

## **About the Cover**

The Tennessee-Kentucky boundary, intended to be 36 deg 30 minutes, was run too far north in 1779-1780 by Virginia surveyors. Kentucky finally accepted this erroneous Walker Line in early 1820, but significant parts of the boundary remained uncertain until a resurvey completed in 1859. Some settlers in the disputed strip were uncertain in which state they lived, though Tennessee exercised jurisdiction over much more of the strip than Kentucky ever did. By contrast, the Tennessee-Kentucky line west of the Tennessee River was surveyed in 1819 essentially on 36 deg 30 minutes<sup>1</sup>

The Spanish first visited Tennessee in the mid-1500's, but they made no attempt to colonize the area. King Charles II included Tennessee in his grant of the Carolinas in 1663 and the first English visited the area a decade later. The same year, Marquette and Joliet landed at the site of the future city of Memphis. In 1682, La Salle built a fort at the mouth of the Hatchie River in west Tennessee. Rivalry between the French and the English continued until settlers entered the area in 1769 from North Carolina and Virginia. They settled in the Watuga Valley and banded together as the Watauga Association in 1771. By 1772, there were four areas of settlement: North of the Holstein River, near Bristol; along the Watauga River, near Elizabethton; west of the Holstein River, near Rogerville; and along the Nolichucky River, near Erwin. North Carolina formally annexed Tennessee in 1776 as Washington County.

During the Revolutionary War, there were a number of volunteers from the state and some notable battles, including the Battle of Kings Mountain in 1780, which was the turning point of the war in the South. In 1784, North Carolina ceded Tennessee to the United States in order to secure federal protection for the area. When the federal government refused to acknowledge the cession, the people in Tennessee organized the State of Franklin. This lasted but four years and North Carolina regained control of the area in 1789. North Carolina again ceded the area to the United States in 1789, which formed the Southwest Territory in 1790.<sup>2</sup>

Settlement of middle Tennessee began with the founding of Nashville in 1779. The west Tennessee area was the last to be settled. In 1796, Tennessee became a state. Twenty years later, the first steamboat reached Nashville. Early white settlers of Tennessee were predominantly English, but there were many Scotch-Irish, Germans, and Irish as well as some French and Dutch. Most of the Americans came from South Carolina, Virginia, and North Carolina. Many of the Scotch-Irish came through the Shenandoah Valley, while the Germans settled in several of the counties west of Chattanooga.

In 1861, Tennessee seceded from the Union. The Confederacy received about 110,000 soldiers from Tennessee and the Union about 31,000, mostly from east Tennessee. Tennessee was readmitted to the Union in 1866.

Official registration of births and deaths began in 1914, Birth records from 1908 and death records since 1936 are available from the Division of Vital Records, State Department of Health and Environment, Cordull Hunt Building, Nashville, TN 37119.

They were parents of George Franklin who was b. in Jefferson Co. 8 Aug 1854. George Franklin married Julia Blackburn and after she died he married again to Sallie Bell, daughter of Calvin Bell. All Presbyterians.

p. 112: Hezekiah Franklin of Jefferson Co. belonged to a different set from that of John W. Franklin (above) unless the relationship runs back into Virginia, which it may. Hezekiah Franklin was b. in NC and came to Jefferson Co and settled when a very young man, his wife being Elizabeth Duncan. They had a son J.B. Franklin b. 1848 who married Elizabeth Walker, the daughter of Haynes Walker of Jefferson Co., who was b. 1847.

### **Tennessee Settlement Patterns**

(By Norman E Wright, Associate Professor of History at Brigham Young University)

The first white settlers in Tennessee were primarily from the back country of Virginia and North Carolina, but some were also from Pennsylvania, Maryland, and New Jersey. Later, migration from South Carolina and Georgia took place, bringing settlers from all along the tidewater country into Tennessee.

The earliest settlers from Virginia and North Carolina were of English stock and had migrated from the Tidewater region to the Piedmont, then into the higher mountain valleys along the Holston, Clinch, and Watauga rivers of East Tennessee. A few French Protestants (Huguenots) were also among that number; some directly from Virginia, and others from North and South Carolina.

Settlers from Pennsylvania included English/Welsh Quakers from the southeast counties of Chester, Philadelphia, Montgomery, and Bucks; German and Swiss/German Palatines from Berks, Lancaster, York, and Adams counties; and numerous Scotch-Irish (Ulster Scots) from the south-western counties. English and German settlers from Maryland were also in the early vanguard. This writer had an early Tennessee ancestor who came from Middlesex County, New Jersey with family
