D.C. Smith Is Victim of
Heart attack Monday

Well known local resident succumbs while en route
to his home in this city

David Hiram DeWitt Clinton Smith, aged 72, who resides at the corner of Locust and Sixth avenue, dropped dead of a heart attack at 4:30 yesterday afternoon at the corner of Vine and Sixth Avenue, a block from his home, as he was en route home from mowing the yard at the home of Mr. and Mrs. H.W. Woosley, of West Garland Street. Mr Smith was a native of Greene County, being born on a farm west of this city, and had resided in Paragould since 1919.

Funeral services will be conducted at 3:30 this afternoon from the family residence, and burial will be made in Liberty cemetery. The Rev. Will Hopper, Church of Christ minister, of Arbyrd, Mo. will officiate.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Christian Smith; two daughters, Mrs. Tom Dubar of Red Onion, and Mrs. Eugene Queen of Paragould. Five sons, Frank Smith of Hornersville, Mo., Sam, Oscar, Eunie and Walter Smith, all of Paragould. 15 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
