Notes: The 1860 Slave Schedules show George as owning 1 43 YO Black Female Slave. He just recently married Ann Roland and has some of her family living with him. His wife, Mary Coontz, died in 1858. Emily, Edwin, Irene, Caroline (might be Cornelia) and Dianna are all children George had with his second wife, Mary Coontz. George and Ann had no children. This is the last census for George Waters. He died in 1869. The Ancestry.com transcription lists the last name as Walters.

I could not find the two children ( Irene and Dianna) or the widow (Ann) of George Waters in this census
