SHE KILLED TWO.

Mrs. Janbert Shot Hasband And Brother-In-Law.

Men Attacked Her And She Fired In Self-Defence.

A Garoner's Jury Is Called And Folly Exonerates The Woman.

Carbondale. III., July 18.—The Jaubert brothers, who operated a small coal mine near Oraville, were both shor to death at their home, early today by the wife of one of the men.

They had returned home about midnight, and the husband demanded his supper. Mrs. Jaubert undertook its preparation, and her husband began breaking dishes and at last attacked her

In self defense, Mrs. Jaubert fired three shots into his body, causing in stant death.

The brother then took up the quar rel, and attempted to strike the wor an, whereupon she also shot and killed him.

The woman was exonerated by the coroner's july.
