Henry Evilsizer (son of 'Old Jacob') born ca 1777, married Betsy (Elizabeth) Idle/Eitel on Nov. 6, 1798 in Botetourt Co. VA. Henry moved his family to OH, and it is here in Champaign Co. OH that the chart continues. Henry died ca 1849 in Champaign Co, OH Henry and Betsy had twelve (12) children:

Henry Evilsizer was in the 1810 Census of Virginia in Kanawah Co. which is now West Virginia.

Henry is in the 1818 Tax Record for 86 acres in Johnson Twp. of Champaign Co., OH.

When he died, on Nov. 12, 1849, a petition for real estate sale by sheriff to heirs was found. No mention was made of his wife, Elizabeth, sons Leonard and Abram.

We believe Henry to be the son of 'Old Jacob' as we have fondly begun to refer to the patriarch of the family.

Squire Evilsizor, born May 10, 1812 in Virginia. He was a native of the Shenandoah Valley and came to Champaign County, Ohio with his parents in 1815 when he was but 3 years old.

The family settled in Mad River Township, Champaign County on the David Pennee farm within a mile east of the Nettle Creek Church. The church was northern located more probably thought of, as about where it now stands. There were camped in large numbers the red men of the forest (Indians). With the younger of these, Squire played with in his boyhood days as it was his pleasure to often relate.

He and his future wife Christiana Comer both grew to maturity here in Ohio and married on a farm near St. Paris, Ohio. They married in 1832, when Squire was but 20 years.

Squire worked as a farm hand, but later farmed for himself. He died in Tremont City at the age of 84 years, and his wife, Christina died here at 79 years. They were members of the Hickory Grove Church.

Squire was first a Whig, then later a Republican. To this couple were born eleven children, of whom ten survived him. Also surviving were 56 grandchildren, and 27 great-grandchildren.

Isaac was a farmer and began a sawmill business in the Champaign County area. Isaac married Effie Rilla Lippencott Evilsizor (b. DEC 25, 1856; died SEPT 24, 1930) To this union were born four children:

The following data was sent by Sharon Durels of NY:

JOHN EVILSIZER, born April 2, 1783, believed to be a son of 'Old Jacob' was married in Rockingham County; VA on August 24, 1809 to Mary Peters. JOHN was listed as a shoemaker and was baptized in Berks Co. PA at the St. Paul Lutheran & Reformed Church in Amityville.

JOHN was bound over by "OVERSEERS of the POOR" to a Christopher How (SP?) on June 22, 1789 in Rockingham Co., VA. He was 6 years old...

IOHN and Mary (Peters) EVILSIZER had two children:

- 1. John Evilsizer: born 1814 in VA, married Mary (Polly) Arnold ca1834-40; died 1887 in Wood Co., OH In 1860 John & Mary lived in Jackson Twp., Guernsey Co., OH. John was a minister and his children are:
 - 1. Ebenezer Evilsizer; born 4/10/1841; died 7/20/1902 in Wood Co., OH

Ebenezer served in the Civil War and was a Private in Company E, 122nd Regt. of the Ohio Volunteer Infantry Ebenezer was reported 150 lbs. 5'8", blue eyes, fair complexion, light hair. He was captured in Winchester, VA on June 15, 1863 and held at the Libbey Prison at Richmond, VA & Belle Island Prison, exchanged on July 23, 1863, and later discharged on June 26, 1865. After his discharge he lived in Wood County, then later moved to Noble County, Ohio. Ebenezer had 7 children with his first wife, Elizabeth Baker. After her death, he married Susannah (King) Hardesty. She had two sons with Ebenezer, George and Ottis. After Ebenezer's death, Susannah refused to qualify as guardian of her two sons and they were placed in Xenia Orphan's Home for Children of Soldiers & Sailors. Court appointed Mr. E.T. Dunn of Findlay, OH on July 21, 1911.

2. William Evilsizer; born 1816 in Belmont Co., OH; married twice; died August 8, 1905 in Wood Co., OH and buried in Hancock County, OH.

According to the 1850 Guernsey County census, living next door to JOHN and Mary were William and Hester Evilsizer. William and Hester had three children (George, William W., James H.F.). William was 32 years old.

Thirty years later a William shows up in the 1880 Census in Henry Twp. Wood County at age 64 living with Mary age 27; and John age 6 months.

January 20, 1900: page 8 "Mrs. Theodore McKinley and Mrs. Charles Hupp were entertained at the home of Mrs. Lewis Evilsizor."

March 3, 1900: Page 15 "Isaac Evilsizer is seriously sick with lung trouble."

March 24, 1900: Page 19 "Charles Evilsizor, who has been ill with lung trouble for several weeks at the home of his brother, Isaac Evilsizor, was able to be at his old home in Tremont for a short time yesterday. His many friends were glad to see him."

June 24, 1900: Page 41 "Noah Reed, Jacob Broadstone, Lynn and Peter Reed, Irvin Evilsizor, Manie Evilsizor, Charles Layton, John Gharon and John Spahr will go to Ironton and Ohio river Sunday morning via Ohio Southern excursion.

Amy Evilsizer was in Salt Lake City Utah this spring and found some Evilsheiser's in the LDS Library. She found "Old Jacob" with a birth date of 1768. She found him at St. Paul's Luthern and Reformed Church Records in Amityville, Berks County, PA. He was married to Elizabeth and they had 3 children:
