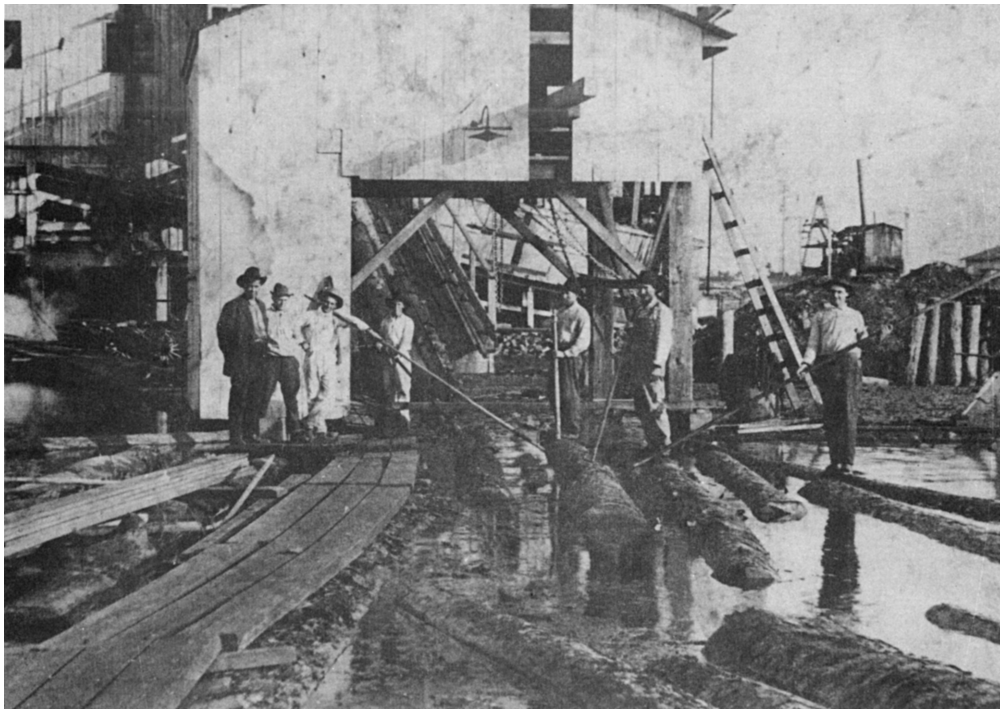

About the Cover - Lumber Mill Pond Longville, Louisiana

Joseph Franklin (born 26 Oct 1882 Grosebeck, Limestone County, Texas); Virgil G Franklin (born 26 Jul 1878 Erath County, Texas) is the Great Grand-father of Dan Franklin. Very little is known about W. Zack Coleman, however it is known that the Colemans were related to the Franklins through marriage.

The lumber industry, one of the oldest in the United States, employed many of our Franklin ancestors in sawmills. Your editor's father - William Watson Franklin (born 1894 Trinity County, Texas) started working in the sawmills "pitching shorts" at a very young age and was a lumber grader when he retired.

The lumber industry started in Jamestown, Virginia in 1608 to supply the colonists with lumber and found its way to the pine forests of the South about 1909. The first sawmill in Louisiana was erected in 1716 on or near streams where cypress trees grew. The water was used to transport the logs to the mill and from the mill to the market. This changed with the introduction of steam railroads in late 1880's and 1890's.

The early sawmills were chiefly for use of their owners and neighbors. As the demand increased the large size of the logs forced the sawmills to locate in or near the large forests. Small "Sawmill Towns" sprung up everywhere and later died when the forest was "cut out."

The Mill Pond (as shown on the cover) made it easy to sort and handle the timber. Storage in water also helped prevent splitting on the ends of the logs before sawing.

She has also shared with us Indiana Mortality Schedule 1850-1880 and *History of the Central Christian Church* which features Benjamin Franklin and Mary Personett Franklin.

