Marvin Dale Dies in Utah Truck Collision

Marvin Dale, 33 of Gill, Weld Co., CO, was killed in a three-truck collision on a stretch of Highway 91. The accident occurred at four miles north of Mona, Utah.

A north bound tanker truck crosse the center line and collided with two southbound trucks. All the trucks were traveling without cargo. Dale's companion, Charles Lindsey of Payton, CO was taken to a hospital in Salt Lake City, Utah, where he was reported in critical condition.
