### Family A

Heinrich Hiestand, b. 1570. d. 11 Sep 1653, Richterswil, Zurich, Switzerland. He married Anna Luthold. She was an Anabaptist.

1. Jung Hans Hiestand, b. 1605, Richterswil, Zurich, d. after 1659, Ibersheim, Hesse, Germany. He married Verena Appli. She died 20 Nov 1679, Richterswil. They were Anabaptists.

11. Hans Hiestand, b. 21 Mar 1630, Richterswil. He married Regul Aeschmann on 4 Oct 1651. She died after 1670. Hans married second on 6 Aug 1672 at Richterswil, Anna Strickler, daughter of Jacob & Barbel (Leeman) Strickler. His children were all born at Richterswil.

111. Margretha Hiestand, b. 1652. d. 22 Jan 1654.

112. Anna Hiestand, b. 25 Nov 1655. d. 19 Jan 1657.

113. Anna Hiestand, b. 1 Jan 1657. She lived at Richterswil in the 1671, 1682 & 1695 census.

114. Kungold Hiestand, b. 10 Jan 1658, Richterswil. d. after 1710, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. She married first Michael Reiff (1652-1684) of Mettenheim near Ibersheim and second Hans Stauffer (1644-aft 1710) in 1685. She was living at Ibersheim in 1679. She was living at Alsheim near Ibersheim in 1705 and again in 1709 when she left for Pennsylvania. She had one daughter by Reiff and four by Stauffer who all went to Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. She was also known as "Kinget".

115. Casper Hiestand, b. 8 Feb 1659, Richterswil. He was living at Ibersheim, Hesse, Germany in 1679. He was probably a Mennonite. He was not listed as a Mennonite at Ibersheim in 1685.

116. Klianna Hiestand, b. 21 Sep 1660, Richterswil. She died at Richterswil 5 Jun 1713.

117. Hans Hiestand, b. 29 Dec 1661, Richterswil. He died 15 Dec 1726, Richterswil.

118. Verena Hiestand, b. 23 Jul 1665, Richterswil. She was living at Richterswil in 1708.

119. Susan/Anna Hiestand, b. 5 Sep 1667, Richterswil. She was living in Richterswil in 1695.

110. Elsbeth Hiestand, b. 24 Oct 1669, Richterswil, She was living at

Richterswil in 1695.

11A. Hans Jacob Hiestand, b. 26 Feb 1671, Richterswil. He married Verena Zuricher at Richterswil by 1708.

11B. to 11I. there are 8 more children by his second wife.

12. Elsbeth Hiestand, b. 25 Sep 1631, Richterswil. She was living at Ibersheim, Germany in 1657. She lived with her brothers in Richterswil, Zurich in 1671.

13. Anna Hiestand, b. 1635, Richterswil. She left Richterswil before 1695. Was she married to Joseph Reiff?

14. Klinann Hiestand, b. 1637, Richterswil. d. Ibersheim, Hesse, Germany. She was living at Ibersheim in 1657. She married Hans Jacob Brubacher of Ibersheim in about 1658. They were Mennonites. Some of her children went to Pennsylvania.

15. Conrad Hiestand, b. 1640, Richterswil. d. after 1685, Ibersheim, Hesse, Germany. He was living at Ibersheim in 1657 and 1669. He was living at Ibersheim in 1685 with five children and two step-children. His two step-children may have been the children of Hans Conrad Egli, named Hans Conrad Egli and Abraham Egli. See Family "B".

16. Hans Rudolph Hiestand, b. 7 Feb 1641, Richterswil. d. 31 Dec 1706, Richterswil. He married Margaret Strickler on 26 Nov 1676 at Richterswil.

17. Heinrich Hiestand, b. 2 Sep 1645, Richterswil. d. unmarried. He probably went to Ibersheim as a young man but returned to Switzerland as he was living at Richterswil in 1682 with his brother Hans Rudolph. From Richterswil records it was noted that Heini died unmarried and his brother Konrad was an Anabaptist and is said to be in the Kurpfalz in Ibersheim and had several male progeny.<sup>1</sup>

18. Hans Heinrich Hiestand, b. 1647, Richterswil. Heinrich went to Friedelsheim, Bayern, Germany from Ibersheim in March of 1665 with Heinrich Gochenauer, Heinrich Schnebeli and Hans Peter to purchase the hof there. Only Gochenauer, Schnebeli and Peter actually made the purchase, probably because Heinrich was still a too young. He was listed however as a tenant living at Friedelsheim on April 21, 1665. By 1672 he left Friedelsheim and was again living at Ibersheim in 1685 with his ten children. He was probably the Mennonite minister living at Ibersheim in 1709 and who was mentioned by Hans Stauffer (b. 1644) of Alsheim in his notebooks. See Family "C".

19. Jacob Hiestand, b. 1649, Richterswil. He was living at Ibersheim in 1669, but was not called an Anabaptist. He was not listed at Ibersheim in 1685.

### Family "B"

Conrad Hiestand, b. 1640, Richterswil, Zurich, Switzerland. d. after 1685, Ibersheim, Hesse, Germany. He was a Mennonite living at Ibersheim in 1657 and 1669. He was a Mennonite living at Ibersheim in 1685 with five children and two step-children. See Family "A".

1. Conrad Hiestand, b. c1668, Ibersheim. He was married to Katharina Opmann, probably the daughter of Peter Opmann who was a Mennonite living at Ibersheim in 1685 with his three children. Conrad was still living at Ibersheim in 1715.

11. Johannes Hiestand, b. c1700. d. before 1743, Ibersheim. md Agnes Stauffer of Gerolsheim. He was a Mennonite living at Ibersheim in 1738. His widow was living at Ibersheim in 1743 with two sons and one daughter. His wife Agnes was listed on the tenant list at Ibersheim on 27 Feb 1745 as Johann Hiestand's widow Agnes. In 1753 Conrad Hiestand was the owner of this same farm but sold it that same year to Heinrich Seitz.

111. Conrad Hiestand, b. c1728. d. c1754. He owned his father's farm in 1753 but sold it that same year to Heinrich Seitz. He is not found in any records after 1753 which may indicate that he emigrated with his brother in 1754, but died before the ship arrived in Philadelphia.

112. Heinrich Hiestand, b. 1731. d. 1795, Hempfield Township, Lancaster County. He arrived in Philadelphia on 30 Sep 1754, age 23 on the ship "Brothers" with his brother-in-law Johannes Forrer, Johannes Seitz and others from Ibersheim. He was taxed at Hempfield from 1756 to 1758 as a married man. He was not taxed at Hempfield Township again until 1792. He may have been the single man taxed at Manor Township from 1769 to 1772. In 1785 he bought and sold some land in Hempfield Township from Christian Newcomer without a wife. His sister Maria Luft lived at "Overshiem" (Ibersheim), Germany in 1795 according to Heinrich's will which was written in 1795. He wrote his will 6 Apr 1795 and it was proved 9 May 1795. He left 50 pounds money to his sister Mary Luft of Overshiem, Germany. He left money to his nephew Daniel Forrer and the rest of his estate to his niece Elizabeth Smith. His trusty friend Henry Hiestand (c1735-1805) of Manor Township was appointed executor. The witnesses to the will were Christian Newcomet and John Newcomet. He had no children.

113. Maria Hiestand, b. 10 Oct 1739. d. after 1795, Ibersheim, Hesse,

Germany. md Jacob Brubacher (d. before 1792) of Ibersheim. md 2) Mr. Luft.

12. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1702. d. by 1753, Ibersheim. He was a Mennonite minister of the Ibersheim congregation in 1732. He lived at Ibersheim in 1738. He lived at "the gate" in Ibersheim in 1743 with his wife and one son. He was listed on the tenant list at Ibersheim on 27 Feb 1745.

121. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1730. d. 1782, Ibersheim. md Elisabeth, supposedly a Neukommet. He lived at Ibersheim in 1753 with his wife and one son and it stated that he received his farm from his father. He lived at Ibersheim in 1759 with one child. He lived at Ibersheim in 1768. On 1 Feb 1768 he was listed as a leaseholder at Ibersheim with his wife Elisabetha and two heirs. He was still living at Ibersheim on 6 Nov 1772. On 10 Jul 1784 it stated that he had died about two years ago and the farm was inherited by his two children and is now run by the oldest son Jacob Hiestand, who had three children.

1211. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1753. md Barbara Kägi. On 10 Jul 1784 he was the tenant at Ibersheim having taken over his father's farm and now lived on the farm with his three children. He lived at Ibersheim in 1792 having inherited his farm from his father Jacob. He was "Vorsteher" at Ibersheim in 1803.

12111. Elisabetha Hiestand, b. 1777, Ibersheim. She died 27 Dec 1841 at Ibersheim. She married first Johannes Kagi (30 May 1769-24 Oct 1803, Ibersheim). She married secondly Heinrich Stauffer (23 Aug 1775-21 Apr 1837) of Ibersheim.

12112 Barbara Hiestand, b. 15 Nov 1779, Ibersheim. md Jakob Berki and lived at Sandhof.

12113. Katherina Hiestand, b. c1782, Ibersheim.

12114. Maria Hiestand, b. Dec 1784, Ibersheim. d. 18 Oct 1838, Wendelsheim, Hesse, Germany. She married Christian Eicher (12 Dec 1783-1 Feb 1856) of Wendelsheim on 2 Aug 1811.

12115. Veronica Hiestand, b. 17 Jun 1786, Ibersheim. She died at Ibersheim on 18 Sep 1855. She married Rudolph Forrer (1788-1854).

12116. Jacob Hiestand, b. c 1790, Ibersheim.

1212. [?] Elisabeth Hiestand, b. c1760. md Heinrich Seitz of Ibersheim in about 1780.

13. Anna Hiestand, b. c1704. md Heinrich Seitz of Ibersheim.

2. Heinrich Hiestand, b. c1670. md Barbara Mellinger on 25 Nov 1694 at Friedrichstadt, Holstein, Germany. He lived at Amsterdam, Holland in 1714. He was accepted back into the Mennonite Congregation at Friedrichstadt in January 1715, without a wife. He was a Mennonite.

3. Catherina Hiestand, b. c1674. She married Johan Jacob Müller of Ibersheim in

about 1699.

### Family "C"

Hans Heinrich Hiestand, b. 1647, Richterswil, Zurich, Switzerland. Heinrich was a Mennonite who went to Friedelsheim, Germany from Ibersheim, Germany in March of 1665 with Heinrich Gochenauer, Heinrich Schnebeli and Hans Peter to purchase the hof there. Only Gochenauer, Schnebeli and Peter actually made the purchase, probably because Heinrich was still a minor. Heinrich was listed as a tenant living at Friedelsheim on April 21, 1665. By 1672 he left Friedelsheim and was living at Ibersheim in 1685 with his ten children. He was probably the Mennonite minister who was mentioned by Hans Stauffer (b. 1644) of Alsheim in his notebooks. See Family "A".

1. [?] Hans Jacob Hiestand, b. c1667, Friedelsheim. d. between 1732 and 1738, Friesenheim. He was a Mennonite minister and went to Friedrichstadt, Holstein on 13 Oct 1693 with his wife and child and other members of the Ibersheim Mennonite Congregation to escape the war. He married secondly as "a widower with child" to Anna Beyer on 29 Apr 1694 at Friedrichstadt. He returned to the Pfalz on 9 Apr 1698 with his wife. He lived at Friesenheim, Bayern in 1711, 1717 and 1724 and finally in 1732 as a Mennonite deacon.

