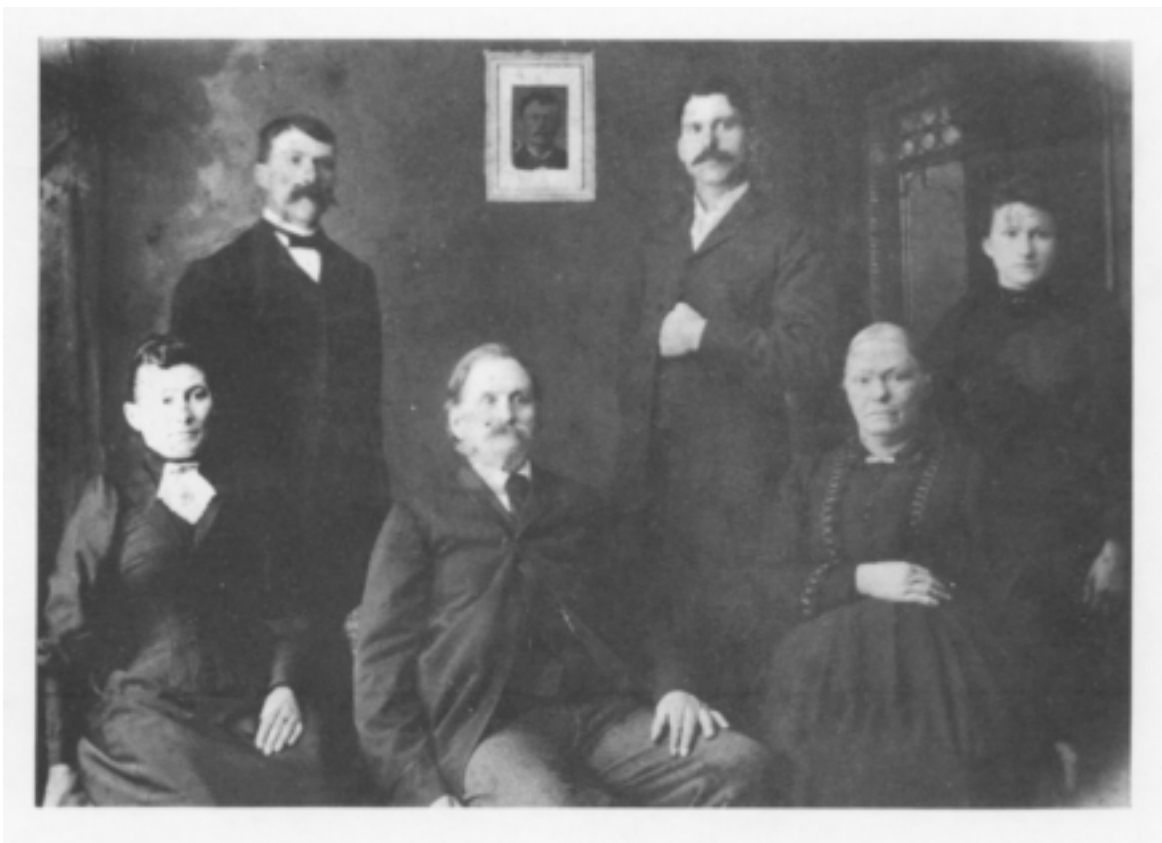

At the present time we have on film the 1860 Alabama (Jefferson & Lawrence Counties); Archives of the Spanish Govt - West Florida Volume 16-18; 1900 Census Texas (Trinity, Tyler & Upshur Counties); 1900 Census Texas (Anderson, Ectr, Andrew and Angelina Counties)- 1900 Census Texas (Runnels, Rusk, Rockwall, Sabine, San Augustine Counties); 1910 Census Texas (Travis Trinity, Young, Anderson, Andrews, Angelina & Armstrong Counties); 1830 Census Mississippi (Adams, Hinds, Jackson & Yazoo Counties) 1920 Census Texas (Andrews, Angelina, Aransas, Archer, Armstrong, Stososa, Baily, Bandera, Robertson, Rockwall, Sabine, Sterling and Stonewall Counties); and 5 rolls of Indian information. These rolls could be recorded on a micro cassette tape recorder and transcribed into printed data.

Lautenschleger, Minister of the Gospel. I have copy of this certificate. Elijah was a lawful age at the time of his marriage and a resident of Tippecanoe Co., IN at the time".

Margaret's parents were **Daniel and Margaret (Buchan) McDonald**. According to census records, Abram and Margaret were the parents of **Catherine Franklin** (b ca 1828), **George W. Franklin** (b 1844 - d in Civil War), **Sarah A.E. Franklin** (b ca 1846), **Jane M. Franklin** (b ca 1848), **Henrietta Franklin** (b 1850), **Wealthy A. Franklin** (b ca 1853) and **Pernol J. Franklin** (b 1856). Abram died February 1876 and Margaret died 1880, both in Thomas County, GA. I am trying to prove that Sarah married **Charles Platt** and Jane married **William E. Platt** in Jefferson County, Florida in the late 1860's. (Janet Medlock Cook, 521 Missionary Ridge, Desoto, TX 75115-5233; e-mail J.Cook45@genie.com.)

Still searching for parents or siblings of **John Franklin** (b 1804 Rutherford Co., NC) probably in the part known first as Tryon Co. John went to Walton Co., GA around 1827-28. He took part in the land lottery of 1832 for which a 3 year residence was required and died there ca 1880. One son, **D.B. Franklin** moved to Marcelina, Wilson County, Tx about 1890. D.B.
