 and each and every of our Heirs, Executors and Administrators, jointly and
 severally, firmly, by these presents.

Given with our seals and hands this 29th day of December A. D.
 One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty five

The Condition of the above obligation is such, That if there be any lawful cause why
 Martin D. Kinard and Catyia A. Southworth
 should not be joined together in the Holy union of Matrimony, then this obligation
 to be void; otherwise, to remain in full force and virtue.
