Comment on Inquiry:

Chas. Bartling Evilsizer. "It was the prisoner in Texas that my brother, Ivan in Montana, found in his legal database. He was released on parole in March 1992 and was reported as "absconded". (Not reporting to his parole officer,) and was supposed to have a warrant out for his arrest. I called last month and as of that date, he was still 'at large.' I just recently purchased the "Social Security Death Benefits Master File" on CD-Rom and he is listed as "DEAD". He evidently died in May of 1992 at the address that he gave as his forwading address from prison. I have applied to the County for a copy of the death certificate. Will keep you updated... Mr. Evilsizor was a graduate of Oak Grove High School in 1933, and of Holbrook College with a Bachelors Degree in 1937. He also attended Wittenberg College, Cedarville College, and University of Cincinnati, where he earned his Master of Education Degree in 1952. He served from 1941-1945 in the United States Air Force in the European Theater. He was discharged with the rank of Captain. He taught at Rome High School from 1937-1941, Zanesfield high School from 1945-1952, Bellefontaine City Schools from 1952-1956, and was Elementary Supervisor at Logan County Schools from 1956-1978. He was a member of the Bellefontaine Lions Club, the Ohio School Supervisors Association, and was Charter President of the Lions Club.