We are beginning to put together our Pedigree Chart publication and each day brings more charts to us. Thank you for responding to our last effort to make this publication as complete as possible. p 137: Crosby County was created in 1886 from Bexar County and was named for Stephen Crosby, early chief clerk in the land office. The county was organized in 1886 with Estacado as the first county seat. Emma was made the county seat in 1891 and remained so until Drosbyton became the county seat in 1912. There have been nineteen men who have served as sheriff, one twice. **Felix S Franklin** was elected the first sheriff, being qualified on Sept 20, 1886; re-elected Nov 2, 1886 and served until Nov 6, 1888.

p192: Franklin County was created Mar 8, 1875 from Titus County and was named for **Judge B C Franklin**, District Judge during the Texas Republic and a San Jacinto veteran. The county was organized April 30, 1875 and the name of the county seat was changed from Lone Star to Mount Vernon. There have been sixteen men who have served as sheriff, two of them twice. This is one of the few counties who all the sheriffs have been elected with no appointments being made during the history of the county.

p 207: Goliad County was created March 17, 1836 as one of the original counties and was named for the Municipality of Goliad. It was organized in 1837 with Goliad as the county seat. Donna Garza, Deputy County Clerk, was a big help in helping me find information in the county records. The county records started in 1894 due to storms and other natural calamities destroying the court house. There have been forty-one men who have served as sheriff with two of them being elected twice. **Isaac Franklin** was elected the 22nd Sheriff on December 3, 1869 and served until February 17, 1871 when he resigned.

p 246: Harrison County was created on Jan 28, 1839 from Shelby County and was named for Jonas Harrison, an early Texas lawyer. It was organized June 12, 1842 with Marshall as the county seat. There have been twenty-four men who have served as sheriff, with one being elected three different times and one twice. **Earl C Franklin** was elected on Nov 1, 1954; re-elected Nov 6, 1956, Nov 8, 1960, Nov 3, 1964 and served until Jan 1, 1969. He was elected president of the Sheriffs' Association of Texas in 1965.

p 310: King County was created Aug 21, 1876 from Bexas Territory and was named for William King, an Alamo hero. The county was organized June 25, 1891 with Guthrie as the county seat. There have been

fifteen men and one lady who have served as sheriff with one of the men serving twice. **S W Franklin** was elected Nov 5, 1912 and served until Nov 3, 1914.

p 441: Robertson County was created on Dec 14, 1837 from Milam County and was named for Sterling Clack Robertson, early Texas Colonist. The county was organized in March 1838 with old **Franklin** as the county seat until 1850. Wheelock became the county seat in 1850 - 1855; Owensville from 1855 - 1869; Calvert from 1870 - 1879 and Morgan in 1879. Morgan was later re-named **Franklin** and remains the county seat today. There have been thirty-seven men who have served during the history of the county with two of them serving three times and one twice.

Elizabeth Franklin, daughter of Thomas and Mary Franklin, Jr. was born March the fourteenth in the year of our Lord 1765 at half an hour past three in the afternoon. Elizabeth Franklin took the small Pox November the thirteenth 1765 and had it very favorably.

Mary Franklin the wife of Thomas Franklin departed this life on first day morning abt 15 minutes [sic] after 6 o'clock the 2 of the 5th month 1779 after ten weeks lingering [sic] illness which she bore with christian patience [sic]. Apprehending her time short amongst us all in a Christian like cheerfulness and expressed a desire if it was her makers will to live a little longer for the sake of her dear babes.

Benjamin Franklin died in Phil 14th of the 6th month 1781 after 60 hours illness with the chollick.

Franklin-Spencer Family Records

According to Spencer, "This material is laying loose in front of a large Bible given to me by Ilah Spencer Elliott, passed down to her from her grandfather, James Whittley Spencer, who may have received it from his wife's family, the Franklins. This Bible is dated in the early 1840's and these sheets on the Franklin fam-

ily apparently came from a Bible copyrighted much earlier than this one. ”

Three of the record pages deal primarily with members of the Franklin family. They are quite large and ornate. Four smaller pages (one of them blank) contain Spencer family data.)
