About the Cover

Walter James Franklin and Becca (McFarland) Franklin Wedding Portrait

This photo was taken in 1916, probably in Springfield, Greene County, Missouri. It is a scan of a color Xerographic copy of the photograph.

Walter was born 16 Apr 1892 in Springfield, Greene County Missouri, second child, oldest son of Edward Grundy Franklin and Ella Louvina (Buck) Franklin. Ella died young and Edward began drinking. He often beat Walter. When Walter was 10, it was so severe that Walter left home and lived with an uncle. When his uncle moved to Oklahoma, Walter moved with him. He invited his sisters to join him in Oklahoma and at a young age, they were on their own. They worked hard, growing and picking cotton to make a living. When his father, Edward, became ill in 1914, Walter returned to Springfield to stay with him. His father soon died, but while there, Walter met Becca Jane McFarland, whom he married on 26 Jun 1916. Walter moved back to Noble, Oklahoma, where Becca soon followed. Later her parents (who lived near Springfield, Missouri) also joined them when they moved from Noble, Oklahoma to Norman, Oklahoma. Walter and Becca had 11 children, 9 of whom lived to adulthood. For 32 years there was at least one family member attending Norman High School. Walter died 17 Feb 1972. Becca died 6 Mar 1987.

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Editor's Message

I mentioned in a previous volume that I would be going to Salt Lake City. I had 4 days to research in the world-famous Family History Library. I spent about a day-and-a-half among the surname-oriented books. These books have all been moved to the Joseph Smith Building, about a block away from the main library. At first I was disappointed that these were located in another building, had different hours, etc., but after I got used to the new environment, it was nicer than being in the main library. I stayed in the Temple Square TravelLodge. It is an older place, but the rates weren't too bad (for the height of the tourist season), and it's just across the street from the FHL. I ate at the nearby Dee's restaurant which is a family-owned local chain, similar to Denny's or Shoney's. There's a lot of construction going on in the area right now, so the usual serenity of the area was missing, but I still enjoyed my visit there.

The Joseph Smith building (formerly known as the Hotel Utah) is newly-renovated. Because it was away from the main library, there really weren't many patrons there, and in fact there were almost always more librarians than patrons there while I was visiting. They closed at 9:00 p.m. (rather than the 10:00 p.m. of the FHL) The copy machines do not accept coins, so you have to keep track of the number of copies that you make. It really was a pleasure to work there.

While there, I viewed many of the 135 books which are listed under the Franklin surname in the Family History Library Catalog (FHLC). A copy of the Franklin FHLC listing is available from the FFRU website. I discovered that quite a few of the books listed for Franklins had little or nothing to do with Franklins, and I will be annotating the Franklin FHLC printout to reflect this.

Starting in this issue, I am including book reviews of the books which I found there.

This is the third issue which contains extracts of the LDS Vital Records Franklin marriages including the states of Hawaii, Idaho, Illinois Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine and Maryland, and Massachusetts.

Several subscribers from 1997 informed me that they had not received their copies of Volumes 22 and 23. We regret this oversight. Elaine Giddens has now corrected this for all those who were overlooked. If any more of you out there, please let me know.

New Policies

Oh! I almost forgot! I've had come up with some new policies for the newsletter.

In order to encourage more submissions, there will be an exception to this. Submitters of articles (not just queries) will receive a free hardcopy of the volume of the newsletter in which their submission appears, or a PDF copy, whichever they prefer.

You will note that there are many past issues of the newsletter which are still not available on the website. Once I get this volume mailed out, I will be able to return to the task of re-indexing and releasing these.

I know that some of you prefer softcopy and do not want a hardcopy. There are several advantages to the softcopy version: 1) You can cut-and-paste data and narratives into your genealogy program, and 2) it doesn't take up very much physical space. By the same token, there are several disadvantages to the softcopy: 1) You need a computer to read it 2) It is lost if you have a harddisk crash. If you are a subscriber and you prefer to receive the newsletter in softcopy form, please let me know.

Another benefit to subscribers is that their queries are given priority. I receive many queries, in fact, too many to properly respond to all of them. Subscriber's queries always get priority over any other queries. An example of this was that when I visited the Family History Library in Salt Lake City in June of 1999, I did research for several subscribers to answer specific queries. I am working my way through all of queries which subscribers or contributors have sent me. For non-subscribers, I will perform an in-depth search of the research materials in the FFRU library for \$5.00.

