MEETING HOUSE HILL CEMETERY-located where D.A.R. Marker now stands, on Rte. 302, Redstone, on road to the Covered Bridge, which was destroyed by fire July 1975.

This was the first community cemetery in Conway. Some of the graves and stones were moved to the N. Conway cem., on Rte. 16, and some to the Conway Village cem. Many were destroyed when the new roadwas constructed about 1915. The following names are of persons buried in the old cem. whose stones were destroyed, but from old records, and personal recollections, are believed to have been burried there. This, too, was the site of the first Meeting House, with the cem. in the church-yard.

We know that the 2 wives of Joseph Odell were b. in this cem. by the entry in the Vit. Records of Conway. It would seem logical to think the others listed here, with the exception of Phebe & Mehitable Merrill, who died early, were b. with their husbands. There is no positive proof of this, but it seems almost certain that they were.