11. child, b. c1692, Ibersheim.

13. daughter, b. c1697, Friedrichstadt. md Michael Kägi of Friesenheim in about 1718.

2. [?] Heinrich Hiestand, b. c1669, Ibersheim. He left for Friedrichstadt, Holstein on 13 Oct 1693 with a number of Mennonites from the Ibersheim Congregation to escape the war. He married at Friedrichstadt on 20 Feb 1698, Maria Gochenauer, probably the daughter of Heinrich Gochenauer. He lived at Herrnsheim near Worms, Hesse in 1698 when his daughter Elisabeth was born.

21. Elisabeth Hiestand, b. 15 Nov 1698, Herrnsheim. d. 5 Nov 1727, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. md Abraham Schwartz (Nov 1701-1785). According to Abraham Schwartz' bible record they were married on 4 Apr 1723 by Hans Burkholder of Gerolsheim, Germany and she was born at Herrnsheim, the daughter of Heinrich Hystandt. They were Mennonites. They arrived in

Philadelphia on the ship "Friendship" on 16 Oct 1727 with a large group of Mennonites.

22. [?] Veronica Hiestand, b. c1700. d. after 1754, Brecknock Township, Lancaster County. md 1) Hans Schnyder (c1697-1734) in about 1720. md 2) Peter Good of Brecknock Township by 1740. She emigrated in 1720 and lived at Hempfield Township with her first husband.

23. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1702. d. 1772, Hempfield Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. md Elisabeth (d. c1788), widow of Newcomer. He arrived in Philadelphia on 16 Oct 1727 on the ship "Friendship" with his sister Elisabeth and brother Johannes and a large group of Mennonites. He was naturalized as a Mennonite in February 1728 at Lancaster, signing the petition as "Jacob Hiestandt". His two signatures are identical. He was taxed at Hempfield in 1751 and in 1756 on 300 acres, next to John Rife and Henry Hiestand and 1758 and 1759 next to Jacob Hiestand Jr. and finally in 1769 on 50 acres next to Abraham Hiestand.

231. Jacob Hiestand, b. 1732. d. 1808, Hempfield Township, Lancaster County. He was taxed at Hempfield Township in 1759. He was married to Margaret.

2314. Jacob Hiestand. d. 1816, Hempfield Township. He was married to Barbara. He did not mention all his children in his will.

234. Abraham Hiestand, b. 17 Apr 1739. He died 18 Apr 1772, Rapho Township, Lancaster County. He married in April 1764, Barbara Long, daughter of Herman & Anna (Hershey) Long. He left four minor children.<sup>2</sup> Ludwig Metz of Rapho township was their guardian.

24. Heinrich Hiestand, b. 27 Sep 1704. d. 5 Oct 1779, Shenandoah County, Virginia. He moved from Hempfield Township, Lancaster County to Shenandoah County, Virginia in 1743. He probably arrived in Pennsylvania in 1726. He was naturalized as a Mennonite in February 1728 at Lancaster, signing the petition "Heinrich Hiest\_\_\_" (damaged). His wife died on 12 Jan 1777. Her name is unknown. He owned land in Hempfield Township in 1741 next to Jacob Hiestand. He sold his land in Hempfield in 1743 and bought land in Orange County, (later Shenandoah County) Virginia on 21 Sep 1743 from Philip Long.

241. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1734, d. 1795, Shenandoah County, Virginia. He is mentioned as his father's oldest son in his father's will.<sup>4</sup> He married Maria Elizabeth Brumbach. He received his father's land. He divided his land among his children in 1788.

2411. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1757. He was married to Mary by 1798.

