This early postcard of Springfield, Greene County, Missouri shows the town near the time when my ancestors left there. You can get a feel for the community of your ancestors from old postcards. They frequently show buildings which no longer exist, etc. In this case, all of this area is now paved, and looks quite a bit different than it did when my great grandfather had an office overlooking this area.

Old postcards like these may be found on the Internet on the various USGenWeb county sites, on communities' historical sites, and for sale on eBay.

One such website describes itself thus: "Have you ever wondered what it would have been like to journey across the United States in 1910, traveling through countryside and small towns, craning your neck to look up at the skyscrapers of the cities, stopping to see the current events and sites of this glorious country's history?"

"This is a special project for history and vintage postcard buffs everywhere. It's a directory of vintage postcard collections of the American Local History Network and USGenWeb Project, historical and genealogical societies, private libraries and museums, universities, towns, parks and private collectors. It does not include any commercial listings (unless they contain significant galleries for public viewing with no pricing information), auctions, electronic greeting cards or modern postcards.

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Letter from the Editor

Well, another new year! This particular volume is the second one devoted to Missouri, and as such it is a continuation of Volume 40, the first volume of 2003. This does not contain all of the material I have about Missouri Franklins, but there are just some odds and ends - kind of a hodge-podge.

I have started a project of abstracting all of the Franklins for all of the US census enumerations. So far, I have at least indexes for all of the available states for all of the years 1790-1930. I say "available" because as you may know, some census records are gone, including virtually all of the 1890, and the 1790 from Georgia, Delaware and Maine, for instance. If you have transcriptions of the various census years that you'd be willing to contribute, I would love to have them. Of course, the natural question is "What am I going to do with the data?" I really don't know. As a minimum, I'd like to publish the data on the FFRU website. I am a software developer by profession, so I would also like to create a database with a slick user interface that would allow a user to do searches and create linkages between the various census years, then print out the (possible) lineages. We'll see. That just might be too ambitious.

The amount of data is most interesting. Take for instance the fact that I started this while looking into the census records Missouri. I now have 190 pages of Missouri census information. That does not include 1870 or 1880, nor are all of those complete abstracts (some are just heads of households). At 200 pages per year, I could easily fill a 6 issues (1 1/2 years) of FFRU just for Missouri census records. At that rate, and remembering that some states like Texas have has more than 3 times that many records, it would probably take more than 30 years of FFRU just to publish the records. By that time, there will be 3 more censuses released (1940-1960)... Anyway, you see what my problem is. To minimize this then, I've decided:

- 1) When publishing the census in FFRU on a state-by-state basis, only publish 1880 and prior censuses in FFRU.
- 2) Find another way (outside of the FFRU newsletter) to publish the rest of the census.
- 3) As I mentioned above - try to find a useful way to facilitate cross-census searching.

David Franklin Family

First Generation

1. David Franklin was born in 1734 in England and died in 1782. He married Mary Hubbard.² He was probably the same David Franklin who enlisted 20 Jul 1780 in the Connecticut Line as part of the 4th Connecticut Regimental Levies, recruited principally from Windham and New London Counties (his captain, John Buell, was from Lebanon, Connecticut). He was discharged 10 Dec 1780. His three children are listed in 1896 Oneida County History by Daniel E. Wager (page 15, family biographies).³

Some time after the Revolution this family moved from Connecticut to the town of Norway, Herkimer County, New York. All three children first appear in the area shortly after 1800. Did David himself move to Norway before his death? This does not seem likely, as the Mohawk Valley prior to 1782 was still in a state of considerable turmoil from the Revolutionary war; the earliest settlers from New England arrived in Norway a decade later, settling on the Royal Grant lands forfeited by Loyalists after the Revolution. More likely, Mary came with her children when her sons were in their early twenties, eager to join other New Englanders in seeking a new life.

Second Generation

2. James Franklin was born 1769-70 and died 11 Jul 1825 in his 56th year. He married 1) Molly Reed.⁴ She was born 1773-4 and died 11 Apr 1813 in her 40th year. (There is a Molly Reed born 12 Jan 1770 in Litchfield, Connecticut, daughter of Elias and Ruth Reed.) James and Molly are buried in the Fairchild Cemetery in the town of Remsen. According to the census record of their son Harry in 1880, James and Molly were both born in Connecticut. James Franklin married 2) Anna _____.

The earliest land record of James Franklin is dated 21 Jan 1803 when James and Molly Franklin of the town of Norway, Herkimer County, New York, and Josiah and Abigail Pardee of the same town, sold 50 acres in Lot 66 of the 3rd Allotment of the Royal Grant to George Taylor for \$300. Lot 66 is in the present-day town of Russia, on the Old Military Road between Gravesville and Cold Brook. On 28 Mar 1806 James and Molly sold 200 acres in the same Lot 66 to Josiah Pardee for \$900. The original purchase of the Lot 66 land is not recorded; presumably this deed was destroyed by a fire in the Herkimer courthouse after 1800.⁵ The Pardee family is documented in Donald Lines Jacobus's *The Pardee Genealogy* (1927), which notes that Josiah Pardee, the son of Eliphalet and Rebecca (Bradley) Pardee of Southbury, Litchfield County, Connecticut, was born 19 Sep 1771 and married Abigail Smith born 5 Mar 1777.

After leaving Norway, James purchased from Joshua Borden of Remsen 122 acres in Lot 13 of the Serviss Patent (James Road, south of Fairchild Road) for \$1,500 on 2 Jun 1806. He was a property holder in the 1814 Oneida census. He was also a deacon, according to his gravestone. No doubt he served under Reverend Edmund Tefft from Rhode Island, the first resident minister of the Fairfield district (east of Remsen village), who by 1800 had moved to the town of Norway (Millard Roberts, *History of Remsen* 1914).

In the 1810 census James' family consisted of three males aged 0-5, one male aged 5-10, two females aged 0-5 and 2 females aged 5-10. In the 1820 census, the household consisted of three males aged 0-5, one male aged 5-10, one male aged 10-15, one male aged 15-20, one female aged 0-5, three females aged 5-10, two females aged 10-15, and one female aged 15-20. In his will, dated 4 Dec 1824, he gave his wife one-third of his real estate, his children by his first wife equal shares of the remainder, and his two children by his second wife half of a share each. It is not clear who the three males and one female born after 1815 are, since only two children by his second wife were mentioned in the will. It is conjectured that one of the males may have been Oliver Franklin who is known to have been born 2 Oct 1815 in Oneida County. Most of his known children shared in the sale of his Remsen property to Wightman and Electa Morgan in the 1820s and 1830s.

James H. Franklin, born about 1821, died 30 Dec 1840, buried with his parents in the Fairchild Cemetery.

She is buried in the cemetery in Norway, Herkimer County, New York, on west side of Newport-Gray Road, 0.1 mile north of Military Road). Waite Franklin married 2) Maria Pride on 18 Sep 1803 in the Reformed Dutch Church of Fonda, Montgomery County, New York. By 1813 they had moved to Sangerfield, Oneida County, New York. By 1820 they had moved to Watertown, Jefferson County, New York, and by 1830-35 to the town of Brownville in Jefferson County. In 1820 his family consisted of one male 0-10, two males 10-16, and one female 0-10; by 1830 there were two males 15-20, one male 20-30, one female 10-15 and one female 15-20. He had a farm of 80 acres in 1835.

Child of Ruth Willoughby and Waite Franklin:

Esther Franklin, born 1793 in New York, married Nathan Dexter. He was born in 1796 in Rhode Island.⁷ In 1850 they were living in West Turin Township Lewis County, New York. Children listed in 1850: Hellen Dexter, born 1832, Delin Dexter, born 1834.

They had granddaughters Ida Louise McClusky and Esther Pankhurst, both born in Leyden, New York. They joined the DAR on David Franklin's services in the Revolution.

In 1831 he purchased 11 acres in Lot 199 of Adgate's Western Tract from Moses Claflin for \$60. 1. Oliver Franklin was born 2 Oct 1815³⁰ Oneida County, New York and died 22 Sep 1877 Poland, Herkimer County, New York. On 16 Sep 1839 he married Juliette Case (daughter of David Merritt and Mary (Beebe) Case), born 7 Jan 1816 and died after 1880. They are buried in the Poland cemetery (no stone). He came to Herkimer County, New York in 1836, and purchased a house in Poland in 1839. He was a shoemaker in 1850³¹ and 1860, but is listed as a photographer in 1855. He is said to have suffered from “fits”, which may have been mercury poisoning. His descendant Richard Bellinger owns Oliver’s violin.

Oliver was almost certainly an illegitimate birth, as his mother (living with Oliver in Poland in 1860) was then only 60. She was Miranda Green (daughter of Samuel Green from Rhode Island, first gristmill and sawmill owner in the town of Fairfield, Herkimer County). She was born 24 Oct 1800 and died 23 Mar 1861. Her will, on file in Herkimer County, lists son Oliver and daughter Marilla A. Jacobs.³² She subsequently (about 1827) married Lewis Higby and resided in Lewis County, New York and Erie County, Pennsylvania, until his death in 1859. Family tradition related by Oliver’s grandson Frank Howe and granddaughter Anna Franklin states that Oliver was an orphan who ran away from home as a boy or young man; no doubt this was a story to conceal the true facts. There is at present no proven connection between the Green family and the James Franklin family of Remsen, New York (the only Franklin family in Oneida County in 1815), but Miranda’s brother James Green had a son named Franklin and a grandson named James Franklin Stevens. If there was a family connection, one can speculate that Miranda may have been sent to help care for the younger children in the James Franklin family after the death of his first wife in 1813, and that Oliver’s fa-

A Case for Susannah as Daughter of John and Margaret Dawson Franklin of Amherst County, Virginia and Barren County, Kentucky³⁵

In the time since publication of the article, “The Life of John Franklin, Sr. of Amherst County, Virginia” in FFRU, Vol. 34, page 5, some evidence has come to light which lends support to the theory that John and Margaret Dawson Franklin had at least one other daughter, if not more, than were suggested in the article.

It is most important to document everything possible, but there are times when documents only tip toe around the point or don’t exist at all. That’s the time when all the evidence must be weighed in light of the customs of the century in question, and the “preponderance of the evidence” be allowed to point in its own direction. This has particularly been the case in trying to define the lives of females prior to 1790 in Ken-tucky and a few other places. There were no females on the censuses of 1790 and 1800 in Kentucky because Tax Lists had been used for the information and males only were reported. If any female had married and moved on out of her father’s house before 1790, her paternity was more difficult to prove. The daughters of John and Margaret Franklin were certainly a case in point since they had all married and moved from his household before 1790. It was not until 1810 that females began appearing on these censuses.

In following the preponderance of evidence found for Susannah Franklin as a daughter of John and Margaret Franklin the following documentary evidence is important:

1. The 1850 Barren County Census lists Susannah (Franklin) Byrd as age 58. This would place her birth date in 1792. The records of Fayette County, Kentucky in that year indicate that the John Franklin family was living there, and it was most likely the birthplace of Susannah.³⁶ The 1792 birth

date does not conflict with any of the other children's birth dates.

2. On 18 Aug 1808, when Susannah was 16, she married William Byrd in Barren County, Kentucky.³⁷ They were married by John Howe and the surety on their marriage bond was John Franklin. This strongly suggests Susannah was John's daughter. (John Howe had also performed the marriage of Margaret Franklin to James Waggoner in 1802)³⁸ John Franklin's presence in Barren County is confirmed by the 1800 Tax Lists and also the 1810 Census.
3. The second marriage of Margaret (Franklin) Waggoner, daughter of John, was to John McDaniel.³⁹ It is in a document found in Barren County which makes John McDaniel the guardian of Susannah's children by James Waggoner that the children's names are listed.⁴⁰ One of them was a daughter named "Susan." While this is not a strong reason for thinking of Margaret as Susannah's sister - it is a small link in the chain of supporting evidence.
4. The 1810 Warren County, Kentucky Census lists the William Byrd household and the "1 female 16-26" correctly fits Susannah who was age 18 that year.
5. By 1819 both Susannah and William Byrd were listed on the church rolls of Mount Tabor Baptist in Glasgow, Barren County, Kentucky. John and Margaret Franklin had become members there as early as 1801, and others in the family had followed later, including John Franklin, Jr. and wife, Mary (Byrd) Franklin. There is also a "Jane Franklin" on these church rolls by 1810, and because the will of Susannah (Franklin) Byrd mentions that she had a daughter named "Jane Stovall",⁴¹ it is to be wondered if this Jane Franklin on the church rolls might not have been another daughter of John and Margaret Franklin, Sr.

Putting all of these documented instances together seems to make a good case for Susannah (Franklin) Byrd as a daughter of John and Margaret Franklin. - Carol.