This is in keeping with the policies that Elaine used and is in harmony with the fact that these queries are using up more and more of my time, which reduces the time I can devote to the interests of FFRU.

These reports are provided for nonmembers for \$5.00 per search plus 10¢ per hardcopy page. All search fees will be used to purchase source materials for the benefit of all FFRU members.
- To encourage all members to submit any well-documented Franklin research for publication.
- To encourage all members to submit pedigree charts, family group sheets and any other materials that will assist us in maintaining and updating our computer database.
- To solicit unlimited queries from members as well as non- members. These queries will be published, at the discretion of the editors, free of charge and must have a Franklin connection.
- To encourage members to submit family publications (or any other books deemed of interest to other members) for review in our quarterlies. Books submitted for review becomes a part of FFRU Library after being reviewed.

Regarding conflicting information, I will be unable to arbitrate disputes. The single best way to resolve them is by collaboration and sharing of source documents. Researchers can then weigh the facts and present their reasoning and conclusions. This is a very important function of this group.

This appears to be well researched and documented. This work does not include very much information on collaterals. It includes several Franklin photographs. There are about 30 pages devoted to Franklins.

Source material is liberally quoted throughout, including census, Wills, *Barren County Heritage* by C. Goode. No photos. Uses a Henry numbering scheme that is easy to follow. Printed with a courier font with names in all upper case, which reduces legibility, however, all in all, the book is of high quality.

This includes the Jesse Franklin who became Governor of North Carolina. The entire work is only 19 pages, and only about 3 deal with the Franklins.

Henry H. Franklin, my great, great-grandfather, was born on 8 July 1832^[1] to James Smyth^[2] and Mildred^[3] "Milla/Milly" (Quick) Franklin^[4]. This was the second marriage for James Smyth Franklin (1787^[5]-1863^[6]). James' first wife, Sarah Rush^[7] (1791^[8] -1812^[9]), having borne Henry's older two half-brothers, [Wesley^[10] (1808^[11] -1853^[12]) and John^[13] (1810^[14] -1850^[15])] died on 10 November 1812^[16] at the age of twenty-one. James Smyth Franklin then married Milla Quick^[17] (1792^[18] -1861^[19]) on 20 June 1814^[20] in Ross County, Ohio.^[21] They had thirteen children:^[22]

It appears that the James Smyth Franklin family lived in Ross County, Ohio for several years. Both of the marriages of James Smyth Franklin,^[23] as well as the births of his first nine children (including Wesley^[24] and John,^[25] listed above) probably occurred there. [I have not personally researched all of these birth places.] It appears that Charles W. (eldest son of Milla Quick and James S. Franklin born in 1815^[26]) and Cuthbert (their seventh child born in 1825^[27]) were born in Ohio.^[28] Rhoda Jane (born in 1830^[29]) and her younger siblings, including Henry H., were born in Indiana in the Tippecanoe County area.^[30] I do not have any source documentation on the birthplace of the two children (Dorcus Quick, born in 1827^[31] and Oleyvet S. born in 1829^[32]) born between Cuthbert and Rhoda Jane. However, if the dates of land ownership noted below are correct, the Franklin family was in Indiana by 1825, and these two children were probably born there as well.

Henry's father, James Smyth Franklin, and his grandfather, Joseph Franklin (1768-1833) both purchased land in the Tippecanoe area in Indiana in 1825.^[33] James purchased eighty acres of land (E ½ NE ¼ of Sec 17, T22N R4W) in Wabash Co, Indiana on 14 Nov 1825.^[34] Old Wabash County included the present Tippecanoe County.^[35] The next year, Tippecanoe County, Indiana was formed.^[36] In fact, Henry's aunt Rebecca Franklin and uncle William Trenary, became the first couple ever to be married in this new county on 2 Nov 1826.^[37] It appears, then, that much of the extended Franklin family moved together to the Tippecanoe area about 1825.