2412. Abraham Hiestand, b. c1760. He was married to Magdalena by 1798.

2413. Mary Hiestand, b. c1762. She was married to David Stouder by 1788.

2414. Elizabeth Hiestand, b. c1765. She was married by 1788 to Christian Pixler.

2415. Madlena Hiestand, b. c1768. She was married to Frederick Diceus by 1788.

2416. John Hiestand, b. c1770. He was married to Barbara by 1798.

2417. Joseph Hiestand, b. c1773. Unmarried in 1798.

2418. Samuel Hiestand, b. c1776. Unmarried in 1798.

248. Mary Hiestand, b. c1752. She married Andrew Gimlin on 5 Dec 1773. She moved to Kentucky. She was called the youngest daughter.

25. Johannes Hiestand, b. c1706. d. c1784, Manor Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. He married Elisabeth Ocher (Eicher). He arrived in Philadelphia on the ship "Friendship" on 16 Oct 1727, signing his name "Johannes Hiestandt". He

was naturalized at Lancaster in February 1728 and signed his name “Hannes Hiestandt”. Even though he signed his name as Johannes on the ship list and Hannes on the naturalization petition, the hand writing is identical. He warranted 150 acres on 23 Jun 1741. He lived at Manor Township and was taxed there from 1751 to 1759.

251. Barbara Hiestand, b. c1733. She married Michael Witmer (1719-1763). She died by 1785.

252. Henry Hiestand, b. c1735. d. c1805, Manor Township, Lancaster County. He inherited his father’s 150 acres in Manor Township. He married Esther Risser, daughter of Peter and Elizabeth (Hershey) Risser. He was taxed at Manor Township from 1769 and beyond 1793. He was the executor of his father’s estate on 2 Mar 1785. He bought 150 acres in Hempfield Township from the heirs of Jacob Reiff on 20 Apr 1757. He sold that land on 22 Feb 1760 with his wife Esther to Christian Swarr. He signed the deed in German script.

2521. John Hiestand, b. c1759 d. Oct 1797, Donegal Township, Lancaster County. He married Ann. His children were under age in 1797. The executor of his will in 1797 was his brother Peter Hiestand, brother-in-law Jacob Hershey and friend Christian Hershey.

3. [?] Maria Hiestand, b. c1671. She went to Friedrichstadt, Holstein, Germany in 1693 with Heinrich Hiestand from the Ibersheim Mennonite Congregation to escape the war.

4. [?] Anna Hiestand, b. c1674. She was baptized at Friedrichstadt, Holstein, Germany on 11 Jul 1696. She probably married Hans Strickler as his second wife. They returned to Ibersheim in 1698.

5. [?] Abraham Hiestand, b. c1676. His son Jacob's Bible inscription states that he received his bible from his father Abraham Hiestand. He is not found in Pennsylvania records which may indicate that he died on the ocean voyage to America in about 1724.

51. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1700. d. 30 Mar 1769, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. He married Anna Schelli (b. Aug 1703), sister of John and Michael Shelley of Lower Milford Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania. He emigrated in about 1724. He was taxed at Hanover Township, Montgomery County in 1734 on 150 acres. He had a Bible which he wrote he received from his father Abraham. The birth dates of his children are listed in his Bible. He wrote his will on 27 Mar 1765 and it was proved 6 Jun 1769. He was married to Anna. The executors of his will were his sons Jacob and John. He listed his children in his will as Jacob, Abraham, Isaac, Madlena, Margretha wife of Martin Clemmer, Barbara wife of Abraham Beyer, Ann wife of Samuel Detweiler, Mary wife of Leonard Metz, Elizabeth wife of Abraham Stauffer, Susanna and Magdalena.

511. Jacob Hiestand, b. Sep 1725. He may be the Jacob Hiestand who lived at Milford Township, Bucks County in 1780.

512. John Hiestand, b. Apr 1726. He was alive in 1781 according to his uncle John Shelley's will.

513. Margreth Hiestand, b. Oct 1728. She was married to Martin Clemmer by 1765.

514. Barbara Hiestand, b. Nov 1730. She married Abraham Beyer by 1765. She was alive in 1781, according to her uncle John Shelley's will.

