway he said that he and his friend would work a while somewhere until a certain day arrived and one of them would look at the other suggesting "Time to move on"? And off they'd go somewhere else.

I have looked more than once trying to find record of him somewhere but have mostly been unsuccessful, that is until this last week when I found a record that I think is probably him, though there were lots of Louis Finks, and even some Louis/Lewis M. Finks, the statistics match his own.

Here's where I "found him" I think in a town halfway between Chicago and the Wisconsin State Border:
