(This is the land described in the will of Moses). Was on the census for Knox Co TN, 15th Subdivision in 1850. Family #1398 Lists Moses, age 49, farmer, born TN; Mary age 47 born TN; Susan age 22 born TN; John age 20 born TN; James age 19 born TN; Drury age 18 born TN; Marvel age 17 born TN; and a daughter which appears to be "Mira", but is undoubtedly a shortened form of Jamima age 16. This is probably why some researchers erroneously give Moses a daughter Mira. Milly Conner is also in the household. Age 71. on 8 Jun 1868 Knox Co. TN. See will text in notes. Moses E. died abt 1872; he was 70. Buried in Old Cox Family Cemetery, Knox Co. TN. She and Moses are buried in the old Cox Family Cemetery just off Old Maynardville Pike in Knox Co. Nationality: Mostly English.

After their marriage Moses and Polly lived on the old Curd Cox farm on Bull Run Creek until 1848 at which time Moses bought 93 acres in the 7th District of Knox Co. Later he bought a tract of land in the old 5th District of Knox Co. from John and Sevier Underwood, but he never lived on it He left this land to sons Marvel and Drury in his will 1

Moses Cox Will:

On the 8th day of June, 1868 Moses Cox wrote his will. It was presented to the court on the first Monday of June 1872. It is probable that he died early in 1872. Census records prove that he was still living in 1870. Mary was still living in 1880 according to census records. She was living with her son Curd. It was likely that she died in 1881 since her property was divided among the heirs in Jan. of 1882. She and Moses are buried in the old Cox Family Cemetery just off Old Maynardville Pike in Knox Co.

Moses Cox will:

In the name of God amen, I, Moses Cox of the County of Knox and State of Tennessee, being of sound mind and memory, and considering the uncertainty of the frail and transitory life, do therefore make, ordain, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament; that is to say, first, after all my debts are paid and discharged the rest of my estate, real and personal, I give, bequeath and dispose of as follows, to wit; To my beloved wife, the land and appurtenances situated thereon known and described as follows. Lying in the 7th District of Knox County beginning on a black oak on P. D. Bell's corner, thence N 5 E 43 poles to a rock, thence with Gibbs line to the race, thence up the east side of the race to a white oak, thence west to the spring branch, thence a north course 98 poles to a stake, thence S 45 W to James McClelland's corner, thence with the line of George Lammie's heirs and the line of Jane Crippen to the beginning during the time of her natural life, together with the household and kitchen furniture with all the wheat, corn and bacon on hand. One sorrel mule, one milch cow, six head of stock hogs. To my grand'daughter Jamima L. Jett one heifer calf. To my grand'daughter Rebecca Cox, daughter of James Cox deceased, the sum of one hundred dollars. To my two sons Drury Cox and Marvel Cox one tract of land in the 5th District of Knox Co. that I purchased of John and Sevier Underwood, adjoining the lands of T. L. George, O. H. Crippen and others, and the sum of fifty dollars each, all the rest residue of my personal estate and the tract of land that I have bequeathed unto my wife at her death I give and bequeath unto my heirs Curd Cox, John Cox, Milly Jett, Susan Mynatt, Gemima Hall and Ambrose and Moses Cox, sons of my Samuel Cox deceased, which said Moses and Ambrose to constitute one heir to signally divide between them,

share and share alike, that is to say the said Ambrose and Moses Cox is to have between them as much as either of the above named Curd Cox, John Cox, Milly Jett, Susan Mynatt, Gemima Hall and no more.

Likewise I make, constitute and appoint my sons Curd Cox and John Cox to be Executors of this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal. On this 8th day of June, 1868.

The children as listed for James Madison Cox have come from two sources. The "Ancestry and Posterity of the Lyles" and from Jewel Robinson who appears to have gotten much of her info from LDS and probably supplied to LDS by Pearl Cox, a descendant of James Madison. This line is considered unproven by this researcher until more work is done on it. Several names and dates are in conflict.

From the Lyle info it is given that James Madison was in TX by 1893. If the birthdate of 1888 and the birthplace of TX is correct for his son John, it appears that this family may have gone to Collin Co. TX at the same time his sister Charlottia and her family did.

My grandmother was the most really religious person I have ever known, she was not a fanatic, she really believed the Bible and could tell stories about what happened in those times and her stories sounded as though she knew the characters. She could tell the stories so real that you could pick out the characters so like the people of today. Grandmother would come to visit me after I had a family and she and I were very close. Sometimes she would stay a week or two with me and we spent a lot of our time discussing the Bible. We would talk about the families, the way she grew up and many things were were happening in the present day. Grandmother lived with us when I was a teenager and after I reached my 20's. I slept with grandmother for a number of years. We had a large utility room in mom's and dad's house. Grandmother and I would set up a quilt and spend hour after hour quilting. We made about 6 or 7 quilts before I married. I kept some of the for my hope chest and we made several for my mother. I must have been about 28 or 29 years old when I last saw my Grandmother. My Dad insisted that Mother send Grandmother back to Oklahoma to stay with her younger daughter, my mother was brokenhearted that she had to do that. I think maybe Mother saw her mothr maybe one more time before she died. Mother never forgave my father for that, she talked about it to me every once in a while. I felt very bad about it for her because I knew how bad she felt....

Services for Millie Catherine Hamilton, 91, were held Sunday in the First Baptist Church with Rev. Chalon Meadows officiating. Burial was at Mountain Park. Born Jan 12, 1860 she was married to Tillman Frank Cassaday before moving to Mt. Part in 1901. He died in June 1908. Notes from Jewell Hamilton Robinson:

When I knew my grandfather it was when they lived in Newkirk, New Mexico. They lived in a small one room house as I remember it, there were trees around the place. It seems to me my grandmother and granddad looked very old. I am sure that the reason he looked old to me was because I was so young. I liked them a lot. I remember very vividly that my granddad used to trap quails. he had a trap which was a box, covered with chicken wire, he placed feed into the box and the quails would go in to get the food and couldn't get out. I was very fond of the breast of quail so my grandmother would cook them for us. It seems to me that the house they lived in was a log house, or something that looked like logs. It seems that I still can picture this place in my mind. I don't know how old I was. I think I was about three years old. Granddad, I understand by a note from LaRue Stumbaugh, was buried in Navajoe Cemetery near Altus, Oklahoma. I think that is where they lived at the time I visited Grandmother, when my Dad and I and my sister Gene went to visit her. I was 18 years old, Gene was 2 years old and we took a friend with us. He was my boyfriend at the time. His name was Elmer Watts. My granddad died in 1928 and he is buried in the Navajo Cemetery in Altus, Okla. The most of his records are from his death certificate. His death was caused by influenza and Bright's desease. He was a merchant. They had a small grocery store. The information on his death certificate was given by an A. M. Hamilton. The death certificate says that he was widowed, but that is wrong. My grandmother lived for years after grandfather died...

Description: She Was Described By Her Grandchildren As A Soft Spoken, Really Good Woman. Almost All Of Her Children Were Sentimental Loving People Like Her. Nationality: About 1/16 Irish, 1/4 Scot And The Rest English.

Note: In 1911 in Mill Creek OK, a J. M. Cox owned a livery stable. It is not known what if any relationship this Cox had to Charlottia's family. Her brother James Madison was dead by this time and none of his children had the initials J.M. Her brother Moses Scott "Mote" had no children. Her brother William Jackson had none with those initials.

Charlottia had a very modern cookstove for her time. It was a big wood stove with a tank on it that held water. Heat from the stove kept the water heated for dishes, bathing, etc. It had a large warming oven across the top.

Research: Timelines:

1888 Bennie was born in Collins, TX. There is no Collins, TX. It could be Collin Co. or it could be Collinsville which is straight south of Gainesville.

1889 According to Melissa Ellen they were in OK and I'm betting Charlottia and her family were also here.

1891 Uncle Mack is born in Ardmore.

1893 Saphronia marries Joe Lett. Even though I have info from the Letts that says Joe went back to TN and married her, I'm betting he married her in Ardmore. He was known to go to Ardmore frequently to replenish his stock for his general store.

1894 Dessie is born in Thackerville. (That's straight south of Ardmore almost to the Red River).

1896 Dessie died and was buried at Nebo. That year my Grandmother and her twin were born near Mill Creek.

1899 Melissa Ann marries around Nebo.

1900 Aunt Madie was born at Mill Creek.

1902 Grandpa Marvel dies at Wanette (What in the world was he doing way up there?)

1902 Bennie dies and is buried at Nebo. Tragic accident

1904 Saphronia dies in Kiowa Co. Joe Lett takes Aunt Ada back over there to help him with the kids. My great grandparents end up in Cleveland Co. (July)

1905 Aunt Ada marries Joe in Kiowa Co.

1907 Eliza Ann dies at Tupelo. Near a son

Summary: From 1887 when they left TN until 1894 when Dessie was born, my great grandparents seemed to have been moving around a lot. In 1889 Marvel and Eliza were probably in Ardmore. By 1895, it appears that my great grandparents were in the Mill Creek area where they remained until 1904. It appears that Marvel and Eliza joined them there by 1899. Why Wanette in 1902 and Tupelo in 1907? (Note: later research found son James Madison in Tupelo)

These are the counties: Carter (Ardmore) Love (Thackerville) Johnston (Mill Creek) Coal (Tupelo) Murray (Nebo)

In 1900 it appears that they would all be on either the Johnston or Murray Co. census.

Another person to look for around them might be Mary, sister of Saphronia and Charlottia, who married James Acuff. I haven't found anything on her and don't know where they went. If there's a James Acuff around them anywhere, it's probably them.

More info about the town of Mill Creek can be found in notes at Jerome Lester, the husband of Leon's sister Sarah Ellen. It appears likely that the family lived somewhere west of Mill Creek and near Nebo. Nebo was seven miles from Mill Creek and is where two of Leon's c. in 1904 Cleveland Co. OK Territory. See the story "Grandma's Lilacs" by g granddaughter Lou Ann Murphy for info on the trip to Cleveland Co. Came to Cleveland Co. in 1904 (according to daughter Vestes on their way to Tillman Co., but Tillman co. was far the opposite direction). Stopped at White Mound in Cleveland Co. (area of Cedar Lane and Hwy 77) so Charlotte could give birth to Eddie Leon. The family had a cow and chickens and lived in their wagon. A nearby farmer had a cottc. Leon Cullis died in Norman, OK on 1 May 1943; he was 81. Before he died, he had been living for a couple of years with daughter Issa. Buried aft 1 May 1943 in Fairview Cemetery, Noble, OK. Occupation: Blacksmith/Farmer (Raised Cotton, Corn,

Feed Grain For Stock, & Ribbon Cane. Had The Reputation For Making The Best Sorghum Molasses Anywhere, Which He No Doubt Learned From His Family In TN Where For Some Of Them Molasses Was An Important Farm Product. Religion: Baptist. A Bit Of A Fanatic. Raymond Doussett (Nephew Of His Son-In-Law) Said Of Him That He Could Tear Apart A Church Faster Than Anyone Ever Saw. Like To Discuss The Bible But Was Most Fond Of Arguing Religion And Politic. Nationality: About 3/4 German And 1/4 Cherokee.

The spring after moving into their house east of Norman, baby Ed was asleep on the bed. Uncle Mack and Grandpa Cullis were sitting around the wood stove. The bed was in a corner of the room. A thunderstorm moved in and a lightening bolt came down the stove pipe, a ball of lightening rolled out in front of the stove, across the floor and went under the floor under the bed. It killed two dogs that were under the house. The twins were about 8 or 9 at the time. (From Cleta Loveless Jones, daughter of Vestes, one of the twins).

The farm had a 3 room L shaped house which had a divided side room that was part bedroom and part storage. There was a screened in front porch. A blacksmith shop was near the road and south of the house. In back of the house, between the house and creed were the farm animals and their barns and sheds.

5th of 10 children. First came to OK Territory with his brother John when he was about 18 years old. He worked for a doctor on the forks of the Red River (per his son Roy Lett). Once when Joe was traveling to Millcreek, OK from TX on horseback he was tired and spent the night in a roominghouse. When he got up the next morning and looked out the window, there were three men hanging from a tree. The proprietor of the roominghouse told him they were horse thieves. (from dau. Bertie Wilson). He stayed in OK for a while, possibly seven years, then went back to TN where he married Saphronia Cox. Joe and "Fronia" went back to OK to make thier home. OK was sod grass country. The grass was belly deep to their horses. They may have gone to Mill Creek first where Saphrinia's brother Moses "Uncle Mote" owned a gin. However, later they settled in Cache, OK. Joe and his brother hoped to draw land, but neither of them did. John went on to NM, but soon returned and lived in the Mt. Park area near

Cache, OK. Once a tornado blew his house away. Joe Lett had been worried about his brother and sent his son Roy to check on him. Roy found the house gone and John sick with the flu. They cooked and ate in the cellar. John had patched up an old hen house and they slept in it. Then Roy got the flu and had to stay several days.

Joe Lett had a general store (dry goods & groceries), a livery stable and a pool hall. He carried supplies from Ardmore to Cache sometimes taking three wagons. The trip often took from two to three weeks at a time because the river would be too high to cross. He also carried drummers (salesmen) around from town to town because he was known to have the fastest trotting horse in the area. In those days Cache was larger than Lawton. Lawton was only a "tent town". Now Cache is about 4000 and Lawton is 85,000.

After Saphronia died, Joe sold the store and went back to Millcreek, OK. He knew Ada Pearl Meltabarger since she was the daughter of Saphronia's odler sister. Ada returned to Cache with Joe to help him take care of his children and they married in 1905.⁶

"392 South High St, Salem, Oregon to E. E. Hamilton, 201 Prince St, Clovis, N. Mex c/o J. M Barnard (who was father of Gladys Hamilton, wife of E. E. Hamilton)" Note from Jewell Robinson, sister of E. E. Hamilton and person who provided the letter: "I have tried to copy this letter as near to her lettr as possible....This was a letter written shortly after the family left Clovis and came to Oregon. Erin had planned to join his parents in Oregon."

"Dearest Children:

I will write you as I am thinking of you so very often. Do hope each of you are well and happy at this writing. We are all able to eat what we get. I have been teasing Dad all the way out here about being so very hearty. He was mad if he could not find the onions. I told him I was going to put one in every pocket and tie one to his shirt tail so he would always have one when we stopped. They have sure been hungry all the time, it has taken quite a bit of money to buy our eats. I feel so thankful that we are all well as we are.

There is plenty of fruit and vegetables of all kinds to buy here pretty cheap. We are trying to get some kind of work so the rain won't interfere with us. Glenn is very anxious to locate. he wants to get us a place out on one of these paved streets going out from town aways and buy us cows, hogs and chickens, and then get a job in town so we can get started up and it won't cost so much. One can rent them pretty reasonable and you can buy a house here with as small a downpayment as \$100 on a \$1000 or \$1500.00 place. You can buy any kind of farm or trade of any kind or any price for a reasonable payment down. The best thing I can see about the people they are real friendly and sociable, and the next best thing they are not always talking blue, they say this is good enough. they won't try to hunt anything better.

They are all so anxious for the fall rains to start. they say everyone gets to feeling fine as soon as the rains start. The water here in town is not good it tastes bad but they say they are treating it now. But it is the softest wash water I have ever used it is better than rain water. Everything cooks so easy in it and don't boil dry hardly at all. Beans cook so quickly. Everything is paved you don't see anything hardly but paved streets and roads and surfaced

highways.

The fair starts the 7th of Sept and some of them say it starts raining about then, but the rains won't bother about coming the way we did. It might be all right to come thru Calif - as it won't be so hot when you get ready. The school don't start here until 14th of Sept.

We have not been thru a town since we got out of Mex that they had a "Spit and Whittle Club" or at least I have not seen one and I hope I never see another one. People seems to have some where to go or something to do.

The shows here are from 10 cents to 25 cents. The dances are 25 cents. We have seen 3 parks already. They have a penitinliary [spelled as she spelled it] here insane asylum, Girl's Reform school, Boy's school, so many things that would be of interest to go thru.

There are more churches here than I ever saw at least more different kinds for a town of this size. Montgomery Ward is putting in a new store here now. Sears has a big one. Safeway has a big one Peggly Wiggly and quite a lot of big grocerys. They close at 6 (week days) 7 on Sat.

Glenn and Dad is gone trying to get on something this morn. I am going to ans an ad where they want a man and wife to run a rooming house for their board and small wage and see what they say. I could get a job in the cannery at 27 1/2 cents per hour but Glenn don't want me to work and I don't have anywhere to leave D G [Doris Gene] There are more old women working here than any place I ever saw. They don't seem to mind age at all. Seems the older people have a good chance.

Erin I have seen so many old Model "T's" that I get tickled every time nearly. I don't believe these folks believe in spending their "mon" on cars they all build a home instead. The people most of them dress so very common and don't act big headed.

Dad harps about the rains coming he is afraid they will make us have the Rheumatism. I think mostly all that is the matter is he wants to drag on to Calif. Glenn says he is going to stay here until you come and if we can't get anything we can go some where else. They want to go down to Coravilis next Sunday if nothing happens. they tell me it is 38 miles down there.

With lots of love and the very kindest wishes and a kiss for the children.

There isn't aa child in this end of town where we live. Doris Gene is so lonesome. Mother

PS. Answer soon and let us know if you are coming and when you start and all along the way so I won't be so uneasy.

5th of 10 children. First came to OK Territory with his brother John when he was about 18 years old. He worked for a doctor on the forks of the Red River (per his son Roy Lett). Once when Joe was traveling to Millcreek, OK from TX on horseback he was tired and spent the night in a roominghouse. When he got up the next morning and looked out the window, there were three men hanging from a tree. The proprietor of the roominghouse told him they were horse thieves. (from dau. Bertie Wilson). He stayed in OK for a while, possibly seven years, then went back to TN where he married Saphronia Cox. Joe and "Fronia" went back to OK to make thier home. OK was sod grass country. The grass was belly deep to their horses. They may have gone to Mill Creek first where Saphrinia's brother Moses "Uncle Mote" owned a gin. However, later they settled in Cache, OK. Joe and his brother hoped to draw land, but neither of them did. John went on to NM, but soon returned and lived in the Mt. Park area near Cache, OK. Once a tornado blew his house away. Joe Lett had been worried about his brother and sent his son Roy to check on him. Roy found the house gone and John sick with the flu. They cooked and ate in the cellar. John had

patched up an old hen house and they slept in it. Then Roy got the flu and had to stay several days.

Joe Lett had a general store (dry goods & groceries), a livery stable and a pool hall. He carried supplies from Ardmore to Cache sometimes taking three wagons. The trip often took from two to three weeks at a time because the river would be too high to cross. He also carried drummers (salesmen) around from town to town because he was known to have the fastest trotting horse in the area. In those days Cache was larger than Lawton. Lawton was only a "tent town". Now Cache is about 4000 and Lawton is 85,000.

After Saphronia died, Joe sold the store and went back to Millcreek, OK. He knew Ada Pearl Meltabarger since she was the daughter of Saphronia's odler sister. Ada returned to Cache with Joe to help him take care of his children and they married in 1905.⁶
