

SHE KILLED TWO.

Mrs. Jaubert Shot Husband And Brother-In-Law.

Men Attacked Her And She Fired In Self-Defence.

A Coroner's Jury Is Called And Fully Exonerates The Woman.

Carbondale, Ill., July 18.—The Jaubert brothers, who operated a small coal mine near Oraville, were both shot to death at their home, early today by the wife of one of the men.

They had returned home about mid night, and the husband demanded his supper. Mrs. Jaubert undertook its preparation, and her husband began breaking dishes and at last attacked her.

In self defense, Mrs. Jaubert fired three shots into his body, causing instant death.

The brother then took up the quarrel, and attempted to strike the woman, whereupon she also shot and killed him.

The woman was exonerated by the coroner's jury.
