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About the Cover

The map on the cover was taken from "Map Guide to the U.S. Federal Censuses 1790-1920", William Thorndale and William Dollarhide; Genealogical Publishing Co., Inc., Baltimore, Second printing 1988.

According to Notes: The Kentucky- Tennessee boundary, intended to be 36 deg 30 min, was run too far north in 1779-1780 by Virginia surveyors. Kentucky finally accepted this erroneous Walker Line in early 1820, but significant parts of the boundary remained uncertain until a resurvey completed in 1859. Some settlers in the disputed strip were uncertain in which state they lived. By contrast, the Kentucky-Tennessee line west of the Tennessee River was surveyed in 1819 essentially on 36 deg 30 min. Kentucky became a state in 1792. Federal census were lost for all counties.

According to "The Handy Book for Genealogists", United State of America, Eighth Edition; published by The Everton Publishers, Inc., PO Box 368, Logan, Utah 84321: Long before any white man had explored Kentucky, the entire area was claimed by Virginia as part of Augusta County. As early as 1750, Dr. Thomas Walker explored the eastern part of Kentucky. Daniel Boone followed in 1767. The first permanent settlement took place at Harrodsburg in 1774. The next year, Colonel Richard Henderson of North Carolina formed the Transylvania Company. He purchased almost half of Kentucky from Indian tribes, comprising all of the land between the Kentucky River in the central part of the state and the Cumberland River in the extreme western part. Daniel Boone settled Boonesboro in 1775 as well. In 1776, the Kentucky area was taken away from Fincastle County, Virginia and became Kentucky County, Virginia. In 1780, Kentucky County was divided into three counties: Fayette, Jefferson and Lincoln; which were in turn divided into nine counties within a decade.

This early period of settlement was one of much bloodshed and danger as the Indians tried to keep their lands. The courageous early settlers came mainly from Maryland, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Tennessee and Virginia. Louisiana Purchase in 1803, migration and settlement in Kentucky increased. Immigrants from Russia, Italy, Poland and Austria came to the area. The War of 1812 involved many Kentucky men. Although neutral in the Civil War, Kentucky had over 75,000 of its men in the Union forces and 35,000 to 60,000 in the Confederate forces. The extreme western tip of Kentucky is sometimes referred to as the Jackson Purchase Region since it was purchased in 1818 from the Chickasaw Indians during Andrew Jackson's presidency. It includes Calloway, Marshall, McCracken, Graves, Fulton, Hickman, Carlisle and Ballard counties.

He and his wife, Rachel (b 1767), are supposed to be buried in Lick Creek Cemetery. There are no stones. He was a charter member of the New Hope Church and a Moderator. Sons said to be their children: Caleb D. (b 6 June 1799 SC - d 3 June 1856 Hopkins Co., KY); Thomas (b abt 1803 SC); Jeremiah (b abt 1806 KY - d abt 1860 Hopkins Co., KY); James (b abt 1808 KY); Stephen D.