515. Abraham Hiestand, b. Dec 1732.

516. Anna Hiestand, b. Nov 1734, New Hanover Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. She married by 1765, Samuel Detweiler (c1735-1808) who

died at Rockhill Township, Bucks County.

517. Isaac Hiestand, b. 29 Sep 1736.

518. Maria Hiestand, b. Apr 1739. She married Leonard Metz (9 Nov 1739-23 Jun 1797) on 21 Jun 1763.

519. Elizabeth Hiestand, b. Apr 1741. d. 1817, Colebrookdale Township, Berks County. She married Abraham Stauffer (Dec 1734-1813), son of Jacob Stauffer of Colebrookdale Township.

510. Susan Hiestand, b. 3 Jan 1745. She was unmarried in 1765.

51A. Madli Hiestand, b. 9 Aug 1747. She was unmarried in 1765. She may have married Christian Borneman by 1781.

52. Abraham Hiestand, b. c1703. He emigrated in about 1724. He was living at Swamp, Bucks County, Pennsylvania when he was naturalized in 1734. He may have married a Stauffer.

521. daughter, b. 3 Apr 1730, Buck County, Pennsylvania. Her birth was found in the Peter Stauffer Bible. Peter Stauffer's family lived at Salford Township, Montgomery County and later at Bedminster Township, Bucks County.

6. child.

7. Hansel Hiestand, b. c1680. d. c1744, Ibersheim, Hesse, Germany. He was a Mennonite living at Ibersheim in 1738 next to Jacob Hiestand, his son. In 1743 he lived at Ibersheim with his wife, one son and one daughter in his household. He died by 1745 as he was not listed as one of the hereditary tenants at Ibersheim.

71. [?] Barbara Hiestand, b. c1704. She married Jacob Müller of Ibersheim.

72. Maria Hiestand, b. Nov 1706, Ibersheim. d. 20 Sep 1761, Mannheim, Baden, Germany. md Martin Möllinger (1698-1774), Mennonite minister of Monsheim, Hesse and Mannheim, Baden. Martin wrote a family history in 1766 and named his wife Maria as daughter of Johannes Hiestand.

73. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1710, Ibersheim. d. 1756, Warwick Township, Lancaster County. md Anna Brubacher (b. 1722), daughter of Abraham Brubacher of Ibersheim in about 1738. He lived at Ibersheim in 1738 listed with Hansel Hiestand, his probable father. He lived at Ibersheim in 1743 with wife, one son and one daughter. He was listed on the tenant list for Ibersheim on 27 Feb 1745. He emigrated from Ibersheim in 1752.<sup>6</sup> He arrived in Philadelphia on 30 Sep 1752 on the ship "St. Andrew". Jacob bought 69 acres from Jacob and Mary Everly in Warwick twp., on 3 May 1753 next to Michael Schenk. This land went to his son John in 1762 who later

that same year sold it to his step-father Henry Hackman. His widow Anna, married secondly in Lancaster County in about 1757, Heinrich Hackman (b. 1731), emigrant of 1753 from Ibersheim.

731. John Hiestand, b. c1740, Ibersheim. He lived in Lampeter Township in 1762 when he transferred his father's land to his step-father Henry Hackman. He was the oldest son.

732. Maria Hiestand, b. c1742, Ibersheim.

733. Elizabeth Hiestand, b. c1745, Ibersheim. She was a minor in 1762 when she chose John Brubaker of Manor township as her guardian.

734. Abraham Hiestand, b. 1749, Ibersheim. He was under age 14 in 1762 when Jacob Eberly was appointed his guardian. He may have been the Abraham Hiestand who was married to Juliana and who baptized a daughter at the Manheim Lutheran Church in 1781. Juliana may have died in child birth and he may have been the Abraham Hiestand of Warwick Township who married Anna Maria Weybrecht of Manheim Township on 7 Apr 1781 at Trinity Lutheran Church at Lancaster. Abraham Hiestand was fined at Warwick Township 1783/1786 for refusal to bear arms.

7341. Salome Hiestand, b. 18 Jan 1781. She was baptized at the Manheim Lutheran Church in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania on 22 Apr 1781.

735. Anna Hiestand, b. c1751, Ibersheim. She was under age 14 in 1762.

736. Jacob Hiestand, b. c1754, Lancaster County. d. c1757. According to the orphan court he was dead by 1762, as a minor child.

74. Johannes Hiestand, b. 1712, Ibersheim. d. Lehigh County, Pennsylvania. md Barbara Wenger, daughter of Henry Wenger of Pottstown, Chester County, Pennsylvania in about 1735. He arrived in Philadelphia on the ship "Britannia" on 21 Sep 1731, age 19, signing his name on the ship list next to Jacob Hackmann, age 20.

741. Ann Hiestand, b. 1738. She died 20 Feb 1817. She married Mennonite minister John Gehman (1741-1806).

742. Veronica Hiestand.

743. Magdalena Hiestand.

744. John Hiestand, b. 10 Apr 1742. d. 10 Nov 1817, Allen Township, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania. He married Mary Newcomer (1747-1812), daughter of Samuel Newcomer.

7441. Susanna Hiestand, b. 1778. She died 1847. She married Peter Jung.

7442. David Hiestand, b. 1783. He died in 1839. She married E. Swartz.

7443. John Hiestand, b. 1785. He died in 1863. He was unmarried.

7444. Elisabeth Hiestand. She married P. Geissinger.

7445. Anna Hiestand, b. 1781. She died in 1832. She married the Mennonite minister Christian Bleam (1773-1831), son of Christian Bleam Jr. and Salome Longacker of Pottstown, Pennsylvania.

745. Henry Hiestand.

746. Abraham Hiestand, b. 9 Jun 1748. He died 2 Jan 1832 in Bucks County, Pennsylvania. He married Ann Allebach (1758-1839).

747. Jacob Hiestand, b. Apr 1750. He died in Bucks County. He may have married first, Elizabeth and secondly, Catherine Musselman in 1784.

748. David Hiestand, b. 31 Aug 1755. He died 27 Dec 1846 at Spring City, Chester County, Pennsylvania. He married Elizabeth Bechtel.

749. Isaac Hiestand. He died in Columbia County, Ohio.

740. Elizabeth Hiestand.

75. [?] Christian Hiestand, b. c1715. d. 1753, Ibersheim. md Elisabeth in about 1739. Elisabeth was possibly a sister of Rudolph Forrer, as Rudolph was the guardian of her children in 1753. Rudolph was the son of Johann Jacob Forrer. She also named her oldest son Johann Jacob. She married secondly Heinrich Seitz of Ibersheim in about 1757. Christian's name does not appear on the census lists for the years 1738 nor 1743 so it is not known where Christian lived in 1738 and 1743. Christian probably lived at Mannheim, Germany when a "Mennonite Hiestand" buried a child there in 1744. He returned to Ibersheim and bought a farm there on 7 Apr 1753 from Ulrich Hackmann's heirs. On the tenant list for 1753 it states that he had 6 persons in his household. In 1759 his widow and her husband Heinrich Seitz had six children in their household. Heinrich Seitz had only one child by Elisabeth, so it appears that Elisabeth was pregnant in 1753 when her husband Christian Hiestand died. She apparently had five children by Christian besides the child that died at Mannheim. In 1768 it stated that she had four heirs living from her first marriage and one heir living by her second marriage.

