Hazel appears in the 1920 Census Columbiana Co, E Liverpool Ohio, a foster daughter for Lee and Elsie Herbert.

Indiana March 22, 1964 in Clay Co, TN.

Gene and Cyndie Evilsizer of Troy and the late Rickie Whitenack of Muncie IN, parents of the bridegroom, Benjamin Andrew Whitenack who married Loredana Carmen Petrun-garo in 2004

Darline Evilsizer died Jan 26, 1936 Franklin Co, Buckner, IL age 1 year. (No Evilsizer families in Franklin Co, IL for 1930 Census, need to identify parents)

Has another death on same day for **Nadine Evilsizer**, age 1 yr. possibly twins.

Edith Evilsizer born c1902 married Melvin K Merrick 9/16/1922 in Wexford Co, MI. She was the daughter of Norman A Taylor and May Evilsizer. Norman and Carrie May are found in the 1910 and 1920 Wexford Co, Michigan census, both say they were married 2 times. There is a step-son named Forest Warner indicating Carrie must have married previously to a Warner. This Carrie May (Evilsizer) was born c1875 in Indiana and her parents born in Pennsylvania. It is not known who she is.

C Eugene Evilsizer, storekeeper, Second Class was aboard the USS Highlands, the first troop transport to anchor near the enemy capital on V-J Day, Charles B Evilsizer, Fireman First Class was aboard the Aircraft Carrier Cabot also in the Navy occupying force. Both brothers saw action at Iwo Jima, Okinawa and several other engagements of the Pacific War-They are sons of Mr and Mrs H B Evilsizer, 1235 Otto Blvd.

Secret Indictment Against John Evilsizer (which John is this?)

Denial Made to Perjury Charge

Secret Indictment is Returned Against John Evilsizer
John Evilsizer, carpenter, was brought before Common Pleas Judge F M Krapp Tuesday and arraigned on a secret indictment returned against him by the Grand Jury Monday charging perjury. He pleaded not guilty and was released on \$1000 bond, signed by Roscoe Keefer and Carl Follrath. The indictment against Evilsizer

alleges that during a trial of a suit of James W Circle against Evilsizer in the common please court recently, Evilsizer testified falsly. The suit was over \$250 commission Circle claimed was due him from Evilsizer on the sale of a residence. Evilsizer testified in the case, the indictment recites, that he did not know that the men to whom he sold a house was sent to him by Circle, whreas, it is alleged, he did know the man was sent to him by Circle.



FOUND CONNECTION

Sarah Evilsizer was born 1818 in Rockingham Co, AV the daughter of **John Evilsizer and Mary Peters**. Last we knew when the book was published was she married John Sigman and we had no further record.

John Sigman died 7/29/1844 in Guernsey Co, OH. He married Sarah May 21, 1835 in Guernsey County, OH.

Later census records show they also had children Hulda and Melissa. And Mary Ann She is found lastly in the 1880 census.

Sarah and Elias are both buried in Lebanon Cemetery in Lawrence Co, Fayette, OH but unable to find a date of death. A death certificate was found for daughter Mary Ann who married John R Howell. She died in 1910 and the certificate names parents Elias Smith and Sarah Evilsizer. This was the item that triggered the search for the parents..

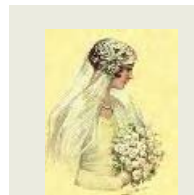