Henry H. Franklin and/or his father, James Smyth Franklin, are listed in the Tippecanoe County, Indiana censuses from 1830-1880.^[38] Henry's grandfather, Joseph Franklin, Henry's uncle, Preston Franklin, and Henry's half-brother, John, are listed in this county as heads-of-household in the 1830 census.^[39] Henry's grandfather, Joseph Franklin, died in Tippecanoe County in 1834 and his will (written in 1833) was probated there.^[40] On 12 Mar 1835, Henry's father, James Franklin, purchased 160 acres of land (NW ¼ Sec 26, Twp 74, R 3 W) in Tippecanoe County from a John and Nancy Shaw.^[41] This points to the fact that the James Franklin family was stable in the Tippecanoe County area before, during, and soon after Henry's birth in 1832.

In October 1855, divorce proceedings against Henry's oldest full brother, Charles W. Franklin, were brought by Charles' wife, Elizabeth. This case was very unusual, as the grounds for divorce were that he had "committed incest with his own daughter, Emily Jane Moore"^[42] (The child would have been about nineteen years old in 1855,^[43] which leaves one to ponder the last name "Moore". It is possible that Emily was married by this point. A marriage of an Emily Jane Franklin and an Elijah Moore is listed on page 165 of the Tippecanoe County Marriage Record Book 5,^[44] but I do not have a copy of this record nor the date of entry.) Henry H. Franklin signed onto this Tippecanoe County document, verifying the place of residency of the defendant and his wife. This fancy, quite legible calligraphy-style signature indicates that Henry could write very well. He apparently could read also.^[45]

On 18 Jun 1857^[46] Henry H. Franklin married Mary Elizabeth Shigley^[47] (about 1833^[48] - 1893^[49]) in Tippecanoe County, Indiana.^[50] They started a family immediately after marriage, as Edwin S.^[51] was born ten months later in April, 1858.^[52] Brother Everette E.^[53] was born in May 1860.^[54]

The 1860 census^[55] finds Henry's family living next door to his wife's brother James Shigley,^[56] a widower, and his two children. James Shigley's late wife was Rhoda Jane (Franklin) Shigley,^[57] Henry H. Franklin's sister.^[58] Therefore, a brother and a sister Franklin married a sister and a brother Shigley and then lived side-by-side. Next door to Henry's brother-in-law, James Shigley is an Elizabeth J. Shigley, listed as a widow. (Col. James Newton Shigley, my third cousin-once-removed and friend and Henry's great-grandnephew is author of the book, *As I Recall*. In it he clarifies the connection of this Elizabeth to the other Shigleys. Documents show that Elizabeth Jane STAIR and James Shigley married on 2 February 1858 in Tippecanoe County, Indiana.^[59] Each had two children from a previous marriage.^[60] Only three months into the marriage, Elizabeth evidently abandoned James and his family. He petitioned for divorce in October of 1858.^[61] Col. Shigley states that this is the same James and Elizabeth as were living close to Henry H. in 1860.^[62] Col. James and I like to say that we are therefore, in the vernacular, "double cousins", sharing as we do, two sets of great-grandparents.)

[Point of interest: This is not the full extent of the “Shigley-Franklin connection”. Henry’s aunt, Olivet Franklin,^[63] married his wife’s uncle, George Sheagley/Schuckley/ Shigley^[64] in 1811^[65] in Ross County, Ohio.^[66]

Ulysses Henry Franklin,^[67] Henry’s third child, joined the family, still in Tippecanoe County, in December of 1864.^[68] The 1870 census does not list any more children. This is the first census to list Henry’s occupation as “farmer”.^[69] (The 1860 census taker mistakenly wrote Henry’s last name, “Franklin”, in the place marked for occupation!) A copy of a single page (p. 128) of an undated “Business Directories [sic]” with accompanying map (obtained from the Tippecanoe County Area Genealogical Association) shows that Henry owned land in section 26 and 35 (adjoining sections) in Washington Township, Tippecanoe County, totaling 84 acres. His business is listed as farmer.^[70] This tract of land is adjacent to an even larger piece of land owned by Joseph and Mary Shigley (Henry’s father and mother-in-law). Surely this amount of land ownership indicates a certain degree of wealth by both families.

