What's in Your Name

Franklin is a name which can be found in any biographical dictionary or Who's Who in America. This prominent name undoubtedly achieved its original fame in the country with the statesman, scientist and philosopher, Benjamin Franklin.

Several Franklins were early arrivals in America. Seventeen year old Jonathan Franklin was taken to Barbados from England in 1635. Nicholas Franklin was registered in the Parish of St. Michaels at Barbados in 1679. Peter Franklyn arrived at the port of Bristol from England in 1775.

Although principally of English origin, the Franklin name can also be traced as Germanic. This occupational surname is derived from the Middle English "Frankeleyn" which means a freeholder who held substantial land for which he paid only a small rent and was not duty bound to render service to the lord.

Actually the name of Free-man, meaning "the free", preceded Franklin which was the French form of the same word. During the 13th and 14th centuries, personal freedom was much desired and the Franklin families progressed upward socially. The "freeman" in Norman England was one who cultivated his land with the right to sell it if he wished, owing the lord or the manor no more than the duty of attending his court and occasionally paying in nominal fee.

Some early records of the name in English history include Ralph Frankelein, 1195 in Yorkshire; Luke Le Frankleyn, 1234 in Cambridgeshire; and Roger le Franklyn, 1274 in Devonshire.

The Franklin coat of arms portrays much symbolism. The shield is silver with two red lions' heads on each side of a blue bend upon which is embellished two gold martlets and one gold dolphin.

John Henry Jones married Louisa Franklin born 7 May 1869 in Kentucky. She was the daughter of ? Franklin and ? McGowan. Louisa Franklin is recorded as a niece in the 1880 Collins County, Texas Census in the HH of W. C. McGowan (McGowen) born 1847/48 in Kentucy. Also recorded as a nephew is Sidney T. or I. Franklin born 1871/72 in Texas. Both Louisa and Sidney's parents are recorded as born in Kentucky. Also recorded as part of the family is E. E. McGowen. E. E. is a brother to M. C. or W. C. McGowan.

John Henry and Louisa are recorded on the 1860 Henry County, Alabama Census; PO Columbia, pg 69 HH #471/470 in which Wiley J. Jones is recorded; he is not recorded in the 1880 Tarrant County, Texas Census. Their Children:

Ancestors and Descendants of the Franklin, Barnes, Ormsby, Horton, Whitman, Kimble, Darting and Mixon Lines of my Family

I am submitting this somewhat lengthy compilation in the hope that I will lend some clarity and substantiation to the lines from the information I have either gathered from published sources and from the considerable amount of information from my paternal grandparents. FFRU Volume 4, pages 27-31 (from which I have quoted directly) contains much I agree with and in other areas there are some discrepancies. We begin with James Franklin (born 1650, probably in England). The *NEHGR* Vol 105 contains the following information, originally copied from *Short History of West Ferries of Jamestown* by Susan Braley Franklin.

James had been a soldier in King Phillips War. He served under Captain Daniel Henchman on 24 Aug 1676, in Captain Thomas Brattle's Company. On 9 Dec 1675 James was one of Captain Samuel Moseley's volunteer troops and was present at the Great Swamp Fight later that month. On 24 Aug 1676 his pay was assigned at Braintree, Massachusetts. This would indicate he was probably a resident of that town. He was evidently a young man at the time of the war. James was living in Rhode Island in Oct 1603 when he bought land in Dartmouth. In 1706 he was in Swansea, Massachusetts. He was styled a "cordwainer" in 1710 and was of Rehoboth, but by 1716 he had returned to Swansey. It seems probable the James Franklin was a brother of John Franklin of Swansea, cordwainer, who, with his wife sold land there in 1717 and James Franklin was a witness to the deed.

1. James Franklin was born about 1650. Before 1681-82 he married Unice (Unice Barnes daughter of

Samuel Barnes of Barrington)³ Their children:

- A John Franklin married Ruth Wilson 6 May 1703. Later married Hannah

James Franklin (born 8 Jul 1682 Dartmouth, Massachusetts; died 21 Oct 1765 or 66 in Rhode Island and married 2 May to 1705 Martha Ormsby (born 7 May 1680) daughter of John Ormsby (born 1641; died 10 Mar 1717 from Rehoboth, Massachusetts vital records) and Grace Martin 1 Jan 1664 (Baptized 21 Sep 1640 in England; died 4 Jul 1710 Massachusetts).

John Ormsby's father was Richard Ormsby (born 1608, probably in Lincolnshire, England; died 30 Jun 1664 Rehoboth, Massachusetts. was (?Sara Fitch or Sarah Upham). They were living in Saco, Maine in 1641, later moved to Haverhill, Massachusetts. ⁴ John Ormsby was a member of Phillip's Expedition against Quebec in 1690. (born 2 Nov 1609 at Ottery St Mary, Devon, England; died 2 Mar 1694 Rehoboth, Massachusetts His will entered 9 May 1695 (Paul Gen.). Richard married 9 Jun 1631 at Ottery, Elizabeth Salter Ellis (born 20 Oct 1616 at Ottery, Devonshire, England) Elizabeth was daughter of Robert Saiter Ellis (born - 1578 at Ottery) who married 26 Nov 1604. Elizabeth Frawkener (or Ffrawkener) daughter of Michael Frawkener (born - 1557).

James and Martha (Ormsby) Franklin's children were all born in Swansea, Massachusetts. They moved to Scituate, Rhode Island in 1738. Their children:

- 5. Icabod Franklin (born 1 Jul 1713 Swansea, Massachusetts) married 21 Aug 1731 at Attleboro, Massachusetts (#1) Esther or Hester Horton. She died in 1739 while giving birth to her son Icabod Franklin (born 28 Apr 1739). lcabod and Esther were married by the Rev. David Turner. (Attleboro records show Hester, but all other records show Esther. Icabod (the father) was of Swansea, Reheboth, and Attleboro, Massachusetts, living in Attleboro until 1761 and then moving to Winchester, Cheshire County, New Hampshire, where they lived during the Revolutionary War. Their Children:
 - Stephen Franklin (born 10 May 1736 at Attleboro) married 5 Nov 1758 to a. Rachael Carpenter daughter of Eleazur and Elizabeth (Warfield) Carpenter of Reheboth, Massachusetts. Stephen served in the Revolutionary War. They had 8 children:

Icabod Franklin (born 28 Apr 1739) married (1) 22 Jan 1761 Molly Whitman (born 1743 Weymouth, Massachusetts; died 24 May 1778 Winchester, New Hampshire.
