Mayo of Madison County, State of Tennessee, of the one part and Joel Mayo and Haray Mayo of the other part, both of said County and State; Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, one thousand of which is to me in hand paid, and the other five hundred payable the 25th of December, 1851, for which they have this day executed to me their note under seal, I, the said Council B. Mayo, have bargained, sold, aliened and conveyed, & do hereby convey unto the said Joel Mayo & the said Haray Mayo, their heirs and assigns forever, the following described tracts of land, lying, situated, and being in the County of Madison, State of Tennessee, in the 8th civil District.

The first - Bounded as follows: Beginning at a black oak 135 poles South & 70 poles West from the South East corner of Entry No. 541 for 50 1/2 acres in the name of Stephen Lacy, Jr. runs thence East 140 poles to 2 hickories and black jack; thence South 96 poles to a stake; thence West 140 poles to a post oak; thence North 96 poles to the beginning - containing 84 acres, be the same more or less.