Henry H. Franklin’s assets slowly increased. In 1850, he was still in his father’s household.^[71] In 1860, there is no mention of real estate, but his personal property was worth \$700.^[72] By 1870, Henry’s real estate was worth \$2300 and he had personal property worth \$800.^[73]

Sadly, Henry’s first marriage was short-lived, as Mary Elizabeth died in Washington Twp, Tippecanoe County on 23 June 1871 at the young age of 36 years.^[74] She is buried in Buck Creek Cemetery where her tombstone lists her maiden name, age, date of death, and the fact that she was the “wife of H.H.”^[75]

Henry was not a widower for long, marrying Sarah (Carnes^[76]) Shigley,^[77] widow of Jacob Shigley^[78] on 11 March 1872.^[79] Jacob Shigley was a brother of Henry’s first wife, Mary Elizabeth Shigley.^[80] Henry therefore married his sister-in-law. (Another Franklin/Shigley connection!!) She brought two young children to this union.^[81] Only ?Lizzie?/?Luigi? Shigley was listed on the 1880 census as a nine-year-old stepdaughter.^[82] Also listed in 1880 were two new daughters, Edith, age five, and Lena, age three.^[83] Henry was still listed as a farmer.^[84]

Henry and Sarah may have had a daughter named Elizabeth in about 1880.^[85] The 1900 census reveals that Sarah is the mother of six children, four of them living.^[86] (I am only aware of five possibilities, including Elizabeth as noted above. Elizabeth is not listed on the 1900 census. She may represent one of the children not living at that time. Perhaps the other deceased child was the unnamed second stepchild Sarah brought with her when she married Henry. This child would have died prior to the 1880 census, as she was not listed there.)

By 1885, the family moved to Nebraska. Clara Lucille Franklin (Henry and Sarah’s third child) was born there in July of 1885^[87] or 1886.^[88] The turn-of-the-century finds the Henry Franklin family in Liberty Precinct, Grant Village, Perkins County, Nebraska. Edith B. is still living at home, even though she is twenty-four years old.^[89]

I have been unable to find Henry or his sons in the 1910 census, although his three sons are still in Nebraska according to the 1920 census.^[90] A newspaper article dated Tuesday, October 22, 1912 from an unknown newspaper was found tucked in the Ewing family Bible.^[91] (Harry Walter Ewing married Henry H. Franklin’s granddaughter, Irma Franklin.)^[92] The article is entitled “*The Sunset Social. All Hamilton County Old Folks, Regardless of Church Connections Invited to Par-*

ticipate.”^[93] This describes the Sunset social given in the Methodist church. A list of “guests seventy years of age or older” was published. This included “Henry H. Franklin, age 80”.

Loren Elliott, Henry’s great-grandnephew, reports in his unpublished history that Henry died on 19 June 1913 in Hamilton County, Indiana.^[94] I imagine that this is an error as Henry’s three sons were in Nebraska this whole time. I suspect that the above mentioned newspaper article was from Hamilton County, Nebraska, as the vocal soloist is listed as Miss Pearle Munson, step-sister of Henry’s granddaughter Irma May Franklin.^[95] Irma was married in Aurora, Hamilton County, Nebraska in 1911.^[96] Pearle Munson also sang at this wedding.^[97] In the newspaper account of this wedding,^[98] Henry H. Franklin is not listed among the list of “out of town guests”. In fact, he is not mentioned at all. However, this could be just an oversight as if he were not from “out of town” or a parent, there is no obvious place to list him. It is also possible that he was too ill to attend the wedding. Henry’s granddaughter, Irma, and her husband still lived in Nebraska in 1913.^[99]

In conclusion, it appears that Henry H. Franklin was a literate, successful farmer, although I know nothing about his formal education, hobbies, or passions. His two marriages were productive and apparently happy. He lived to an age that is still considered above average for American men today. As noted in the addendum, I hope that future research sheds more light on some of the many remaining mysteries concerning Henry H. Franklin and his family.

From the preceding history, it is obvious that a great deal of work remains to be done on this family, and specifically on Henry H. Franklin.

Using the LDS IGI and the Ancestral File in Your Research

Often the LDS International Genealogical Index (IGI) and the Ancestral File (AF) are quoted as “sources”. At best, these are secondary sources. At worst, they are wild guesses. Unfortunately, some submitters to the IGI and AF have a “shotgun” approach to genealogy which means that when they aren’t sure, instead of not submitting anything, they will submit all possible permutations and hope that one is right. This may suit their purposes, but it is not useful in genealogy, and those who try to use the results of this method, will find it confusing and misleading.

Ancestral File

The Ancestral File (AF) is a database of genealogical that have been submitted to the Family History Department of the LDS Church. Ancestral File currently contains 35 million names, arranged in pedigrees and in family groups.

If you find an interesting line, you can create a GEDCom file to download onto a floppy. (You can’t do this on-line, you’ll have to visit your local FHC to do this). The file can then be read into your database on your home computer. Obviously, the further back your lines go, the more likely this is to have connections to your kinfolk...

The Ancestral File only accepts new information in GEDCom format. Before this information is distributed, all notes and source references are deleted. The name and address of the submitter is available, however. This is intended to facilitate the collaboration of the various researchers. Again, there is a downside in that many of the addresses are old and are no longer valid.

International Genealogical Index

The International Genealogical Index (IGI) is the single largest genealogical database of names in the world. It consists of names submitted, for any time period, since the Family History Department of the LDS Church began to keep computerized records in October 1969. This is an index for about 250 million vital records. You can find birth, christening, and marriage information.

You can print the information, or save it in GEDCOM or ASCII format. Unlike the AF, the IGI does not contain linked pedigrees. Record categories include:

- b = birth record
- c = christening record
- m = marriage
- d = death
- p = probate record
- n = census record.

Just because your ancestor wasn't a member of the LDS church, it doesn't mean he or she won't appear on the International Genealogical Index. One of your ancestor's other living relatives has possibly submitted the name to the IGI.

There is a second way names get into this huge genealogical database: through names extracted from original records, such as census or church records. This program has provisions for a system of checks and balances, so that two, sometimes three people view each record and enter the details independently into databases. Those entries are then cross-checked and verified.

Once you find an entry in the IGI for someone on your pedigree chart, copy the information. For those centers without microfiche reader/printers, you may use an IGI extraction form, complete with rows and labeled column headings, or if you are using the CD-ROM version, you can print a hard copy.

I'm not suggesting that we completely ignore the IGI and AF, rather that like any other record, in order to understand the surety and quality of the information, we have to understand why and how the information was gathered. The LDS Church accepts information which has been submitted by literally millions of church members. They check for EXACT duplicates, and if no exact duplicate is found, then the information is added. No source documents need to be referenced, and no one, other than the submitter themselves, verifies the information.

I strongly recommend that these records be used as they were intended. For instance, "IGI" stands for International Genealogical Index. It does not claim to be a genealogical record, rather it is an index to records. As an index, it points to other records, some of which may be source documents or others may or may not contain the names of source documents. Sometimes, just the fact that you have a date and a place will enable you to find the proper source record.

Correcting the IGI and the Ancestral File

Actually you cannot "correct" the IGI. It is an index to other records. As such, even if the events are not correct in the other records, the index must report them exactly as they appear in the other records, correct or not...

On the other hand, the Ancestral File can be corrected. Detailed instructions for doing so are found at your local Family History Center. You will, naturally, need to completely document your conclusions, and the easiest way to correct the information will be to contact the submitter and have them amend their original data.

I have found thousands of events, well-indexed in the IGI and Ancestral File. I have benefited

greatly from these sources which the LDS Church has so generously proffered. They have led me to many source documents. These can be a wonderful resource when we use them properly.

Queries

In general, these are "most-wanted" or "end-of-line" individuals. I have made NO effort to match these, so there may be duplicates. These are ALL from the 'Web page, because the mail version of this forum has been dormant. If you do not have access to E-mail, then I would be happy to forward your U.S. Mail response to any of these queries.

Riley Franklin born about 1800, location unknown. He lived in Limestone County, Alabama by 1828. Married a Josephine Bonapart (her surname unknown) about 1825. Riley Franklin and family moved to Johnson County, Arkansas by 1842. Census data from 1840 shows at least 6 children. Riley sells land in 1848 and no further record for him and wife. We believe James A. Franklin born 1828 at Limestone County, Alabama is a son who married Lou Ann Park in 1849 at Johnson County, Arkansas.

Also interested in a Preston Franklin in Talladega County, Alabama from 1839-1850.

Franklin descendants in my line have an old "pocketbook" with his name stamped on it. We have never figured out what the connection is. Brother to Riley?

Very interested in what, if any, was the relationship between Ashworth families of Pope, Crawford/Sebastian counties Arkansas? Benjamin H. Ashworth of Pope who took in a Franklin girl per the 1850 census. Joseph Ashworth also 1850 at Crawford County, Arkansas with a William Franklin. Are these Franklin's related to Riley and Josephine Franklin?
