BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCHES

FREDERICK G. HETTLER, the son of Jacob and Catherine Hettler, was born in Germany Nov. 20, 1827. He sailed for this country in 1854, coming six years before his parents did. He settled in Pennsylvania about two years, then lived in Marion for seven years, and then moved to Big Island Township, purchasing 100 acres of wild land in 1872. He, with the assistance of his sons, have cleared and improved the most of this farm, and erected suitable buildings. He married, in 1854, Catharine Pfeil, and three children crowned this union - Frederick, Mary and Jacob. Their mother died in 1864, aged thirty-five years. The following year he again married, Margaretta Haberman, and four children were born to them. This wife died in 1878, also aged thirty-five. **His third union occurred in 1879, with Lena Wissinger, daughter of Gottlieb and Margaret (Ritman) Wissinger, natives of Germany, and the parents of nine children, four living - Margaretta L., Louisa Lena, Jacob G. and William.** Frederick and three others are deceased. Mr. Hettler is an industrious and worthy citizen. He is a Democrat, politically, and himself and wife are members of the Lutheran Church.

GODFRIED LEFFLER (LOEFFLER), (PICTURE) president of The Marion Brewing & Bottling Company, whose portrait is shown on the opposite page, has been identified with the business interests of this city since 1854. He was born in Gruenwettersbach, Baden, Germany, October 15, 1829.

Mr. Leffler not only secured a good education in his own country but before he was 21 years of age had prepared for future independence by learning the stone-mason's trade. Thus equipped he came to America and in the city of New York learned the trade of bricklayer, and for a number of years he worked at these trades, first in the East and after 1854, at Marion. In 1858 he entered into partnership with his employer, William Culbertson, under the firm name of Culbertson & Leffler. Later, when James Culbertson was admitted to partnership, the name of the firm was not changed and the business was continued until 1871. In that year the partnership was dissolved and Mr. Leffler continued alone until 1880, when he admitted William Bland, one of his skilled employees, to partnership, and a general building and contracting business was carried on under the firm name of Leffler & Bland, until 1897, when Mr. Leffler retired from the firm. He was succeeded by his son, C. W. Leffler and the business was continued under the former name. During his active years in this line, Mr. Leffler erected many of Marion's handsomest and most substantial buildings, including the Court House, the Jail, the Opera House, a number of schoolhouses and many private residences. His work has contributed largely to the attractiveness of the city of Marion.

Since retiring from the above business connection, Mr. Leffler has interested himself in looking after a number of real estate investments and other business enterprises. He is president of The Marion Brewing & Bottling Company and is a stockholder in The Marion National Bank, The Prendergast Lumber & Coal Company, and The Marion Manufacturing Company. He owns a large amount of valuable property in city and county.

On December 14, 1851, Mr. Leffler was married to Louisa Wissinger, in the city of New York. She was also born in Baden, Germany, and came to America in 1847. They have five surviving children, namely: Jacob Gottlieb, a retired business man of Marion; Charles William, the leading builder and contractor at Marion; John F., also engaged in business at Marion; Louisa, wife of Fred J. Gottschall, of Columbus; and Bertha W., wife of Oswald Wollenweber, a prominent manufacturer and lumber and coal dealer of Marion.

Formerly, Mr. Leffler took a very active interest in politics, being a Democrat, but worked entirely for the success of his friends and his party, never being willing to accept office for himself. He is a leading member of the Evangelical Protestant Church. Fraternally he is an Odd Fellow. His residence is located at No. 252 South Greenwood avenue.

"CANCER OF STOMACH, Results Fatally After a Brief Final Illness.

For Years Mr. Leffler Has Been Closely Identified with Marion's Business Interests.

The death of Godfried Leffler, one of Marion's oldest and most wealthy and distinguished citizens, occurred at his home at No. 252 South Greenwood street shortly before 8:30 o'clock Friday evening. The demise was the result of a long illness with cancer of the stomach. Mr. Leffler had been suffering with cancer for more than a year but his final illness incident to death, dated back to last Monday afternoon when he first took to his bed. The same energy and ambition that characterized him as a business man, lingered with him until the end, making his fight with death a desperate one.

