## History of ELLEN HAYDOCK LANGTON

Ellen Haydock Langton was born 24 August, 1800 in Farrington or Ulnes Walton, Lancashire, England. She married James Langton in 09 April, 1826. The family resided at Cockabar Station near Erosion and Ulnes Walton, near Preston, Lancashire, England.

They became the parents of five children: Aaron, 16 July 1826; Mary Catherine, 5 December, 1827; John, 27 September, 1829; Seth, 13 May 1832; Robert, 8 March, 1835.

In 1852, they immigrated to Utah to be with the Latter-day Saints. They sailed on the ship "Ellen Maria" on 10 February, 1852; Ellen and her husband, two sons, Robert and John, a daughter and the daughter's son. Amherst Whitmore was Captain of the ship. Isaac C. Haight was in charge of the L.DS. Emigrants while they were at sea.

After an arduous journey, they arrived at the mouth of the Mississippi River in the Gulf of Mexico on 12 April, 1852. From there, they traveled up the Mississippi to St. Louis, Missouri, arriving the latter part of April. Here they became part of the First Perpetual Emigration Fund Company, with Abraham O. Smoot as leader.

They made camp on an elevation near Kansas City, Missouri to wait for wagons to be made. Here, tragedy struck the Langton family and other Saints in the party. Cholera broke out in the camp. James Langton, his wife Ellen and their sons, Robert and John, all died from the deadly disease about May 1852.

There is no written account of Ellen's callings or civic activities. She was a caring mother and a devoted disciple of the Lord who gave her life for her beliefs. Her posterity could profit well from her example of courage and faith.
