

This is one of the earliest maps of Kentucky. It is from the first American gazetteer, issued by Joseph T. Scott, a Philadelphia engraver and publisher, The maps of the individual states and territories are very accurate for the period. The cartographer included highly detailed rivers, county lines, roads, and towns. He derived much of his information from Elihu Barker's map, which though not as well known as Filson's earlier map, presented a more accurate and detailed picture of Kentucky just after its admission as a state.

Kentucky became a state in 1792. Originally the territory was claimed by Virginia as part of Augusta County. Early settlement included the establishment of Harrodsburg in 1774, and Daniel Boone's Boonesboro in 1775. Early settlement was characterized by significant conflict with the native americans of the region.

Troops from Kentucky were heavily involved in the War of 1812, and in the Civil War, it was officially neutral

Some counties have birth records back to 1851. Most counties have marriage records beginning within a few years of their formation.

One interesting genealogical feature of Kentucky is that it was the birthplace of USGenWeb. In March and April of 1996, several genealogists organized the *Kentucky Comprehensive Genealogy Database Project*. The concept was to furnish a single access point for genealogical data pertaining to Kentucky, organized by county. The information would be indexed and linked, so that even if an individual were found in more than one county, they could be located in the index.

Volunteers signed up to coordinate the collection of databases and to maintain the web pages which included at least queries and lookups. This project later became known as KyGenWeb. Within just a few months, volunteer coordinators had adopted most of the Kentucky counties, and it was decided to expand the project to include the other states and USGenWeb was born, and a short time later WorldGenWeb.

Another interesting genealogical feature of Kentucky, which may have been part of the inspiration of the above the KyGenWeb initiative was that they were the first state to make the index to their vital records available via the web. (See http://www.kygenweb.net/vitals/index.html). Many states have followed suit, with several new states added in the past few months.

Letter from the Editor

This has been one of the more difficult volumes to write, because my Franklin ancestors come from Kentucky. This means that I have been concentrating on this area for decades and therefore I have thousands of pages of records that pertain to this state. There are over 100 footnotes to the 1850 Census alone, and these hardly scratch the surface of what I have, but after taking months to write this much information, I need to move on.

There have been numerous articles in previous volumes that have focused on Kentucky, including Volume 19, which was entirely about the Franklin of that state. Kentucky became a state in 1792. People living in that area were enumerated in Virginia in the 1790 Census. The 1800 Census was lost for several states, including Georgia, Indiana Territory, Kentucky, Mississippi Territory, New Jersey, Northwest Territory and Tennessee. There are no known substitutes except for some isolated tax lists, which in the case of Kentucky are included in this volume.

Editor's Response:

I am surprised to see that I have never heard of Niobe Franklin. A quick Internet search and search of a few of my own records yields the information found below. There seem to be several people named Niobe:

- Niobe Dodge, born 30 Apr 1754, New Shoreham, Newport County, Rhode Island, daughter of Mark Dodge and Lydia Rathbone. She married John Franklin, becoming Niobe (Dodge) Franklin
- Niobe Franklin, born 1810; died 1902, married Allen Foster Boomer, becoming (Niobe (Franklin) Boomer.
- Niobe Boomer, born 1832, married Captain Lyman Andrews, becoming Niobe (Boomer) Andrews.

...I wonder if Niobe is a phonetic variation of Naomi? No, not quite! Niobe was the queen of Thebes in Greek Mythology. There is also a town named Niobe in New York.

If you haven't done so already, the obvious place to look for information regarding her parents is the death record (not death certificate, death record). It should be found in the following (listed in the FHLC):

Boone County, Illinois, Deaths Register Book 1, 1876(1), 1877-1915 Deaths Register Book 2, 1910-1915 FHL Film # 1914095

One of the hints found below has the town of Riga as her possible birthplace. Riga is now in Monroe County. When she was born Riga was in Genesee County. See FFRU Volume 46 for transcriptions of all Franklins early New York census records.

I recently found the following in a library family file. It contains some errors and som suspected errors. Does anyone recognize this document? Can anyone provide clarification or references to help clarify any of the items marked with ?.

The Boomer Family

Jonathon Allen Boomer was born in Genesse? County, New York in the year 1772?. He went by his middle name, Allen. In 1820 he married Perline? Snow. They had five? children - Orris in 1822, Albert in 1825?, Marietta and Harriet. Another child died in infancy.

- 1. Albert became a doctor and practiced in Iowa. He served in the Civil War as a surgeon. After the war, he practiced in Delhi, Iowa until his death in 1887?.
- 2. Orris married and had several children. He lived in Garden Prairie. Illinois near Chicago. He later moved

to Laciede, Linn County, Missouri. The town called Boomer is named for him. He died in 1889?.

Allen Boomer's wife, Perline? died in 1827 and in 1829, he married Niobe Franklin of Riga? County, New York. Her father was a cousin? to Benjamin Franklin. To this union thirteen? children were born: Niobe, Florence. Charlotte, Daphne?, Mamie?, Frederick Orton, Allen Foster, Jasper, Herbert, Clayton and Benjamin. Two? children died in infancy.

- 1. Niobe Boomer, the oldest daughter, married Captain Lyman Andrews in 1850?. They had five children Fred, Milton, James, Florence and Ida. He served in the Mexican War. They moved to Missouri in 1859.
- 2. Charlotte Boomer¹ married Joseph Cronk and had ten children. They lived Belvedere, Illinois.
- 3. Daphne? Boomer married Frank Doolittle.
- 4. Florence Boomer married Louis Snell and had two girls, Gladys and Daphne. They lived in Chicago, Illinois.
- 5. Mamie Boomer was a hunchback and never married.
- 6. Frederick Boomer married Hattie Hayles. They had six children. Oba, Lena, Annie, Fred, Mary, and Mittie?. They lived in Newton County, Arkansas.
- 7. Herbert Boomer went to the California gold fields and was never heard of again.
- 8. Jasper Boomer died when he was young?. Little is known about him.
- 9. Benjamin Boomer not known what happened to him.?
- 10. Clayton Boomer, the youngest, died at 32. He left two daughters, Hattie and Gracie. They lived in Springfield, Missouri. Neither ever married.
- 11. Allen Foster Boomer married Eleanor Gunn in 1858. They had eight children Cora, Lottie, Nellie, Montague, Albert, Forrest, Mamie and Florence. They also moved to Newton County, Arkansas.

Fred and Allen moved to Belvedere, Illinois in 1851. In 1862 they moved to Chariton County, Missouri. They farmed and operated saw mills. Fred and Allen helped to organize the first school in Cunningham township. It was known as the Boomer School until 1930 when the district was reorganized and the old school was abandoned. In the late 1800's the Boomer brothers moved by team and wagon to Jasper, Arkansas

Allen F. Boomer was born 3 Jul 1836 near western Lake Ontario? (Believe this was the area known as the Western Reserve in NY near Lake Ontario?). Allen Married 8 Jul 1858 in Illinois to Eleanor Frances born 1834 in Toledo, Ohio.

Allen F. Eleanor had 8 children: Cora Agnus born 27 Apr 1859, Lottie, Nellie, Mamie, Forrest, Montague, Bert Florence. Allen Eleanor moved to Jasper, Arkansas and remained there until they died. Allen on 19 May 1918, and Eleanor on 8 Dec 1928.