Last Sunday morning Mr. Leffler, followed his usual custom and attended the services at Salem's Evangelical church. He was apparently in ordinary health and was able to walk to and from the church. Monday afternoon, shortly after dinner, he complained of being weak and tired and retired to his bed. His condition gradually grew more precarious and on Tuesday the physicians gave no encouragement whatever for his recovery. The widow of the deceased has been critically ill, suffering from heart trouble and the attending physicians fear the shock of the husband's death will have fatal results.

Mr. Leffler was born in Baden, Germany October 15, 1829, making him nearly seventy-nine years of age.

He had been identified with Marion business interests since 1854. He was not only one of the largest real estate owners of the city but was president of the Marion Brewing and Bottling Co. and a stockholder in the Marion National Bank and the Prendergast Lumber and Coal company. Before he had reached the age of twenty-one years Mr. Leffler had prepared himself for future independence by attaining a good education and learning the stone mason's trade. When he came to America he located in New York City for a number of years where he learned the trade of brick layer. He came to this city in 1854, worked at his trade four years then entered into partnership with his employer, William Culbertson, under the firm name of Culbertson and Leffler. In the year 1871 the partnership was dissolved and Mr. Leffler continued alone until 1880 when he admitted one of his employees, William Bland, to partnership. Under the firm name Leffler and Bland, which stands to this day, a general building and contracting business was carried on and the business grew to be one of the largest and most successful contracting firms in the city. Mr. Leffler retired from the firm and was succeeded by his son, Charles W Leffler.

Many of Marion's magnificent buildings were erected under Mr. Leffler's supervision and his work has contributed largely to the attractiveness of the city. The opera house, the county Jail, the court house, a number of the school houses and many fine private residences were erected by him.

December 14, 1851 Mr. Leffler was united in marriage to Louise Wissinger, the wedding taking place in the city of New York.

She was also born in Baden, Germany coming to America in the year 1847. There are five children surviving in the family. They are, Jacob Gottlieb, a retired business man of the city; Charles William, of the contracting firm, Leffler and Bland; John F. a prominent local business man; Mrs. Louise Gottschall, of this city, and Bertha W wife of of Oswald Wollenweber of South Greenwood street, this city, Four brothers are also living, They are, John, Frederick and Andrew Leffler all well known business men of the

city; Christian Leffler of Marceline, Linncounty, Missouri, The deceased was an active member of Salem's Evangelical Protestant church and a liberal contributor to its support. He was a member of the local lodge of Odd Fellows but never took a particular active part in fraternal orders. Like all of his name, he was a thoroughly conscientious man and people of Marion will remember him as a citizen, noted for his thrift and industry and many sterling qualities.

Funeral services will be conducted from the home at 3 o'clock Monday afternoon, Rev. Joseph Reinicke to officiate. The services will be in charge of the Odd Fellows and the Druids lodges. Interment will be made in Marion Cemetery."

JACOB G. LEFFLER (LOEFFLER), capitalist of the city of Marion, and a prominent and representative business citizen, was born in the city of New York, September 17, 1852, and was three years of age when his parents, Godfried and Louisa (Wissinger) Loeffler, came to Marion. A sketch of Godfried Leffler appears elsewhere in this work.

Jacob G. Leffler was reared in this city and completed his education at Delaware, Ohio, and Poughkeepsie, New York. Upon his return to Marion, he engaged in a retail grocery business, which he carried on for a period of 33 1/2 years, being alone with the exception of five years when he was associated with his father. For some two years in his early life he was a clerk in a drug-store, but the greater part of his business career was identified with the grocery line. After retiring from the retail trade, he was manager for the Mezger-Court Company, wholesale grocers, for two years, and since then has been engaged in handling securities and looking after his own real estate. Mr. Leffler is one of the directors of the Marion National Bank and of the Marion County Bank; is a director and one of the executive officers of the Home Building, Savings & Loan Company; and a director of the Central Ohio Loan & Trust Company.

Mr. Leffler has been twice married. In 1886 he was united to Laura H. Buchsieb of Columbus, Ohio, and they have four daughters, namely: Mabel Louise, a student at Oberlin College; Clara Helen, also at Oberlin, Alma Amalia, a student in the Marion High School; and Ruth Violette. Mr. Leffler and family belong to Salem Evangelical Church, of which he has been a member of the official board for many years. Formerly he was very active in city affairs and served acceptably on the City Council. He is interested as a director, in The Marion Manufacturing Company and The Prendergast Lumber & Coal Company.
