





Margaret's parents were <u>Daniel and Margaret (Buchan) McDonald</u>. According to census records, Abram and Margaret were the parents of <u>Catherine Franklin</u> (b ca 1828), <u>George W. Franklin</u> (b 1844 - d in Civil War), <u>Sarah A.E. Franklin</u> (b ca 1846), <u>Jane M. Franklin</u> (b ca 1848), <u>Henrietta Franklin</u> (b 1850), <u>Wealthy A. Franklin</u> (b ca 1853) and <u>Pernol J. Franklin</u> (b 1856). Abram died February 1876 and Margaret died 1880, both in Thomas County, GA. I am trying to prove that Sarah married <u>Charles Platt</u> and Jane married <u>William E. Platt</u> in Jefferson County, Florida in the late 1860's. Still searching for parents or siblings of **John Franklin** (b 1804 Rutherford Co., NC) probably in the part known first as Tryon Co. John went to Walton Co., GA around 1827-28. He took part in the land lottery of 1832 for which a 3 year residence was required and died there ca 1880. One son, **D.B. Franklin** moved to Marcelina, Wilson County, Tx about 1890. D.B. Franklin's wife's name was **Housch-Hoche-Houche** (?). This family lived in other counties of Texas. Related families are Hill and Camp who also have roots in Rutherford Co., NC and may have also been in Texas (Wilson Co., Nacogdoches Co., Jefferson Co.)
