Obituary:

of William Evilsizor Sr. in Microfilm reel at Urbana Public Library, Champaign Co, OH
Newspaper: "Champaign Co., O. Democrat" 11 August 1892

"William Evilsizor Senior, was born in Kanawha County, Virginia, June 8th, 1808. He departed this life July 25, 1892 at the age of 84 years, 1 month, and 15 days old. He emigrated to Champaign County, Ohio, with his parents about the year of 1814, and settled on the farm of Abram Pence, now owned by Mr. W.S. Garett. He was a resident of this county upwards to 75 years. This county at this time was dense forest, compared with the present. The red man and wild animals were common features then. Many were the trees that had to be felled in order to make way for our present homes, and it is certain that the deceased did his share of the work for his was the life of Industry, economy, and honest integrity. By exercising these qualities he prospered, sufficient to gain means which placed him beyond want.

He was twice married. At the age of 21 years he was married to Nancy Jenkins. To their happy union was born 13 children, 7 sons and 6 daughters. After a lapse of 29 years, their happy union was served by the death of the wife which occurred Feb. 15, 1858, at the age of 44 years. He was married again May 26, 1859 to Frances Jane Allison. To their union was born 7 children, 4 sons, and 3 daughters. After a duration of 26 years their union was served by the death of the second wife which occurred March 31, 1885, at the age of 54 years. He lived with his first wife a term of 29 years; and with the second 26 years.

To them in all was 20 children, 11 sons, and 9 daughters. All lived to maturity but 3. Two little boys of the first wife died, the first was of 3 years of age, and the second was of 6 months. One boy of the second wife, Johnny, age of 15 died suddenly while at school.

Three other of the first wife died, each of them leaving families: Allen, age 44, who body was interred in the cemetery at Nettle Creek; Sara Jane Nesbitt, age 48, was interred in the cemetery at Mahomet, Ill.; Mary Margaret Clark, age 27, was interred in a beautiful cemetery at Urbana, Ill. In the fore part of last month, the writer had the privilege of visiting the graves of the latter two.

About 14 years ago, Father Evilsizor united with the Harmony Baptist Church. He was baptized by his own brother Henry who was a minister in the Christian Church. To his Church he proved faithful until death.

Of this family death has now removed a loving and kind father, mother, and stepmother, 4 brothers, and 2 sisters, while 7 brothers, and 7 sisters with a large number of grand and great grandchildren, with 2 aged brothers of the deceased, Squire and Allen, besides a large circle of relatives and friends mourn their loss of the departed father.

He was a tender father here

And long his life the Lord did spare,

We trust our Lord....."

please note: Kanawha County is now in the state of West Virginia and not Virginia. William Evilsizor and both wives are buried in the Nettle Creek Cemetery, Champaign County, Ohio. This used to be a Baptist Church and Cemetery. The old church is now owned and used by the township trustees. The cemetery is still in use, as of 1989.

In the little digging that I was able to do, I found the first three individuals who migrated to Indiana from our known group of ancestors were brothers, Allen and Leonard Morris Evilsizer, and Abram. They died in Jay CO Indiana in 1893 and 1885 respectively with no death date for Abram. They were children of Henry and Elizabeth (Betsey) Idle... I have very little further data on these men. Does anyone else have anything? See microfiche records of Indiana on next page refering to Anna Marie and Eveline....

CLARIFICATION:

In the last newsletter, an article printed contained reference to Jacob and his link to Hessian soldiers. The letter that Sharon Durels received went on:
" ... Jacob returned after or in 1782 to Germany and married 23.11.1783 his cousin Anna Elisabeth Ibelshauser, daughter (sic) of Johann Just and Martha Elizabeth Ibelshauser. The marriage was in Dodenhausen. "

They seem to have had only one child, the daughter (sic) Anna Elisabeth, born 5.8.1787 in Dodenhausen, died in June 1863. The family probably did not return to USA. Thus we have the theory/fact of two different Jacob Ubelshauser/Ibelshauser.
