


I do appoint my wife and my son Benjamin Cannefax my Executors to wholly & Sollyly Execute this my last Will and Testament



I Strother L. Gilleland of the county of Greene and State of Missouri do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say - First, it is my will that my funeral expences and all my just debts be fully paid. Second I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Ann Gilleland my servants, Harry, Esther

and Joseph during her time or their good behavior to work or hire for her service or to Educating our children, otherwise she shall sell them at Private Sale or Public Sale and the money immediately put to the use of purchasing other slaves, and at her death the said proceeds shall go to the use and benefit of our heirs, also my plantation she shall have during her Natural life time or widowhood, also she is to Keep up and repair the fences, house, stables &c also all the Household and Kitchen furniture also I leave her three of my horses namely snip, Bald Eagle and Lucetta, and three choice cows and calve wagon and oven, and all my flock of sheep, and one Thousand pounds of pork. I want all my hogs fattened that is fit to fatten and she is to have Fifty Barrels of corn at the day of sale which sale must be last of February or first of March - And she is to have all the farming utensils and all the stock hogs. She is to have One Hundred Bushels of wheat if it is raised, she is to run a cross fence along the North side of James Delzelli's corn across my field, also another fence to commence on said cross fence sixty yards below the South corner of my timothy patch and run north to a lone Black oak in John Griffiths Corn. thence East to the horse lot, and to commence another cross fence at the draw bar and run West across the field - and she is to break the unbroke ground as she can conveniently and to sow it in Blue grass and hard grass or clover as she pleases, also all the balance of my property to be sold at the sale and after all my just debts are paid the first hundred dollars that comes to hand is to be put to use of Entering this Eighty acres of land that my house and spring is on.

Third. Proposals made between parties first of my Estate is able and money can be procured. The second Hundred Dollars is to be paid to Thomas R. Griffie for his dower in his fathers land. Also the Third Hundred dollars to Nathan Abernathy for his dower in the same land, The Fourth Hundred dollars to be given to John J. Griffie for his dower in same land, and they all three are to warrant and forever defend the right and title of said land from all persons whatsoever and as soon as that can be done the land must be sold according to law and one half of the money to go to the use of my wife and the other half to the benefit of my children Fourth - all the Scales and proceeds of the above to go to my children. And lastly, I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Mary Ann Gilleland & Joseph A. Renshaw to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament, revoking and annulling all former wills by me made and ratifying and confirming this is other, to be my last will and Testament. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 12th day of October 1843.