751. Johann Jacob Hiestand, b. c1740. d. 1765, Ibersheim. md Anna Maria Stauffer on 20 Apr 1762 at Ibersheim. In the marriage contract he was called the son of the deceased Christian Hiestand and Anna Maria was called daughter of Daniel Stauffer of Guntersblum. One of the witnesses was Martin Möllinger, probably Johann Jacob's uncle. He was on the list of Ibersheim tenants on 12 Nov 1762. Johann Jacob took over his father's lease but after Johann Jacob's death his mother and step-father Heinrich Seitz expelled his widow Anna Maria from the property in 1766. Through appeals of Anna Maria's father Daniel Stauffer, she was allowed to stay on the farm until 1775. Anna Maria married secondly, Heinrich Forrer in about

1767. On 10 Jul 1784 tenant list it mentioned that Heinrich Forrer owned the land of Christian Hiestand that was bought from Ulrich Hackmann's heirs. Johann Jacob was a Mennonite.

7511. [?] Elisabeth Hiestand, b. c1764. md Johannes Berki of Ibersheim in about 1793.

752. Elisabeth Hiestand, b. c1742. md Daniel Stauffer of Ibersheim on 20 Apr 1762 as his second wife. In the marriage contract she was called the sister of Johann Jacob Hiestand who married on the same day. Daniel Stauffer was called widower and hereditary leaseholder at Ibersheim at his marriage. They were Mennonites.

753. child, b. 1744. d. 28 May 1744, Mannheim.

754. [?] Johannes Hiestand, b. c1746. md Elisabeth Hackmann, daughter of Johannes Hackman of Ibersheim. He received the hereditary tenancy of 1/24 of Ibersheim from his mother-in-law. They lived at Ibersheim as hereditary tenants with 2 heirs on 1 Feb 1768. He sold his farm in Ibersheim to Heinrich Kaegy and emigrated in 1770 with Daniel Stauffer from Ibersheim. He may have been the Johannes Hiestand who was taxed at Cocalico Township from 1773 to 1778 and then gone. In 1777 he had 100 acres, 2 horses and 3 cows. Johannes was a Mennonite. He lived at Cocalico Township on 8 Mar 1775 when Anna Maria Hockman, minor child over age 14 of John Hockman, late of Germany chose him as her guardian. The previous guardians had been John Stouffer and John Witmer.

7541. child, b. c1766.

7542. child, b. c1768.

755. [?] Magdalena Hiestand, b. c1750, Mannheim. She married first Abraham Seitz (d. before 1792) of Ibersheim. She married secondly Heinrich Forrer of Ibersheim. They lived at Ibersheim in 1792. They were Mennonites.

756. Christian Hiestand, b. c1753, Ibersheim. d. after 1792, Ibersheim. md Katherina Forrer. He was a Mennonite tenant at Ibersheim in 1789. He was living at Ibersheim in 1792 where he owned part of the Hof and had seven children. He was apparently living on Christian Neukommet's farm in 1789 and by 1792 he apparently took over the farm of Jacob Forrer at Ibersheim.

7561. Elisabeth Hiestand, b. c1781, Ibersheim. md Johannes Kägi (30 May 1769-24 Oct 1803) in about 1800.

7562. Katharina Hiestand, b. c1783, Ibersheim. md Jakob Dahlem.

7563. Johannes Hiestand, b. 12 Apr 1785, Ibersheim. md c1810, Elisabeth Janson.

75631. Abraham Hiestand, b. 5 Jun 1814, Harxheim. reported at Ibersheim.

7564. Rudolph Hiestand, b. 3 Jun 1787, Ibersheim.

He lived at Heppenheim in 1759 as a linen weaver with his wife and no children. He was still living at Heppenheim in 1768.

9. [?] Barbara Hiestand, b. c1683. This Barbara's maiden name is not known but she may have been a Hiestand. She married Heinrich Neff and emigrated in 1717. Heinrich Neff surveyed land for John Hiestand, possibly his nephew in 1736 in Lancaster County.

0. Catherina Hiestand, b. 1685, Ibersheim. d. 1755, Mannheim, Germany, age 70 years. md 1) Jacob Eichacher (1694-26 Apr 1748). md 2) Johann Jacob Hackman (1697-1765). Both husbands died at Mannheim.
